#### LAST TIME OUT...

**ALLENTOWN, Pa. (August 24, 2021)** – Led by a quality start from Luis Gil the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Lehigh Valley IronPigs 5-2 on Tuesday night at Coca-Cola Park.

Lehigh Valley scratched across a run in the top of the first against Gil on a Mickey Moniak sacrifice fly. The RailRiders took a 2-1 lead in the top of the third when Greg Allen launched a two-run home run to right off Mark Appel. The blast was Allen's third of the season, all coming against right-handed pitching.

Gil (4-0) settled in nicely after the first, allowing only two runs on four hits in the game, striking out six and walking two in 6.1 innings of work. It was his first start with the RailRiders since July 27 after three successful MLB starts.

Max Burt provided an insurance run with an RBI double in the top of the fourth to put the RailRiders on top 3-1. The IronPigs cut the lead to 3-2 with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the fifth, but SWB added a tally in the seventh to expand the lead to 4-2. Brooks Kriske was stellar in 1.2 innings of relief for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to keep Lehigh Valley off the board in the seventh and eighth innings. In the top of the ninth Trey Amburgey lifted a sacrifice fly to right to score Estevan Florial and grow the advantage to 5-2.

Sal Romano shut the door in the bottom of the ninth for his second save of the season with a 1-2-3 frame. By virtue of the win and a loss by the Buffalo Bisons on Tuesday, the RailRiders move into a tie for first place in Triple-A East Northeast Division. It is the first time since August 11 that SWB has been atop the division.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**THE OPENING ACT:** The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders starting rotation has turned in a series of great performances on the current road trip. In the seven games, SWB starters are 3-2 with a 2.31 ERA (9 ER/35.0 IP). RailRiders lid-lifters have struck out 35 batters and walked only 12 while yielding just 15 hits in the duration of their work. From Game Two of Thursday's doubleheader through the second inning on Saturday, **Sean Boyle**, **JP Sears** and **Deivi Garcia** combined to throw 14.2 consecutive hitless innings, walking four and striking out 13 in the process. The stretch has lowered SWB's starting pitcher ERA from 5.32 to 5.03 on the season.

**CREAM OF THE CROP:** Throughout the 2021 season, the RailRiders bullpen has been the backbone of the pitching staff, posting a 2.99 ERA as a unit and racking up 41 of SWB's 56 wins. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has the second-best bullpen ERA in full season baseball (minors and majors), trailing only Buffalo (2.84). The bullpen is posting impressive rates of 10.03 K/9, 3.60 BB/9, and has limited opposing batters to just a .202 batting average this season. Currently, the bullpen is working on an 8.2-inning scoreless streak, dating back to the eighth inning on Friday night at Worcester, and has allowed only 3 ER in 19.0 IP (1.42 ERA) since August 18, a span of six games.

**THE FINAL STRETCH BEFORE THE FINAL STRETCH™:** Including tonight's contest with Lehigh Valley, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have only 25 games remaining in the 2021 regular season. An incredible 44% (11-of-25) of SWB's remaining games are on the road against the IronPigs. The remainder of the schedule consists of a 14-game homestand against Buffalo (8 games) and Rochester (6 games). The RailRiders begin play Thursday 4.5 games behind the Durham Bulls (62-34) for first place overall in Triple-A East.

**OUT OF THE RED, INTO THE BLACK:** After the worst run of the season which saw the RailRiders go 6-13 in a 19-game stretch from July 25 through August 17, the RailRiders have seemingly turned a corner, going 4-2 in their last six games. While that is not an overly-impressive record, SWB has out-scored its opponents by a dominant 36-12 mark in those games. The run of strong play has helped the RailRiders erase a 2.0-game deficit in the Northeast Division standings to Buffalo and enter play Wednesday night tied for first place.

**CLOSE CALLS AND BLOWOUTS:** The RailRiders have played an extraordinary number of close games this season, with 49 of SWB's 93 games being decided by one or two runs (52.7%). Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has performed roughly average in these close contests, going 15-13 (.536) in one-run games and 11-10 (.524) in two-run games. Not to be out-done, the RailRiders have also participated in their fair share of extreme blowout games, decided by eight-or-more runs. In 12 such contests, SWB is 10-2 (.833) on the season, and is part of the reason why the team is +119 in run differential this season, second-best in Triple-A East.

