SPRDATACULAR: Mets No. 13 prospect RHP **Brandon Sproat** is slated to start for Binghamton tonight. In his last start 12 days ago on June 2, Sproat struck out a career-high 10 batters over seven scoreless innings, while allowing just one hit and one walk against Harrisburg at home. Sproat struck out each of the first five batters of the game and set down the first 11 batters he faced. The 23-year-old has tossed a career-high seven innings in three-straight starts and holds a 1-0 record with a 1.38 ERA through four Double-A starts. Across High-A and Double-A, Sproat holds a 1.23 ERA, which is the second-best in Minor League Baseball among qualified arms.

NOTES

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Somerset Patriots, 12-5, on Thursday night at Mirabito Stadium. **Rowdey Jordan** hit his fourth home run of the season, with a two-run shot to left field in the second inning. **Ryan Clifford** drew his 52nd walk of the season and extended his on-base streak to 14 games. **Cam Robinson** spun a career-high-tying 2.2 innings with a season-high four strikeouts, while allowing just one hit and no runs in relief.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 75 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** drew his 52nd walk of the season on Thursday night and extended his on-base streak to 14 games. Clifford ranks second in Minor League Baseball with 52 walks, two behind MLB Pipeline's No. 1 prospect Jackson Holliday. He has reached base in 19 of his last 20 games and on his 14-game on-base streak, Clifford holds a .429 on-base percentage and 1.063 OPS with four homers, 10 runs batted in, and 16 walks. He has drawn at least one walk in 12 of his last 14 games. In 10 games in the month of June, Clifford has a .429 OBP, 1.129 OPS, four homers, eight runs batted in, 13 walks, and just eight strikeouts.

CLIFFORD THE DOUBLE-A DOG: Clifford has drawn at least one walk in 18 of his 25 games at the Double-A level. In 25 games, the 20-year-old has recorded 14 hits, including 11 extra base hits (six doubles and five home runs). He currently holds a .443 slugging percentage and .783 OPS in Double-A.

RUDY: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** is currently riding a 13-game on-base streak. Over that span, Rudick is slashing .286/.362/.367/.729 with 14 hits, seven walks, three runs batted in and eight runs scored. Rudick currently ranks tied for the second-most walks in the Eastern League with 32 and tied for 10th in the league with a .377 on-base percentage.

LAST NAME DSBORN, FIRST NAME DRAKE: Catcher **Drake Osborn** crushed a goahead grand slam in the 8th inning on Tuesday against Somerset. Osborn is riding a three-game hitting streak with hits in five of his last six games.

ROWDEY ROCKET: Infielder **Rowdey Jordan** belted a two-run home run to left field in the second inning on Thursday night, batting right-handed against Brock Selvidge, and it marked his fourth homer of the year. Jordan is riding a five-game hitting streak, hitting .368 (7-for-19) with a .955 OPS, a homer, three runs batted in, four runs scored, two walks, and two stolen bases in that span. Jordan went 0-for-20 in six games prior to this hitting streak.

-AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA.
