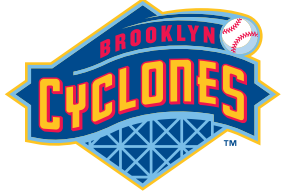


## AMAZIN' STARTS HERE

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones dropped a wild series finale on Sunday against the BlueClaws, 9-6, in 10 innings...Down to their final strike, Jersey Shore tied the game with back-to-back two-out doubles from IB **Keaton Anthony** and DH **Felix Reyes**...The BlueClaws added three in the 10th on a C **Jordan Dissin** single and SS **Aidan Miller**'s two-run single...The two teams combined for 26 hits (13 apiece), while 10 total pitchers were used...Brooklyn's biggest moment offensively came from CF **Omar De Los Santos**, who launched a go-ahead solo home run in the bottom of the 7th...De Los Santos, along with SS **Wilfredo Lara**, C **Chris Suero**, RF **Sebastian Castro** and DH **Donovan Antonia** all finished with multi-hit games.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On July 23, 2016, RHP **Nabil Crismatt** became the first Cyclones relief pitcher to record a double-digit strikeout game, punching out 11 hitters over 5.0 innings to earn the save in a 7-2 win vs. Aberdeen...DH **Pete Alonso** went 2-for-2 with a walk and a two-run home run in the victory...In 2022, down 7-5 in the top of the ninth, Brooklyn took the lead on a two-out CF **Alex Ramirez** grand slam in a 9-7 comeback win at Jersey Shore...In 2023, the Cyclones rallied back from 4-0 down to tie the game with a DH **Omar De Los Santos** grand slam in the top of the fourth...RF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed a two-run shot and IB **Mateo Gil** added a solo blast in the seventh to help Brooklyn win 7-4 at Hudson Valley.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Cyclones made a series of roster moves on Monday...RHP **Jefrey Colón** returned from Double-A Binghamton and INF **D'Andre Smith** was reinstated off the injured list...Additionally, OF **Sebastian Castro** was sent back to the Florida Complex League Mets, while RHPs **Victor Castañeda** and **Joey Lancellotti** were released by the New York Mets...Colón made three appearances with Binghamton after leaving Brooklyn on July 3, allowing two runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings, going 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA...Smith had been on Brooklyn's IL since April 13 with a hamstring injury...The 23-year-old went 7-for-34 (.206) at the plate in 10 rehab games with the FCL Mets and Single-A St. Lucie, adding for runs scored, two doubles, four runs batted in, and three stolen bases...Castro appeared in three games for the Cyclones after joining the team on July 19 and was 2-for-11 (.182) with the bat...Castañeda went 4-2 with a 6.47 ERA (23 ER in 32.0 IP), 12 walks, and 36 strikeouts in 18 relief appearances for the Cyclones in 2024...Lancellotti did not receive a decision and held a 6.14 ERA (10 ER in 14.2 IP), one save, 11 walks, and 11 strikeouts in 14 relief outings...The 26-year-old tossed a scoreless sixth inning in the Cyclones' combined no-hitter vs. Aberdeen on June 4.

**'TALK 2' EM:** RHP **Kade Morris** has started to find his stride at the High-A level...Despite being tagged with the loss on Saturday against Jersey Shore, Morris still holds a minuscule 1.63 ERA over his last five starts dating back to June 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Morris' record during that five-game span (four starts) sits at 2-2...He has yielded just 21 hits and 10 walks while striking out 29...Since June 20, Morris and RHP **Jonah Tong** have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Morris is third in the circuit in ERA (1.63) and Tong is fifth (1.75)...Additionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (27.2), ninth in batting average against (.204), and fifth in WHIP (1.12)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is second in the league in innings pitched (511), and ninth in batting average against (.231), WHIP (1.25), and ERA (3.33).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Over his last five starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with a 1.75 ERA (5 ER in 25.2 IP), allowing only 14 hits and seven walks, while striking out 36...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit in strikeouts (74)...He is also second in batting average against (.203), third in ERA (3.14) and WHIP (1.19), and ninth in innings pitched (57.1)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.09), fourth in strikeout rate (35.4%), and sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%), and tied for eighth in strikeouts (110).

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...Since July 6, he is 12-for-31 (.387) with four runs scored, a double, two RBI, and two walks...Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests, but five in his last eight games...In 12 games during July, the Brandon, Miss. native is hitting .317/.417/.342 with a .758 OPS...His .417 on-base percentage is tied for sixth in the South Atlantic League during the month.

**WIZARD OF PAZ:** OF **Karell Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is hitting .319/.418/.489 with a .908 OPS in 15 games...Paz has scored six runs and picked up three doubles, a home run, six runs batted in, seven walks and seven stolen bases...Since that date, Paz is tied for fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (7), sixth in on-base percentage (.418), and ninth in batting average (.319).

**vs. ROME:** Brooklyn continues a nine-game homestand with six contests against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors have six of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Cade Kuehler** (7), RHP **Jhancarlos Lara** (12), INF **Sabin Ceballos** (17), and RHP **Blake Burkhalter** (26)...RHP **Owen Murphy** (4) and INF **Ambioris Tavarez** (20) are on the injured list...This marks Rome's first trip to Coney Island and the second series ever between the two franchises...Brooklyn and Rome split a six-game series at AdventHealth Stadium from May 7-12.