**HITTING HERE IN ALLENTOWN:** RailRiders OF **Greg Allen** has been on a tear in 12 games since being returned to the team from the Yankees. The switch-hitter is batting .444 (16-for-36) with 7 R, 4 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 3 BB, 6 K, and 3 HBP. Allen had a 12-game on-base streak snapped on Saturday with an 0-for-3 performance, but during the streak his season batting line improved from .263/.402/.343 to .321/.440/.460, a 155-point jump in his OPS.

**SEAN BOYLE RULES:** On Monday RHP **Sean Boyle** was named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for August 16 through 22. In his one outing of the week, Boyle threw a complete game, 7-inning no-hitter at Polar Park against the Worcester Red Sox in his first career Triple-A Start. He became the third Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week Award winner for the RailRiders this season, joining **Deivi Garcia** (May 10-16) and **Luis Gil** (July 19-25). Before this year, the RailRiders had not been honored with a league pitcher of the week award since August 22-28, 2016, when **Jonathan Holder** won International League Pitcher of the Week for his legendary 11 consecutive strikeout performance. However, on Tuesday Boyle was transferred to the Double-A Somerset Patriots.

**CURRENT PROSPECT RANKINGS:** MLB Pipeline -- NYY #2, MLB #66; Baseball America -- NYY #8; Fangraphs -- NYY #4.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Making his long-anticipated Triple-A debut, Clarke Schmidt was strong in 3.1 innings last Tuesday at Worcester. Limited by pitches, he allowed only one run on three hits while walking one and striking out four. The one run he allowed was on a solo home run to Josh Ockimey leading off the second inning, but he allowed only three other balls to be hit out of the infield all game.

**INJURED WING:** Schmidt was initially shut down in February 2021 with a strain in his common extensor tendon in his right elbow. The injury is described as being similar to tennis elbow, but on the anterior (medical jargon for "inside part") of his elbow joint.

**2020 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Saw his first Major League action, going 0-1 with a 7.11 ERA (6.1IP, 5ER) in three games (one start) over two stints with the Yankees (9/4-13, 9/27).
- Was the Yankees' first-round pick (16th overall) in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft...is the first Yankees' firstround pick to make his Major League debut with the club since Aaron Judge on 8/13/16 (2013 draft, 32nd overall) and the first pitcher to do so since Andrew Brackman on 9/22/11 (2007 draft, 30th overall).
- Was signed to a Major League contract and selected to the active roster between games of a doubleheader on 9/4 at Baltimore.
- Made his Major League debut in Game 2 on 9/4 at Baltimore after never having pitched professionally above Double-A in his career...was the seventh Yankee to make his Major League debut in 2020.
- Made his first career start on 9/27 vs. Miami, recording his first career loss after allowing 3ER in 4.0IP (4H, 2BB, 4K, 1HP, 1WP).
- Was part of the Yankees' 40-man postseason player pool, but did not appear on a playoff roster
- Attended spring training as a non-roster invitee for the first time in 2020, posting a 2.57 ERA (7.0IP, 9H, 4R/2ER, 3BB, 8K, 1HR) in four games (one start)...was named the 2020 James P. Dawson Award winner, presented annually to the most outstanding rookie in spring training as voted on by Yankees beat writers...was reassigned to the Alternate Site on 7/21.
- Following the season, was tabbed by Baseball America as the Yankees' No. 3 prospect and as having the "Best Curveball" among Yankees farmhands...was also named on the publication's Top 100 Prospects list as the No. 64 prospect in Baseball.

**PERSONAL:**

- Underwent "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow and did not pitch professionally after being drafted in 2017.
- In three seasons at South Carolina (2015-17), produced a 15-9 record and 3.21 ERA (229.2IP, 218H, 102R/82ER, 65BB, 254K, 17HR) in 45 games (36 starts)...as a junior in 2017, went 4-2 and ranked second in the nation with a 1.34 ERA (60.1IP, 41H, 15R/9ER, 18BB, 70K, 3HR) in nine starts, posting a 10.44 K/9.0IP ratio and .194 (41-for-211) opponents' BA.
- Was named to USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in both 2016 and 2017...was named to the 2017 NCBWA Pre-Season All-America First Team.
- Was Baseball America's No. 31 overall prospect (and No. 17 pitcher) in the 2017 draft...was tabbed by Baseball America as having the Best Control in the SEC.
- His older brother, Clate, pitched in both the Tigers and Reds organizations.
