### INDY BITS

**NO CHASING THOSE STORMS:** The Indianapolis Indians and Omaha Storm Chasers were rained out three games in a row from Friday-Sunday, shortening the scheduled six-game series to three games. It is the first time the Indians were postponed three consecutive games since 4/14-16/18 at Buffalo and Syracuse due to rain, ice and cold conditions. The make-up dates for all three games have yet to be determined.

**ABOUT THURSDAY NIGHT:** A two-run rally sparked by a go-ahead triple from Matt Gorski in the top of the ninth inning was not enough as the Omaha Storm Chasers defeated the Indianapolis Indians in walk-off fashion at Werner Park on Thursday evening, 5-4. Ji Hwan Bae hit a leadoff home run off Omaha starter Luis Cessa to open the scoring for Indianapolis in the first inning. Omaha then knotted the game in the second with an RBI single from Gentry. Leading off the bottom of the fourth, Jake Lamb sent a long ball over the left-field wall to give the Indians their second lead of the game, but Gentry countered once again with another RBI single in the bottom of the sixth. With two outs in the top of the ninth, Matt Gorski sent his second triple of the year to right field to plate Canaan Smith-Njigba and set up a game-winning opportunity. Down by two runs in the bottom of the ninth, Omaha posted a three-spot to hand Indy its third walk-off loss of the year.

**BAE BATS IT OUT:** Ji Hwan Bae jumped on the Storm Chasers early on Thursday, launching the Indians first leadoff homer of the 2024 season on the fifth pitch of the game's opening at-bat. The long ball was also Bae's third as an Indianapolis Indian, with his first two career leadoff homers coming with the club during the 2022 season (5/1 at Iowa, 5/20 vs. Toledo). The jack extended Bae's on-base streak to a perfect 10 games since beginning a rehab assignment with Indianapolis on 4/9, and his run-scoring streak to eight games. Entering Wednesday's game, Bae was working an eight-game hitting streak before going 0-for-4 with two runs and a walk in the afternoon contest. In total, he is hitting .378 (14-for-37) with 13 runs, one double, two home runs and four RBI with Indy this season.

**LAMB ALSO LEADS OFF:** Jake Lamb followed Ji Hwan Bae's lead on Thursday, launching a solo shot to leadoff the fourth inning and break a 1-1 tie. The homer was Lamb's lone hit of the game and marked just the fourth time in 200 career Triple-A games that he homered to lead off an inning. He's been playing leapprog with Nick Gonzales at the top of the International League batting average leaderboard this season, with Lamb's .382 (21-for-55) batting average coming in third while narrowly trailing Gonzales's league-best .385 mark (35-for-91). In addition to batting average, he ranks among leaders in on-base percentage (3rd, .486) and OPS (6th, 1.086).

**GONZO'S STREAK SNAPPED:** Nick Gonzales had his career-high 21-game on-base streak dating back to Opening Day on 3/29 snapped on Thursday night with an 0-for-4 showing at Omaha. The streak bested his previous career high of 15 games from 4/9-30/22 with Double-A Altoona and is tied with Jacksonville's Dane Myers for the second-longest in the IL this season. The middle infielder still leads all International League leaders in batting average (.385) and doubles (11) while also ranking among leaders in hits (2nd, 35), runs (3rd, 22), extra-base hits (T-6th, 14), total bases (9th, 54) and OPS (10th, 1.027).

**TEAM'S STREAK SNAPPED:** Thursday marked the first time in 22 games this season that the Indians offense did not draw a walk and the first time since 4/2 (fourth game of the season) that they didn't hit a double. The Indians' 53 doubles are now ranked as the fourth-most among International League teams this season, trailing Toledo (68), Iowa (61) and Jacksonville (56), while Nick Gonzales still leads the league with 11 individually.

