LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their first game of the season on Saturday afternoon, as they were walked-off by the Hartford Yard Goats, 6-5 in 10 innings, Bowie got out to an early 1-0 lead in the top of the second, as C Ramon Rodriguez smacked a double to center field, scoring Donta' Williams. However, starter Cade Povich struggled out of the gate. The southpaw got out of a jam in the first, before allowing a two-run single to Bladimir Restituyo to give the Baysox their first deficit of the season at 2-1. Ultimately, Povich was only able to go three innings into the contest. The Bowie bullpen held serve for a while, with Peter Van Loon allowing a run in two innings, while Houston Roth also managed a scoreless frame, along with a scoreless seventh from Kade Strowd. Meanwhile, the Bowie bats restored the lead via a two-run home run from OF John Rhodes in the fourth, along with RBIs from INF Coby Mayo and Gilbert Lara later on. However, in the bottom of the eighth, familiar problems from last season resurfaced for Bowie. An error from 1B Heston Kierstad and two walks from Strowd loaded the bases with nobody out. Hartford scored two in the frame via a groundout and Conner Loeprich wild pitch to tie the game. The Yard Goats went on to walk-off the game in the tenth, when their courtesy

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron Rubberducks return fifteen players from a squad that missed the Eastern League playoffs via a tiebreaker in the first half, and finished just two games off the pace in the second half. In its inaugural series of 2023, Akron dropped two of three games at home against the Erie Seawolves, falling in the rubber match 3-2 in 11 innings on Saturday night. Seven of the Guardians' top 30 prospects begin the 2023 campaign with Akron, including a debut Double-A stints for OF Petey Halpin (No. 17 CLE). Halpin hit .262 with six home runs, four triples, and 16 stolen bases for High-A Lake County last season and is off to a 3-for-12 start with a stolen base in 2023 as a tone-setter atop the Akron lineup. INF Angel Martinez (No. 10 CLE) hit .244 in 24 games for Akron last season and has continued to develop in the offseason, putting successful shifts together in both the Arizona Fall League and Guardians Spring Training. INF Jose Tena (No. 24 CLE) hit .264 in 127 games with 13 home runs for Akron in 2022 but did not feature in either of the two last games against Erie. The RubberDucks have four arms inside of the Guardians' top 30, including righthander Gavin Williams (No. 2 CLE) and southpaw Joey Cantillo (No. 19 CLE), the latter of whom was a 2022 Eastern League All-Star with a 1.93 ERA in 60.2 innings.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Akron opens the series by sending out right-hander Tanner Burns. The 36th overall pick in the 2020 draft by Cleveland, Burns is currently the No. 22 overall prospect in the Guardians system. He pitched for Akron through the entirety of 2022, going 3-7 with a 3.55 ERA in 21 starts spanning 88.2 innings. In general, Burns had a rougher go away from home, with a 4.20 road ERA in 2022. However, he had two successful starts at Prince George's Stadium, where he allowed three earned runs across 10.1 innings – good for a 2.61 ERA against one of the best lineups in the Eastern League throughout last season. Burns was very effective at getting out of jams for Akron in 2022, holding opponents to just a .107 average with runners in scoring position. Tuesday night will be his first appearance this season.

HOME OPENER HISTORY

Tuesday night will be the home opener for the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie has lost five of its last seven home openers, dating back to 2015. The last time the Baysox opened at home against Akron was 2016. Bowie lost three of the four games in the series, with the other contest being rained out, including a 5-2 defeat in the official home opener.

WATER UNDER THE BRIDGE?

Bowie and Akron have shared a lot of late-season drama over the past two years. Last season, both teams knocked one another out of postseason contention in the final series of the regular season. First, the Baysox eliminated the RubberDucks from the second-half title race on 9/16 via a 10-3 win, before Akron returned the favor two days later, on the final day of the regular season, with an 8-5 triumph over Bowie. In 2021, the RubberDucks swept the Baysox to win their sixth Eastern League title.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto kicked off 2023 with a great offensive display in Hartford. After going 0-for-5 on Opening Day, Prieto bounced back with consecutive three-hit games for the first time in his minor league career, including three RBI in Friday's 5-3 win. Preito's six hits tie him atop the Eastern

LOOKING TO STALL THE LONG BALL

Right-hander Garrett Stallings gets his first start of the season tonight. Last season was a mixed bag for Stallings - included in that was Stallings surrendering a franchise-record 27 home runs. Stallings had a rough time in June and July, allowing 18 home runs, before closing out the season on a better note, yielding eight in the final three months. Stallings only allowed one long ball to Akron through 24 innings in 2022 – his fewest of any opponent. The right-hander did not allow a run, and gave up only three hits and two walks, while striking out 12, in his two starts against the RubberDucks at Prince George's Stadium last summer.
