THE LO DOWN: Logan Henderson will toe the rubber for his 13th start of the year with Nashville. The Brewers' no. 6-rated prospect enters the game tied for third in the IL with his eight wins. He earned one of those wins with a six-inning quality start his first time against Durham where the only hit he allowed was a two-out solo homer to Carson Williams in the top of the sixth inning back on April 26 at First Horizon Park.

BACK TO BLACK: Tyler Black made it back-to-back games with a home run with his solo home run in the top of the first inning on Friday night. He homered on Wednesday night before having the day off on Thursday. Black is the seventh different Nashville player to have a home run in consecutive games in 2025. Jorge Alfaro was the last to do it with home runs in back-to-back games last Saturday and Sunday against Memphis. It's the fifth time in Black's career with a home run in consecutive games and the first since ending the 2024 season with homers in back-to-back games September 21-22 on the road in Norfolk.

CAN'T FORGET YOUR FIRST: Brewers no. 5-rated prospect Jeferson Quero collected his first career Triple-A home run with his go-ahead three-run home run in the top of the seventh inning off right-hander Joey Krehbiel. Quero had five home runs during his 11-game rehab stint in the Arizona Complex League prior to joining the Sounds on June 3rd. Friday's homer was the 34th of Quero's professional career.

QUALITY + QUANTITY: Chad Patrick's quality start on Friday was the second straight quality start for Nashville and the third of the series. Including his final five starts of the 2024 season with Nashville, Patrick has four quality starts in his last six Triple-A games. He also posted five quality starts in his 18 starts with Milwaukee this year before being optioned back to Nashville. Including Friday night, the Brewers and Sounds are 2-4 in his six quality starts. The Sounds have 16 quality starts out of their rotation this season and are 10-6 in such games.

HOME RUNS: All nine combined runs scored on Friday night between Nashville and Durham were courtesy of the long ball. Tanner Murray's walk-off home run was the second allowed by the Sounds this year. Norfolk's Fernando Peguero hit the first on June 12. It was the fifth overall walk-off loss for the Sounds in 2025.

DAZ HOW IT'S DONE: Playing in his second game with Nashville since being optioned back after 21 games with the Brewers, Daz Cameron led off Thursday's game with his seventh home run in 13 games played with the Sounds. It was his third leadoff home run, and second against Durham after also hitting one on April 25th at First Horizon Park. Each of the last two Sounds games to start in a delay were followed by leadoff home runs. Blake Perkins hit the only other leadoff home run for Nashville in the series finale in Jacksonville after an hour and a half rain delay. Cameron ended the night 2-for-4 for his seventh multi-hit game with Nashville and is hitting .358 with 12 extra-base hits and 19 RBI.

OLD CRAIG: Craig Yoho worked his seventh straight game without allowing an earned run after working 1.1 IP with a hit and two strikeouts on Thursday night. Through 26 appearances with the Sounds this season, Yoho has stretches of 12 games and now seven without an earned run allowed. He owns a 0.93 ERA in 29.0 IP and has 35 strikeouts to 12 walks and has allowed just 18 hits. He has 22 scoreless appearances, and five that are an inning-plus.

COUNTDOWN TO 65: Nashville got to 50 wins on the season with the win over Memphis on Sunday to take the series. It's the earliest the Nashville had gotten to 50 wins since the 2022 season when they picked up their 50th win on July 7 and were 50-30 on the year. The team got to 50 wins in 2009 on July 11th (89 G), July 14th in 2006 (92 G), and on July 8, 2025 (89 G). **Rick Sweet is now 13 wins away from passing Buddy Bailey for the third-most wins by a Minor League manager in history.**

STATING THE PAX: Nashville trainer Jeff Paxson will serve as the Athletic Trainer for the American League during the All-Star Futures Game in Atlanta on Saturday as part of MLB All-Star Weekend. Paxson was honored as the Professional Baseball Athletic Trainers Society Minor League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2024 and earned this assignment as part of the award. It is the second time Paxson has served as the AT at the Futures Game from being named PBATS ATC of the Year, also doing so in 2012 in Kansas City. Paxson is in his fourth straight season with Nashville, ninth overall (2005-09) with the Sounds, and his 31st season with the Brewers. He is the two-time reigning IL Trainer of the Year and has nine Trainer of the Year awards in the minor leagues between the Midwest League, California League, Pacific Coast League, and International League.

- Currently ranked as the no. 6-ranked prospect in the Brewers top 30...no. 2-ranked RHP behind Jacob Misiorowski.
- Made his Major League debut in 2025 and tossed a quality start in his first career start (6.0 IP, 3 H, ER, HR, 9 K, BB) against the Athletics...Through first four MLB starts is 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (14 H, 4 ER, 29 K, 6 BB)...One of two MLB pitchers since 1901 to have struck out at least 29 and allowed four or fewer runs through first four MLB starts...Joined fellow Brewer Freddy Peralta.
- Got a late start to his 2024 season after injuring his oblique during the 2024 Spring Breakout Game...Made his season debut on May 9th in the Arizona Complex League.
- Earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month as well as Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2024 after going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in four starts...Held opposing hitter to a .192 AVG and matched his single-game career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN and 6/28 vs. PNS).
- From the time of his first start with High-A Wisconsin on May 24th until he was promoted to Nashville (8/8) he led the Brewers farm system with his 78 strikeouts.
- Made his Triple-A debut on 8/9/24 and allowed one run on three hits over 4.0 IP but took the loss...Tossed a quality start in his second game vs. DUR (6.0 IP, 0 R, 8 K, 3 H).
- Finished the 2024 season 8th in the Milwaukee farm system in strikeouts (104) and was T-8th in wins (7)...Added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19th. 35.2% strikeout rate was fourth best among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP in 2023.
- Missed the majority of 2022 after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring.
- Pitched one season at McLennan CC in Texas and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 games (14 GS)...Led NJCAA DI in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Struck out 17 over 8.0 IP with one run allowed to guide the Highlanders to their first championship since 1983.
