SPLIT SUNDAY: After winning the first two games of the series and losing the last three, the FredNats aim to salvage a split with the Hillcats today on Salute to Service Sunday presented by SimVentions. Sunday is also Giveaway Sunday, and today is the first bobblehead giveaway of the year featuring reigning Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora. In this Sunday finale, RHP Davian Garcia makes another start for FXBG, looking to build on a very solid start to his professional career. The sixth round pick has allowed just four earned runs over his last three starts, covering 14.2 innings of work. Last week in Salem, he pitched five innings of four hit, one run ball in a nodecision. He faces Lynchburg lefty Rafe Schlesinger, who starts for the second time this week after losing to Fredericksburg on Tuesday. Fredericksburg is unbeaten this year at home on Salute to Service Sunday.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNat offense sputtered for a third straight day in a 7-2 loss to Lynchburg on Star Wars night at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. Jackson Ross had two hits, and Jorgelys Mota and Nate Rombach drove in the two runs for Fredericksburg. Merritt Beeker was a standout performer in the FredNat bullpen, pitching three scoreless innings of relief.

NIGHT AND DAY DIFFERENCE: In the first two games of this series, the FredNats outscored the Hillcats 14-1 and outhit Lynchburg 23-6. In the three losses since, the FredNats have scored a total of seven runs on just 18 total hits. The team batting average the last three days is .184 and the team OPS is .508. The Freddies have just four extra base hits in those three losses.

HE'S A SLUGGER: FredNat infielder Jackson Ross leads the Carolina League in slugging after his fifth and sixth homers in Wednesday's game, and he continues to be near the top of the league leadeboard in several other categories. Ross is slugging .595 on the season, and his .952 OPS ranks third in the league and is eleventh in all of Single-A. He also leads the FredNat team with seven doubles on the year, which is tied for 6th in the Carolina League.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 40% of base runners this year which is first in all of Single-A baseball among qualified catchers, and he ranks sixth in MiLB with 13 caught stealings. Rombach has 11 caught stealings, which is 17th in all of MiLB at any level. Lynchburg is second in MiLB as a team stealing bases, and they only have four stolen bases through the first three games of this series.

STREAKY: Nate Ochoa's triple in the 9th inning Friday night extended his hitting streak to nine games, which is the longest hitting streak of the season for a FredNat. Ochoa blasted his first home run of the season last Sunday in Salem, an opposite field three-run shot off the scoreboard in right center field.

THIS BULLPEN, MAN: The FredNat bullpen continues to be a dominant unit for Fredericksburg. After 4 more innings of two-run ball last night, the bullpen ERA stands at 3.31, which is once again the best bullpen ERA in all of Single-A baseball by nearly .2 runs per game. If you take out bullpen innings from normal starting pitcher Angel Roman, the bullpen ERA is 2.99, which would be the fifth-best in all of Minor League Baseball.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

WELCOME TO FXBG: Davian Abdiel Garcia...was selected by the Nationals with the 170th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Florida Gulf Coast last summer...this is his debut season.

LAST TIME OUT: Garcia allowed a first inning home run in his last start at Salem, but bounced back and didn't give up any more offense. He finished five full innings for the second time in three starts and posted five strikeouts. He's now covered 14.2 IP in his last three starts (4 ER).

PRO MOMENT: Garcia's first career appearance came in relief during the FredNats' second game of the season at Carolina. The righty fired 1.2 scoreless innings in his pro debut, striking out two Mudcats. Since then, he's exclusively been used as a starter.

COLLEGE EDUCATED: Garcia threw for two different schools over the course of his collegiate career. He was an All-ASUN First Team selection at Florida Gulf Coast University as a junior in 2024 after transferring in from Pasco Hernandez State. He finished the 2024 college season as FGCU's Friday night starter after starting the season as a reliever. All in all, he went 6-3 for the Eagles last year, spinning a 3.10 ERA across 61.0 IP and striking out 71 batters. He led the ASUN with a 2.89 conference ERA

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
