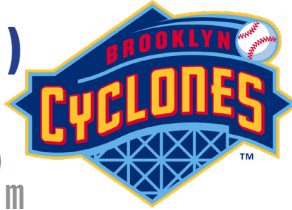

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped the series opener Tuesday night in Jersey Shore despite a masterful pitching performance from not just RHP **Brandon Sproat**, but the bullpen as well...The trio of Sproat, RHP **Diosmerky Taveras**, and RHP **Victor Castañeda** limited the BlueClaws offense to just three runs -- only two of which were earned...Sproat in particular was sharp - hurling four innings while striking out five batters...The only blemish on his final line was a solo home run by DH **Leandro Pineda**...With the loss, the 'Clones are still in search of their first win on the road this season (0-4)...DH **Mateo Gil** provided Brooklyn's only run on a solo home run in the third.

SPROAT'S SPECTACLE: RHP **Brandon Sproat** has lived up to the hype of his third-round draft pick status in the early stages of 2024...Through his first two starts of the season, the former Florida Gator has collectively fired 6.2 innings of one-run ball, while giving up just four hits and striking out 10...Sproat tossed a career-high four innings in Tuesday's loss to Jersey Shore...Coincidentally, a pair of fellow Mets top pitching prospects and 2023 Cyclones RHP **Christian Scott** & RHP **Blade Tidwell** also showcased their stuff for Triple-A Syracuse & Double-A Binghamton, respectively, on Tuesday...The trio combined for 14.1 innings, holding opponents to five runs and striking out 22 batters...The trio make up three of New York's top four pitching prospects.

HAVE A DAY, KIDI: INF **Nick Lorusso** enjoyed his best day as a Cyclone in Sunday's series finale against Asheville...The 2023 9th-round selection by the Mets belted a game-tying solo home run in the third and then followed suit with a walk-off blast with Brooklyn down to its final out in the ninth...The walk-off home run was the first for the Cyclones since C **Hayden Senger** clubbed a game-ending three-run home run in the bottom of the 12th in Brooklyn's 6-5 win over Hudson Valley on May 23, 2021...Lorusso also sandwiched a double between his two home runs, setting a new career high with three base hits...The Littleton, Colo. native launched 26 home runs in his final collegiate campaign as a Maryland Terrapin but did not leave the yard in 26 games with St. Lucie to conclude 2023.

THE BANK IS OPEN: Brooklyn added RHP **Brett Banks** ahead of Tuesday's series opener against the BlueClaws...A 2023 11th-round selection by the Mets, Banks appeared in three contests out of Single-A St. Lucie's bullpen...The UNC Wilmington product hurled 3.0 innings, allowing only one earned run. Banks saw limited action -- also three games out of the bullpen -- with the FCL Mets last season after hearing his name called...Banks went undrafted in the 2021 MLB draft and went on to pitch for the Johnson City Doughboys of the Appalachian League...He also attended the same high school (Garner Magnet) as Cyclones two-way player **Nolan McLean**.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Jordany Ventura**, **Sean Reid-Foley**, **Justin Lawson**, and **Ben Simon** united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in Sunday's walk-off victory...RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Josh Hejka**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joshua Cornelli** also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP **Justin Dunn** (5), LHP **Kyle Regnault** (2), and RHP **Nabil Crismatt** (1) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and in two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** has tossed 8.1 shutout innings to start the 2024 season for the Cyclones...The 81 frames are the most by a New York Mets farmhand this year without allowing a run...The 22-year-old has permitted just four hits and two walks, while striking out six...Since making his South Atlantic League debut last August 23, De La Cruz is 2-1 with a 1.78 ERA (5 ER in 25.1 IP) with seven walks and 23 punch outs...Since his Brooklyn debut, the southpaw leads in second the circuit in WHIP (0.87) and innings pitched (25.1) and third in ERA (1.78) and batting average against (.170).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** stole another base in Sunday's series finale and is 8-for-8 to start the season...The eight swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for fourth among non-Triple-A players...Entering Wednesday, De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is three steals shy of matching UTL **Jaylen Palmer's** (48) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is seventh across the Minors for swipes (115)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** powered his first extra-base hit and home run, as well as earning his first RBIs of 2024 in Game 1 on Saturday...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in all three categories with 43

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Justin Crawford** (4), SS **Bryan Rincon** (9), INF **William Bergolla** (12), OF **Emaarion Boyd** (17), OF **Hendry Mendez** (23), and LHP **Samuel Aldegerri** (24)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 46-38 (.548).

extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 93 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

HOME OPENER: The Brooklyn Cyclones opened up their 66-game home schedule on Tuesday evening vs. Asheville with a 3-0 win...The shutout marked the first for Brooklyn in a home opener since a 3-0 victory in 11 years...The Cyclones last blanked an opponent in their home debut on June 20, 2013, vs. Aberdeen...RHP **John Gant** (5.0 IP), RHP **Tim Peterson** (2.2), and LHP **John Mincone** (1.1) combined for the win...The 'Clones are now 17-5 all-time in their first home game of the season.

