The Round Rock Express face the Albuquerque Isotopes in the six-game series finale on Tuesday afternoon at Isotopes Park. Express RHP Tyson Miller is scheduled to get the start against Isotopes RHP José Mujica. First pitch is set for 1:05 p.m. CT.

### RECAPING LAST NIGHT

The Round Rock Express fell by a final score of 9-5 to the Albuquerque Isotopes on Monday night at Isotopes Park. The Express found home plate first as LF Steele Walker scored on a wild pitch in the top of the first inning. Albuquerque tied the contest a 1-1 in the bottom of the frame when LF Joshua Fuentes hit a solo home run. Round Rock gained a 2-1 edge in the fifth when CF Carl Chester scored thanks to a sacrifice fly from 2B Trace Loehr. The Isotopes then took a 3-2 lead in the bottom of the inning as 2B Taylor Snyder hit a two-run dinger. The two teams traded three runs each in the sixth frame as Express C John Hicks and RF Elmer Hernandez crossed home on a double from DH Curtis Terry, who followed as SS Charles Leblanc hit a sacrifice fly. In the bottom of the inning, Isotopes 3B Colton Welker scored on an Alan Trejo single before DH Greg Bird and C Brian Serven were driven home on a base hit from CF Wynton Bernard for a 6-5 lead. Albuquerque increased their advantage to 9-5 in the eighth when Bird came home as Trejo hit the third Albuquerque homer of the contest. Bernard then scored the contest's final run thanks to a two-out Nick Longhi single.

### BACK ON THE BUMP

Round Rock RHP Tyson Miller is back on the bump after starting in the series opener on Thursday. Miller tossed 5.0 innings that saw one Isotopes run on three hits and one walk en route to the win. The righty struck out five in his outing.

### EVEN MORE DEBUTS

Express RHP David Kubiak made his Triple-A debut on Monday night with a start for Round Rock that lasted 5.0 frames. The righty's outing saw three runs, including two home runs, on five total hits. He struck out five of the batters he faced as 54 of his 77 total pitches landed in the strike zone.

### A RARE OCCURENCE

Round Rock C Jose Felix entered the game during the eighth inning to pitch in relief as he recorded the final out of the frame, a fly out to center field. Felix became the second position player to pitch for the Express so far this season after C Blake Grant-Parks recorded one out in relief on June 8 against El Paso.

### LOOKING INTO THE SERIES

After their win on Monday night, Albuquerque currently leads the 12-game season series 7-4 over Round Rock. The Isotopes are 7-0 in games played to a full nine innings while the Express are 4-0 in games completed in less than nine innings. Round Rock won a rain-shortened, five-inning game at Dell Diamond earlier this season before taking both rain-shortened contests at Isotopes Park to begin the current series, as well as the seven-inning nightcap of Sunday's modified doubleheader.

### HITTING THE RIGHT STRIDE

Express 2B Trace Loehr recorded his fifth multi-hit game over 26 appearances this season with Round Rock. Hitting in the No. 2 spot, the infielder finished Monday's contest 2-3 with a double and an RBI. Loehr has hit .267 (4-15) with two doubles through the first five contests in Albuquerque. He has worked one walk against the Isotopes and struck out six times.

### ACTION UP TOP

RHP A.J. Alexy made his major league debut with the Texas Rangers on Monday evening as the Rangers defeated the Colorado Rockies 4-3. Alexy allowed just one hit in his shutout 5.0-inning start, which earned him the winning decision and marked the first time since May 2, 1992 that a Texas pitcher has worked at least 5.0 innings with one or fewer hits in his first big league performance.

## ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Thirty four members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP A.J. Alexy, INF Sherten Apostel, RHP Kohei Arihara, RHP Jason Bahr, RHP Blake Bass, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, C Jose Felix, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, INF Josh Jung, LHP John King, C Jack Kruger, RHP David Kubiak, LHP Jake Latz, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Yerry Rodriguez, RHP Ryder Ryan, RHP Nick Snyder, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Tyler Thomas, RHP Cole Uvila, OF Steele Walker, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Apostel, Evans, King, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels while RHP Kohei Arihara and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

## STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 12 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas, Virginia and Washington. Justin Anderson, Blake Bass, Josh Jung, Jake Lemoine and Steele Walker represent the native Texans on the roster. Anderson hails from Houston and attended the University of Texas at San Antonio. Bass is originally from Lubbock and played at Angelo State. Jung hails from San Antonio and competed collegiately at Texas Tech. Lemoine hails from Bridge City and was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston. Finally, Walker was born in Prosper before a college career at Oklahoma.

## AROUND THE WORLD

Five different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 26 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Sherten Apostel was born in Curacao, C Jose Felix, OF Elier Hernandez and RHP Yerry Rodriguez hail from the Dominican Republic and RHP Kohei Arihara is Japanese.

## EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
