TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints came out of the All-Star Break in a big way, sweeping their three-game series in Toledo by taking the finale 10-3. Zebby Matthews made his Triple-A debut, throwing 5.0 innings, allowing two runs in the first and struck out six. The Saints gave him early run support by plating three runs in the first. Wynton Bernard hit an RBI single and Anthony Prato hit a two-run triple. The Saints added three more in the third and fourth innings to take a 9-2 lead, pounding out double-digit hits for the second consecutive game. In the sixth, Chris Williams hit a solo home run, tying the career franchise record with his 43rd in a Saints uniform. Brock Stewart struck out the side in the sixth in his inning of Major League rehab. It marks the Saints third sweep this season.

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 12th home run of the season on Sunday and the 42nd of his Saints career. He has tied Mark Contreras for the career franchise lead at 43 long balls. His 43 home runs since his debut on July 17, 2022 are tied for the 10th-most in the International League.

§ In the month of July, Williams has clubbed seven home runs, the most in the International League. He also leads the league in July with his 41 total bases and his .820 slugging percentage. His 1.244 OPS is the second-best in the IL this month. It is also the best of any month he's had in 2024 and over double his .544 OPS in June.

REHAB ROUNDTABLE: The Minnesota Twins sent Royce Lewis to St. Paul on a Major League rehab assignment on Tuesday. The Saints now have two Major League Rehab assignment on their roster, along with Brock Stewart. Lewis will be making his second rehab appearance with the Saints, previously playing with them from May 25-June 2. Lewis went 4-for-23 with a double in six games. Stewart has made four appearances, most recently on July 21. Over the four outings, he has pitched 4.0 innings, allowed one hit, one earned run, walked two and struck out eight.

CHASING STORMS HOME RUNS: The Saints have hit 74 home runs against Omaha at CHS Field, the most long balls they have hit against any team in any venue in franchise history. Their .486 slugging percentage against Omaha is the fourth-best against any opponents at CHS Field since 2021.

AND THAT'S ON BASE: A day after Anthony Prato reached base in all five of his plate appearances on Saturday, Chris Williams replicated the feat on Sunday in his 4-for-4 outing. He is the fourth Saint to do so this season, joining Prato (4/24, 7/20), Will Holland (4/23) and Diego A. Castillo (5/14). Prato and Williams are the second pair to do so in back-to-back games, as Holland and Prato did so on April 23-24. Williams is the 15th player in franchise history to reach base in all five-or-more plate appearances.

BRIGHAM BRINGING IT: Over his last five appearances, Jeff Brigham has been locked in, allowing one earned run over his last 7.2 innings (1.17 ERA), striking out 10 in that span. All 10 of those strikeouts have come in his last three outings and also rank as the most among Saints' relievers in July.

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .420 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 11 of the 13 games he's played in, drawing eight walks and been hit by a pitch four times. *He is fourth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .448 across three levels.*

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 46 games since May 21, he has hit .347 (59-for-170), with 10 home runs, drawing 34 walks to 47 strikeouts, owning a 1.025 OPS. Since June 1, Severino is tied for the league lead with 48 hits, second in the IL in batting average at .356, second in on-base percentage at .467 and second in OPS, at 1.037, ranking fifth in slugging percentage with a .570 mark. His 29 walks since the start of June are the fifth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Minnesota Twins opened their series against the Philadelphia Phillies with a 7-2 victory. Bailey Ober dealt 7.0 innings of two-run baseball. Cole Sands secured the six-out save, his third of the season. Meanwhile the offense pounded out seven runs on 12 hits, with four Twins recording multi-hit nights.

