

HIGH-A AFFILIATE OF THE NEW YORK METS



LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped their third straight to Hudson Valley, 3-0, in front of a season-high 7,221 fans for Seinfeld Night...The Renegades scored all three runs in the top of the fourth on a two-run CF Jackson Castillo triple and a wild pitch...RHP Josh Grosz (6.0 IP), LHP Joel Valdez (1.2), and RHP Yorlin Calderón (1.1) combined on the three-hit shutout for Hudson Valley, earning the win, hold, and save, respectively...LHP Zach Thornton suffered the loss for Brooklyn, allowing only one run on two hits in 3.1 innings...RHPs Ben Simon (1.1 IP, 2 K) and Eduardo Herrera (2.0, 1 H, 4 K) united for 3.1 frames of spotless relief, allowing one hit and striking out six.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On August 11, 2006, RHPs Tobi Stoner (7.0 IP), Jeremy Mizell (1.0), and David Koons (1.0) combined on a five-hit shutout in a 5-0 win at Lowell...In 2009, Brooklyn erased a 3-1 ninth-inning deficit, scoring three runs on a LF Scott Grimes single and error and a C Dock Doyle single to defeat Mahoning Valley on the road, 4-2... In 2019, down 4-1 after six innings, the Cyclones scored six in the seventh and four in the eighth to win 11-4 at Staten Island...Brooklyn tied the game on a 3B José Peroza two-run double and took the lead on a three-run home run by IB Joe Genord, who finished the day with six runs batted in...In 2022, after surrendering a one-run ninth-inning lead and trading runs in the 11th, C José Mena provided the go-ahead run-scoring ground out in the top of the 12th in a 7-6 triumph at Wilmington...In 2023, RHPs Joander Suárez (6.0 IP, 11 K) and Brendan Hardy (3.0, 2) united on a three-hit, 13-strikeout shutout in a 5-0 victory vs. Aberdeen.

LET'S PLAY TWO: After Friday's rainout, Sunday marks the Cyclones' fourth doubleheader in 12 days...From Opening Day until July 28, Brooklyn played just two twinbills...Brooklyn split their third-straight twinbill on Wednesday, walking off with a 3-2 win in Game 1 before dropping Game 2, 7-0...Brooklyn is 5-5 in doubleheader games this year and 1-1-3 in doubleheaders overall...In 2023, the Cyclones were 0-4-2 in doubleheaders overall and 2-10 in games.

WENN IN BROOKLYN: RHP Jack Wenninger suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...Over his last four appearances (three starts) since July 14 at Wilmington, the 22-year-old has no record, but a 1.72 ERA (3 ER in 15.2 IP) and one hold...Wenninger has surrendered 13 hits and nine walks while striking out 19 in that span...The Barrington, III. native's 1.72 ERA ranks seventh in the South Atlantic League in that time among pitchers with 15.0 or more innings of work

MORABITO BITE: OF Nick Morabito has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old is hitting .328/.400/.388 with a .788 OPS in 18 games since the All-Star break...The McLean, Va. native is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (49)...With two swipes (39) on Thursday, he broke OF Omar De Los Santos' single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (84), is second in stolen bases (38), fifth in batting average (.288), sixth in runs scored (49), and 10th in on-base percentage (.364)...The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (38), sixth in batting average (.292), and 10th in on-base percentage (.364) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.311), stolen bases (49), on-base percentage (.403), and hits (115)...He is also third in runs scored (63) and total bases (144), tied for third in triples (4), fourth in OPS (.792), and fifth in walks (50).

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit and third among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (93)...Tong also holds a league-best batting average against (.213) in addition to ranking second in ERA (3.63), third in WHIP (1.28), and tied for ninth in innings pitched (69.1)...The 93 strikeouts are also good for ninth in the circuit overall...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (2.15), fourth in strikeout rate (35.2%), sixth in strikeouts (129), and eighth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.9%).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28 and has homered in six of his last 18 games since July 13 at Wilmington...Five of those six home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones return to Coney Island for their final six-game series of 2024 against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades have six of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF George Lombard Jr. (6), LHP Kyle Carr (11), INF Roc Riggio (17), RHP Cade Smith (20), OF Anthony Hall (27). and OF Jace Avina (29)...Brooklyn and Hudson Valley split a home-and-home series (July 1-6) after the Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley 1-6). 1-6) after the Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley on Coney Island (May 23-28)...Hudson Valley won 4-of-6 in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...On the year, the series is tied 9-9...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all time parties 150,156 (400). trails the all-time series, 150-156 (.490)

All-Star break, Omar is tied for second in the league in triples (2), tied for third in home runs (5), fifth in slugging (.569), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (8), tied for seventh in total bases (33), and tied for eighth in runs scored (12)... Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fifth in the South Atlantic League for the year with 35 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer**'s (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (72) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (72) and is fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (144). League Baseball in swiped bags (144).

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP Justin Lawson tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of last Sunday's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just two hits and one walk, striking out four...Lawson has not allowed an earned run in his last 13.0 linnings dating back to July 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winnfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.70 ERA (2 ER in 25.2 IP), earning two saves...No South Atlantic League reliever with 20.0 or more innings pitched since June 15 has a lower ERA than Lawson (0.70).

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF Kellum Clark snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 23 games...Since July 6, he has been hitting .304/.375/.342 with a .717 OPS, eight runs scored, three doubles, three runs batted in, and three stolen bases over the 23 games.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: For the fourth time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B Jacob Reimer's two-run single in the bottom of the seventh in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B Jefrey De Los Santos blasted a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth before LF Omar De Los Santos followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS William Lugo and CF Stanley Consuegra clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B Nick Lorusso smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in the last 10 home affairs on July 19, via C Chris Suero's game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS Wilfredo Lara's walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.75% of all defeats, including 26.47% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 237 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.66%)...The Cyclones have also earned 23 wins in their last at-bat. have also earned 23 wins in their last at-bat.