**TRAVELING CIRCUS:** Prior to this week's six-game set against Rome, the Cyclones had just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's previous full six-game home series June 18-23 vs. Jersey Shore...Brooklyn was 7-14 in the 21-game stretch...The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and played another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...The stretch also included a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

**MORABITO FUEL:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old is 13th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (38)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito is tied for second in the league in hits (64), tied for third in stolen bases (27), and tied for sixth in runs scored (40)...On the year, the former second-round selection is tied for eighth in the SAL in stolen bases (27)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.305), stolen bases (38), and on-base percentage (.402)...He is also second in hits (95) and runs scored (54), and tied for fifth in triples (3).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Since powering a 421-foot home run on July 13 at Wilmington, the 24-year-old has homered three times in his last four games, going 5-for-13 (.385) at the plate with six runs scored, a double, and five runs batted in...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fourth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer**'s (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (72) and is fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

**SHUT IT:** Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

**LOCATION, LOCATION:** The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests...He is sixth in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (45) and stolen bases (25) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .226/.293/.262 line with a .555 OPS, three extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 20 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .303/.360/.434 mark with a .794 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 34 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .171/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...C **Chris Suero** is hitting .258/.403/.435 with a .838 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 18 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 15 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks.

**ONE-TWO MISSTEP:** The Cyclones have struggled in games decided by one or two runs...Brooklyn is 6-15 in one-run games and 5-6 in two-run games for a combined record of 11-21 (.344)...The Cyclones hold a record 30-28 (.517) in games decided by three runs or more.

**WALK-OFF WOES:** Brooklyn's 3-2 loss at Wilmington on July 12 marked the team's seventh walk-off defeat of the season...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.91% of all defeats, including 26.15% of all road losses...Brooklyn has two walk-off wins this year on **Chris Suero**'s RBI single in the 10th on Friday and **Nick Lorusso**'s game-winning home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 14.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (9), RHP **Jonah Tong** (15), RHP **Kade Morris** (23), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (26), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (19), Báez (21), Ziegler (22), **Wilfredo Lara** (23), OF **Nick Morabito** (25), and Morris (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision on July 14 at Wilmington...Did not allow a run on one hit in 1.0 inning of work...Did not issue a walk and struck out one...Plunked a batter...Threw 18 pitches and 10 strikes (55.56%)...Relieved by RHP **Jawilme Ramirez** to start the bottom of the second inning and Brooklyn leading 1-0...Pintaro, Ramirez (2.2 IP), RHP **Jake Stevenson** (0.1), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (3.0), and RHP **Ben Simon** (2.0) combined on a six-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Blue Rocks, 5-0, in the final game before the All-Star break.

**CHANGE OF PLANS:** Pintaro's final start for the Pioneer League's Glacier Range Riders (Kalispell, Mont.) was cut short due to great news...The 26-year-old tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball against the Great Falls Voyagers on June 2 before being told by manager **Paul Fletcher** that he would not continue...Pintaro's day came to a close because his contract had been purchased by the New York Mets, officially signing the following day..."It was surreal. After the second inning I came to the dugout and I heard him (Fletcher) say somebody get warm and I kind of gave him a look," said Pintaro to the *Daily Inter Lake*...In three starts for the Range Riders, Pintaro was 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER in 14.1 IP), one walk, and 23 strikeouts...The Pelham, Ala. native had a 14.44 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio in the MLB Partner circuit...Pintaro was teammates with 2024 BlueClaws INF **Chad Castillo** with the Range Riders.

**REMEMBER ME?:** Following the 2021 and 2022 collegiate seasons, Pintaro pitched for the Frederick (Md.) Keys of the MLB Draft League...During that time, the 26-year-old was a teammate of a few current and former Cyclones...In 2021, Pintaro pitched alongside RHP **Dylan Tebrake**, who was a member of the 2023 bullpen and is currently on Double-A Binghamton's 60-day injured list...During the 2022 season, the Shorter University alum was a teammate of RHP **Jordan Geber** (2023-24) who is currently with Double-A Binghamton and current Cyclones RHP **Jonah Tong**...In 25 games (17 starts) for the Keys, Pintaro was 3-9 with a 4.55 ERA (44 ER in 87.0 IP), 41 walks, and 108 strikeouts.

**SHORTER STACK:** Pintaro became the first Shorter University alum to sign a contract with a Major League team since becoming an NCAA program in 2013...During his time with the Hawks, the Alabama native was Gulf South Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Pintaro accumulated a 20-7 record with a 3.19 ERA (70 ER in 197.1 IP), 76 walks, and 286 strikeouts during those two seasons...Shorter is located in Rome, Ga. and its campus is located 3.7 miles southwest of the Rome Emperors' AdventHealth Stadium...Pintaro was coached at Shorter by **Wes Timmons**, who was a member of the 2003 South Atlantic League champion Rome Braves.
