LATE TULSA RALLY SENDS CARDS TO 6-2 LOSS: The Tulsa Drillers scored five unanswered runs in the sixth and seventh innings combined as the Cardinals fell 6-2 in the rubber match of a seven-game series at Hammons Field on Sunday night. The Cards concluded their 13-game homestand 5-8. Bryan Torres had two hits for Springfield, while Jimmy Crooks and Matt Lloyd each drove in a run. Trent Baker tied a season high with 5.0 IP but took the loss in his 3rd start of the season. The Cardinals have now dropped three straight series.



**OPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Zebby Matthews** makes his 4th start of the season for Wichita in the series opener, and 8th overall...Last pitched on Wednesday, May 22 against San Antonio and allowed 2 R (1 ER) on 3 H with 8 K over 6.0 IP... Walked his first batter of the season... The Wind Surge lost the game 4-3 in 10 innings...In 3 starts with Wichita has struck out 23 batters with just 1 BB...For the season between High-A Cedar Rapids and the WInd Surge has 51 K's to just 1 BB in 40.1 IP...Began the season with Cedar Rapids and went 3-0 with a 1.59 ERA, striking out 28 with no walks in 4 starts (22.2 IP)...Spent the 2023 season between Low-A Fort Myers and Cedar Rapids going 7-3 with a 3.84 ERA in 22 appearances (20 starts), registering a 112:15 K:BB in 105.1 IP...Selected by the Twins in the 8th rund of the 2022 draft out of Western Carolina, signing for below slot \$125,000...Fastball has ticked up to the mid-to-upper 90's after entering Twins system...Pitched in both a starting and relief role as a junior at WCU going 4-6 with a 3.67 EA and a Southern Conference-leading 122 K to just 21 BB...Began college career at Walters

The Cardinals won 4 out of 5 at ONEOK Field from April 30-May 4. The Cards and Drillers played a doubleheader on Wednesday to make up for the postponement on May 5.

#### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

TEXAS LEAGUE SCOREBOARD



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**TOUGH STRETCH:** After winning 3 of their first 5 series, the Cardinals have now lost three straight sets, dropping Springfield to 3-4-1 in overall series. During this stretch spanning their last 19 games, the Cards are 7-12 and have been outscored by 29 runs, dropping their run differential from +17 to -12. Springfield has allowed 5.9 runs per game during that stretch.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERRE: The Cardinals have had one of the top offenses in the Texas League all season long, but the Springfield bats have heated up again during this current homestand. Over their last 8 games, the Cardinals are batting .308 and are second in OBP (.367) and OPS (.818) in the Texas League during that time. During their 13 game homestand, the Cardinals had 8 games with 9 or more hits.

For the season, Springfield leads all of Double-A in batting average (.271), OBP (.354), and hits (397).

**GRINDIN':** Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 316 times in 45 games, the 3rd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (310 K's in 44 games) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers have struck out the 2nd-fewest times with 311 K's. Springfield is averaging just 7.02 K's per game.

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 35 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 34 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 136 of the 253 total runs scored by the opposition, 53.8% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 9.7% of their innings pitched. In the other 347.2 IP Springfield has allowed 114 runs, which comes out to 2.95 runs per 9 innings.

**SEARCHING FOR LONGBALL ELIXIR:** So far this season the Cardinals have been victims of the longball, getting dinged for 55 home runs in just 45 games, the most in Double-A. The Cards have allowed at least one home run in 11 of their last 13 games.

**HOT CORNER, HOT BAT:** After a slow start to the season, Cardinals INF **Jacob Buchberger** has gotten red hot over the last month. Since coming into play on April 14 batting .087, Springfield's 3B is batting .359 (32-for-89) over his last 26 games, and has hit safely in all but 3 of them. He has two separate 8-game hitting streaks during that stretch.

**Buchberger** is currently riding a career-high 11-game hitting streak, the longest active streak in the Texas League. During his hitting streak, **Buchberger** is batting .463 (19-for-41) with a double, a triple and a home run. He has multiple hits in 7 of his last 8 and 8 of his last 10 games.

**TABLE SETTERS:** The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, **Bryan Torres**, **Nathan Church**, and **Mike Antico** have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, the trio is batting .319 (125-for-391) with 72 R, 23 2B, 27 SB, 9 CS and have struck out a combined 59 times for a 13.4% K rate.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .308 (2nd in Texas League), and the Cardinals are hitting a league-leading .297 out of the 2-hole. Combined, the Cardinals batting .302 between the two spots in the lineup, tops in the league.

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 19 straight games without a home run.