LAST APPEARANCE: 7/11 @ LOU...made 12th start of the season with the Saints, throwing 5.2 innings of shutout baseball, allowing two hits and three walks while striking out six...allowed an infield single in the first inning before retiring seven in a row into the third inning when he walked Jacob Hurtubise...allowed a two-out baserunner in each of the third, fourth, fifth and sixth innings...allowed only four balls to leave the infield, only one of which went for a hit...pitched into the sixth inning for the first time since May 21 at Buffalo...did not factor into the decision in a 3-2 Saints loss.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/4 v GWN... made 11th AAA start of the season, throwing 2.2 innings, allowing two runs on four hits, one home run, walking three and striking out one...threw 42 pitches in the first inning, prompting a positional switch with LF Chris Williams, allowing Varland to stay in the game...allowed one run in the first inning, allowing two singles to start the game, retiring the next two before walking a pair...Williams got Luis Liberato to fly out to end the inning...due to the three batter minimum rule, Williams had to face the first two batters of the second inning, he allowed a walk and single before Varland returned to the mound...Varland's return to the mound saw him give up a three-run homer to Nacho Alvarez Jr...then retired the next three batters...in the third, allowed a two-out single and walk, retiring the other three batters...took seventh loss of the season in 11-0 Saints loss.

SOMEONE IS FLIPPING OVER A CHECKERS BOARD: During the 2023 offseason, Louie got engaged to Maddie Hentges, a former lacrosse player at Concordia-St. Paul (2017-20), the same school as Varland, Maddies brother, Sam, was a star forward on the Totino-Grace HS hockey team, played at St. Cloud State, and was a Minnesota Wild draft pick. Maddies Dad, Mark, was a Hobie Baker Award finalist in 1980 at St. Thomas, a 2x All-American (1980 & 81) and played in the Montreal Canadiens organization.

NOTHING TO RANT(Z) ABOUT X 2: Make it back-to-back years in which Varland was honored with the Jim Rantz Minnesota Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year Award. In 2021 he received it after going 10-4 with a 2.10 ERA in 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids. In 103.0 innings pitched he fanned 142 while opponents hit .214 against him. In 2022, between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, he went 8-5, 3.06 (126.1 IP, 43 ER) with 42 walks and 146 strikeouts as opponents hit .242 against him across 24 games (23) starts. He also went 1-2, 3.81 ERA (26.0 IP, 11 ER) with six walks, 21 strikeouts, and a .261 opponents batting average in five starts.

WHO SAYS YOU CAN'T GO HOME: With the transfer from Double-A to Triple-A, on August 8, 2022, Varland returned home. He became the first player from St. Paul to play for the Saints since the team became a Triple-A franchise. Some of the players from the Independent days that were from St. Paul that played for the Saints include Jack Morris, Ryan Schlosser, Tim Thomas (1995), Chris Schwab, Steve Butler, Adam Larson, Brian Whinnery, Zach Peterson, Reid Mahon, Matt Schuld, Joe Bonfe, Jack Gohl, and Jake Esch.

HULKAMANIA: While in high school at North St. Paul High School, Varland was on the wrestling team. He was a two-time MSHSL State Tournament wrestler, two-time MVP, Most Improved, Rookie of the Year, two-time section runner up and four-time captain of the wrestling team.

GET ON THE BUS, GUS: Louie's brother, Gus, is 13 months older than him. They played together at North St. Paul High School and Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was selected in the 14th round by the Oakland Athletics in 2018 out of Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was then traded to the Dodgers along with 3B Sheldon Neuse in exchange for LHP Adam Kolarek and RF Cody Thomas on February 12, 2021. He was claimed in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 draft by the Milwaukee Brewers from the L.A. Dodgers on December 7, 2022

NOT MY BROTHERS KEEPER: - Louie faced off against his brother Gus in 2022 as the Wind Surge took on the Tulsa Drillers on May 6, 2022 in Wichita. It's the first time brothers started against each other in the Minors since at least the 2000s. Louie went 5.0 IP allowed two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out six. His brother went 3.0 IP allowing six runs on eight hits while walking two and striking out two in a 7-2 Wichita victory in game one of a doubleheader.

BROTHERLY LOVE: On June 15, 2022 the Wind Surge and Drillers met again in a doubleheader in Wichita. This time, the brothers pitched opposite ends of the doubleheader and each got a victory. Louie won Game 1 allowing two runs across 6.0 innings while walking one and striking out four in a 7-4 Wind Surge win. In the second game, Gus pitched 2.0 shutout innings of relief allowing one hit and striking out four in a 4-3 Drillers victory.

RUNS IN THE FAMILY: While Louie has more than made a name for himself, he might not be the most athletic person in his family. His Aunt's Denise and Sue were legendary softball pitchers at North St. Paul High School.
