LAST TIME OUT

WORCESTER, MA (September 2, 2025) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders came back from a five-run deficit to beat the Worcester Red Sox 8-7 at Polar Park on Tuesday night. A seven-run seventh propelled the RailRiders to a win in the series opener.

Worcester opened the scoring in the bottom of the first with an RBI triple from Kristian Campbell. In the fourth, Mikey Romero led off with his fifth Triple-A home run of the year, extending the WooSox advantage to 2-0. Campbell hit a three-run homer to left in the fifth to give Worcester a 5-0 lead. Braden Shewmake led off the sixth with a triple and scored on a groundout by Jorbit Vivas, breaking a scoreless inning drought of 24.2 innings. The RailRiders sent 12 batters to the plate in the seventh, scoring seven runs on seven hits. Jeimer Candelario singled in Brennan Davis to cut the Worcester lead to three. A groundout by Shewmake brought home a second run. MLB rehabber Austin Slater walked to load the bases with two outs and Vivas doubled to tie the game at five. Spencer Jones followed with a two-run double of his own for a 7-5 SWB lead and Davis singled in Jones to build an 8-5 advantage. Campbell added a two-run double in the bottom of the eighth to cut the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre lead to one run. The outfielder finished with six runs batted in and a single shy of a cycle.

The RailRiders were shut down over the first five innings by Connelly Early. The Red Sox Number #6 prospect allowed hits to the first two batters he faced, retired 15 in a row and, ultimately, struck out 10. Sean Boyle allowed the first five runs over four-plus innings. After a scoreless frame from Jake Bird, Wilking Rodriguez (2-1) worked a scoreless sixth and was the beneficiary of the run support. Kervin Castro notched the final four outs for his fourth save. Bryan Mata (3-3) was tagged with the blown save and the loss.

NEWS & NOTES

THE CHASE- As play begins today, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre holds a four-game edge on Syracuse for the International League's second-half title. Toledo is five games back and Indianapolis remains six games out with 17 games to play. The winner of the second-half crown will play at Jacksonville in a best-of-three series starting on September 23.

HONOR ROLL- Minor League Baseball has announced its weekly awards for August 26-31, and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's **Jose Rojas** was tabbed as the International League's Player of the Week. Rojas hit .471 in five games against the Syracuse Mets last week, going 8-for-17 at the plate with three doubles, four home runs, nine run batted in and four walks. His 23 total bases led all International League players for the week, as did his 1.353 slugging percentage. Rojas is the second RailRider to earn a weekly honor this year, joining pitcher Erick Leal, who was tabbed as the Pitcher of the Week for July 29 through August 3. It is the fourth time in Rojas' career that he has been tabbed as a league's weekly award winner.

HIT ME- The RailRiders seven-hit barrage in the seventh last night was the most hits they have accumulated in any one half inning this season, surpassing several six-hit frames.

STREAKING AGAIN- Tuesday's win at Worcester was the fourth consecutive road victory, matching the longest road winning streak of the season for the third time.

SERIES BUSINESS- After a series split last week against Syracuse, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has now won or split 14 consecutive series since going 1-4 in Nashville from May 21 through 24.

COOLER THAN COOL- The RailRiders travel to Polar Park for just the second time this season. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre swept a three-game set at Worcester from July 18-20 out of the Major League All-Star break. The RailRiders hold a 12-4 advantage against the WooSox this season.

DANCING IN SEPTEMBER- J.C. Escarra was recalled by the Yankees on Monday. In addition, **Ryan Yarbrough** returned to New York from his MLB Rehab Assignment and was activated off the 15-Day Injured List by the Yankees.

FIRST TIME/ LONG TIME- The RailRiders have now been blanked six times in 129 games played this season. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre had not been shut out in consecutive games in over three years, having last been held scoreless in two straight on May 12 and 13, 2022, against Syracuse at PNC Field.

RECORD BOOK ROJAS- **Jose Rojas** leads the International League with 65 extra-base hits this season and has set a new Scranton/Wilkes-Barre record in the process with 19 games to go. He passed Marlon Anderson's 1998 record of 62 extra-base hits with seven more last week. Rojas is also chasing single-season franchise marks in doubles, total bases, runs batted in, and slugging percentage.

THE FINAL STRETCH™- The RailRiders have two road trips and one homestand remaining on the 2025 calendar. After this week's series at Worcester, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre hosts Lehigh Valley and returns to Buffalo to close out the 2025 slate.

AROUND THE ORGANIZATION- New York beat Houston 7-1. Jazz Chisholm, Jr., homered twice and Trent Grisham hit a grand slam to pace the series-opening win... Somerset blanked New Hampshire 1-0. George Lombard, Jr. drove in the only run of the day in the eighth inning... Hudson Valley beat Greensboro 4-0 to pull within 3.5 games with five to go. Brandon Decker threw five scoreless and struck out six for the 'Gades... Tampa lost 6-5 to Clearwater in 10 innings. Five different players drove in a run in the loss.

CAREER:

2024: Maeda signed a two-year, \$24 million, contract with the Detroit Tigers on 11/28/23.... Completed his first season in Detroit, appearing in 29 games (17 starts), posting a 3-7 record with a 6.09 ERA... Became the 12th Japanese-born pitcher to appear in 200-or-more games on June 5 vs. Texas... Recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his Major League career on July 9 vs. Cleveland... joined Yu Darvish (1,982) and Hideo Nomo (1,918) as the only Japanese-born pitchers to reach that milestone...

2023: Returned to the mound, making 21 appearances (20 starts) with Minnesota...

2022: Missed the entire season recovering from Tommy John surgery on his right elbow...

PERSONAL:

Compiled a 97-67 record with a 2.39 ERA in 218 games (217 starts) in eight seasons in the JCL with the Hiroshima Carp (2008-15)... Was a two-time winner of the Sawamura Award, given to the best pitcher in Japanese baseball... In 2010, won Japan's pitching triple crown with 15 wins (15-8), a 2.21 ERA and 174 strikeouts, becoming the youngest pitcher (22) in Japanese baseball history to accomplish the feat. Pitched for Japan in the 2013 World Baseball Classic and was named to the All-Tournament Team... signed by Los Angeles (NL) as a non-drafted free agent on Jan. 7, 2016... named to the Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team that season... named to the All-MLB Second Team in 2020 with the Minnesota Twins.