SHUT IT: Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are three behind Rome (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (10), RHP Jonah Tong (17), INF Jacob Reimer (22), RHP Jack Wenninger (27), and RHP Calvin Ziegler (30)... Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL... Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Reimer (14), Tong (18), Báez (20), Ziegler (21), OF Nick Morabito (23), and Wenninger (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision pitching in relief for Double-A Binghamton in Game 2 of last Sunday's doubleheader vs New Hampshire...Entered in support of RHPs Jonathan Pintaro (0.2 IP), Cameron Foster (1.1), Junior Santos (2.0), and Joshua Cornielly (2.0) in the top of the seventh and Binghamton trailing 5-1...Did not allow a run or a hit over an inning of work...Did not issue a walk and struck out two...Threw 12 pitches and 8 strikes (66.67%).. The Rumble Ponies dropped the finale to the Fisher Cats, 5-1...Binghamton dropped the opener to New Hampshire, 3-0.

ON THE MOVE: Hawkins started the season with Brooklyn before joining Double-A Binghamton on July 29...Made two appearances (one start) with the Rumble Ponies, allowing four runs on four hits walking three and striking out three, over 4.0 innings...Rejoined the Cyclones on August 5.

**YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT:** Hawkins, **Joey Lancellot-** Y ti (1.0), and Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-in- $_2$ ning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP Joander Suárez hurled a seven-inning effort on September 7 at Hartford... It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP Sal Maglie tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HAWK IS:** The Chehalis, Wash. native has thrived in the pitcher-friendly confines of Maimonides Park in 2024... Hawkins holds a 2-1 record and a 3.62 ERA (13 ER in 32.1 IP) with seven walks and 25 strikeouts in 11 appearances (three starts) at home...ln visiting ballparks, the 24-year-old's mark dips to 1-2 with a 5.03 ERA (19 ER in 34.0 IP), 13 walks, and 36 strikeouts in 10 games (five starts)... Hawkins also holds a 1.08 WHIP on Coney Island and a WHIP of 1.35 in all other parks.

2023: Signed with the New York Mets as an undrafted free agent out of Washington State University on July 19, 2023... Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Made a pair of scoreless relief appearances before being transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 26...Did not allow a run on two hits over 6.0 innings with the Mets...Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

WAZZOU WIZARD: The Chehalis, Wash. native had an outstanding career at Washington State University...After starting his collegiate tenure with two years at Lower Columbia College (Longview, Wash.), Hawkins went on to be named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention in 2023... In 14 starts, he accrued a 5-3 record with a 4.32 ERA (35 ER in 73.0 IP) with 27 walks and 92 strikeouts...His 92 K's were fourth in the conference and ninth-most in a single-season at Washington State.

REPERTOIRE: Fastball, Slider, Sweeper, Changeup

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth loss with Brooklyn in Game 1 of last Sunday's doubleheader at Aberdeen...Permitted one run on two hits over 4.0 innings...Walked a season-high-tying three and struck out two... Surrendered a solo home run to DH Douglas Hodo in the bottom of the first...Tossed a wild pitch...Threw 63 pitches and 33 strikes (52.38%)... Relieved by RHP Eduardo Herrera to start the bottom of the fifth and Brooklyn trailing 1-0...The Cyclones went on to drop the lid-lifter, 5-2...After trailing 4-0, Brooklyn rallied to win the finale over the IronBirds, 6-4.

PICKING UP STEAM: Ramírez has arguably pitched his best over the last few weeks...Since June 22, the 22-year-old has registered a 1-1 record with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER in 24.0 IP), 11 walks, and 16 strikeouts in eight outings (one start) between Brooklyn and Triple-A Syracuse...When narrowed to his last five appearances, Ramírez has yielded one earned run over his last 12.1 innings (0.73 ERA), allowing six hits and eight walks, while collecting 13 strikeouts and holding opponents to a .135 average (6-37).

**ROLE OUT:** Ramírez split time between the rotation and the bullpen with the Cyclones in 2024...The 22-year-old has thrived as a starter, collecting a 1-1 record with a 2.29 ERA (5 ER in 19.2 IP), eight walks, and 12 strikeouts in five starts...In nine outings in relief, Ramírez is 2-2 with a 4.97 ERA (14 ER in 25.1 IP), 11 walks, and 19 strikeouts.

2024: Returned from Triple-A Syracuse on August 1...Made one scoreless appearance on July 31 at Columbus (1.0 IP)...Transferred to Syracuse on July 31...Made 13 appearances (four starts) in first stint with Brooklyn, posting a 3-3 record with a 3.95 ERA (18 ER in 41.0 IP), 16 walks, and 29 strikeouts...Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 14... Posted a 1-1 record with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP), 10 walks, and 16 strikeouts in eight relief appearances for the Mets...Earned the win out of the bullpen on Opening Day, April 5 vs. Daytona, striking out a season-best six over three frames...Among Florida State League relievers with 16.0+ innings pitched at the time of his promotion, Ramírez was sixth in batting average against (.182) and opposing OPS (.573).

THE WHOLE NINE YARDS: Ramírez's Cyclones debut was one to remember...The 22-year-old was the only Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the ninth inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of three-run ball...Ramírez allowed six hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete eight-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP Conner Grey carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a nine-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a one-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.