2023 IN REVIEW: Brooklyn claimed a share of the North Division Second Half crown in the South Atlantic League, but ceded the final playoff spot to the Jersey Shore BlueClaws on a head-to-head tiebreaker...Needing a win on the final day of the regular season to clinch a playoff spot, the 'Clones dropped a 6-2 contest to Wilmington...Jersey Shore would outlast the Hudson Valley Renegades, 10-9, in 11 innings to secure the seat...After a 28-37 first-half record, the Cyclones composed a 38-28 mark in the second half to finish the season over .500 at 66-65.

YOUTH IS SERVED: **Gilbert Gómez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

FAMILIAR FACES: Out of the 30 players on the Cyclones' preliminary roster, 16 of them have previous experience playing on Coney Island...**Jeffrey Colón**, **Joshua Cornelli**, **Felipe De La Cruz**, **Jordan Geber**, **Josh Hejka**, **Joey Lancellotti**, and **Jordany Ventura** return to the bump, while **Drake Osborn** and **Christian Pregent** are holdovers behind the dish...**Ryan Clifford**, **Mateo Gil**, **William Lugo**, **D'Andre Smith**, and **Junior Tillen** are back in the infield, as **Stanley Consuegra** and **Omar De Los Santos** are set to roam the outfield.

GENIUNE DRAFT: Seven members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class will open the 2024 season with the Cyclones...Pregent returns to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...RHP **Noah Hall** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, will also start the season in Brooklyn.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: **Clifford** (4), **Sproat** (13), **McLean** (19), **Ziegler** (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his first start of the season last Wednesday afternoon vs. Asheville...Did not allow a run on three hits over 3.1 innings...Walked one and struck out two...Plunked a pair of batters...Induced a pair of double plays...Tossed 56 pitches and 36 strikes (64.3%)...Relieved by RHP **Victor Castañeda** with a man at first and one out in the top of the fourth of a scoreless game...Bequeathed runner was stranded...Tourists went on to defeat the Cyclones, 7-3.

HAVE IT TWO WAYS: McLean is listed as a two-way player on the Brooklyn Cyclones roster and is expected to serve as a designated hitter on weekends during the season...At the plate this season, the 22-year-old has picked up an extra-base hit in all three games played...He is 3-for-11 with a double, two home runs, and three RBI...In his professional career, McLean is 5-for-27 (.185) at the plate with a double, three home runs, and six RBI.

PROSPECT RADAR: McLean enters the 2024 campaign as one of the top prospects in the New York Mets farm system...The 22-year-old is considered New York's No. 15 prospect per *Baseball America* and No. 19 by MLB Pipeline.

SPRING BREAKOUT: The Willow Springs, N.C. native earned the win pitching in relief for the New York Mets prospects in their contest against the Washington Nationals' farmhands on Friday, March 15...McLean came on in support of former Cyclone RHP **Blade Tidwell** in the top of the fifth...The right-hander did not allow a run on one hit, did not walk a batter, and struck out a batter...Tossed only 10 pitches (7 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Brandon Sproat** to start the sixth in the Mets' 4-2 win.

COWBOY UP: The second-year pro had a tremendous career at Oklahoma State before departing...In 2023, McLean served predominantly as a relief pitcher, posting a 1-2 record with a 3.30 ERA (11 ER in 30.0 IP) and six saves, tallying 34 strikeouts...As a hitter, he collected a .250/.379/.532 line with a .911 OPS, nine home runs and 29 RBI...McLean was a Perfect Game/Rawlings Second Team All-American in 2022 and was a member of the Oklahoma State football team as a quarterback in 2020.

TWO TIMES: McLean was drafted for the second time last summer, as the New York Mets chose him with the 91st-overall pick...The right-hander was also selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State University, but did not sign...Joined teammate RHP **Brandon Sproat** as two of three players selected in the top 10 rounds that did not sign.

FAMILIAR FACES: While at the Oklahoma State University, McLean spent the summer of 2021 pitching for the Chatham Anglers of the Cape Cod Baseball League...During that time, the right-hander was teammates with current Cyclones RHP **Brandon Sproat** and former Brooklyn RHP **Kolby Kubichek** and C **Kevin Parada**.