**TONIGHT:** The Indianapolis Indians and Buffalo Bisons begin their lone six-game series today at 6:05 PM ET at Victory Field. It is the first time Buffalo has visited Victory Field since 2019 and just the second time the two teams have met since then. Last season, Indianapolis visited Sahlen Field and was swept in the six-game series by the Bisons. Tonight, former AL All-Star Alek Manoah (2022 with Toronto) and future NL All-Star Paul Skenes (No. 1 pick in the '23 First-Year Player Draft, No. 3 MiLB prospect by MLB Pipeline) will face off on the mound for their respective teams. Manoah, who made his Triple-A debut with Buffalo in 2021, owns a career 3-2 record, 3.90 ERA (13er/30.0ip) and 41 strikeouts in six career Triple-A games. He has never faced Indianapolis.

**BATTLE OF THE BATTING LEADERS:** Buffalo and Indianapolis rank first and second, respectively, with the best batting averages in the International League this season. Buffalo's .276 batting average (233-for-843) edges Indianapolis' .276 mark (216-for-784) by less than a point. The Bisons, which are led by six of Toronto's top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, best the Indians in all offensive categories except doubles (53-50), with the most start contrast coming in home runs (33-16).

**SKENES STRIKES OUT SEVEN:** Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated as the No. 3 prospect in MiLB, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline), is set to make his sixth Triple-A start today vs. Buffalo. Skenes took the mound last Wednesday at Omaha and struck out seven over a career-high 4.1 innings. As the MiLB.TV Free Game of the Day, all eyes were on the 21-year-old, who has racked up 34 strikeouts in just 17.0 innings pitched this season, the third-most strikeouts among International League leaders this season. Skenes allowed his first run of the season in the second inning when CJ Alexander hit a one-out triple and was driven in on a Nate Eaton single. He also allowed an unearned run in the bottom of the fourth.

**THIS DATE IN 2004:** Indians first baseman Jeff Liefer went 3-for-3 and drove in six runs while falling a triple short of the cycle in an 8-6 win vs. Toledo. The Indians mounted an 8-0 lead through five innings, but the Mud Hens scored two runs apiece in the sixth, seventh and eighth to creep within two. Future 2017 Indians manager Andy Barkett went 1-for-4 with a run scored for the visitors.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER

**Paul Skenes:** The hard-throwing right-hander Skenes will make his sixth Triple-A start as the MiLB.TV/MLB.TV Free Game of the Day tonight vs. Buffalo.

**Last Outing:** In his third start on the road, Skenes punched out seven while tossing a career high 4.1 innings. He allowed five hits, one walk and his first earned run in the outing at Omaha.

**Against the Bisons:** Skenes has never faced Buffalo.

**Triple Digits:** Skenes' fastball topped out at 100.2 mph during his last start on Wednesday at Omaha. In his Triple-A debut on 3/30 at Louisville, four of his five strikeouts coming on triple-digit four-seamers. The hardest-thrown fastball in Triple-A since velocity began being tracked in the minors in 2021 was 102.9 mph in 2023.

**Prospectus:** Enters the 2024 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect by both *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. ... Is rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 3 prospect in baseball and No. 9 by *Baseball America*. ... Is also rated as the No. 1 right-handed pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline. ... Was rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft and No. 2 by *Baseball America*. ... Was also rated first in "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball" and "Best Athlete, third in "Best Control" and fifth in "Best Changeup" by *Baseball America* in the Class of 2023.

**Geaux Tigers:** Went 13-2 with five shutouts, two complete games, 1.69 ERA (23er/122.2ip), SEC-leading 209 strikeouts, 20 walks and a .165 batting average against in 19 starts, leading the LSU Tigers to an NCAA Championship in 2023. ... Was named the College World Series Most Outstanding Player after going 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA and 21 strikeouts in two starts. ... Took home D1Baseball Player of the Year honors and was the SEC Pitcher of the Year. ... Also was the Dick Howser Award (for the national college baseball player of the year) after finishing second in the nation in ERA, third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.45) and fifth in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (5.28).
