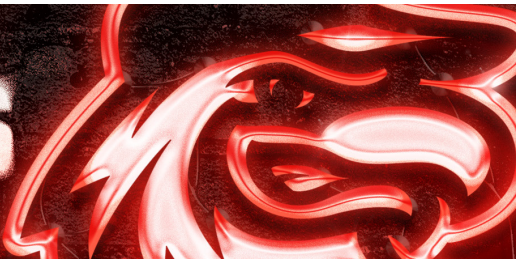

### WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg moved to 3-1 in the second half last night, beating Chesapeake (BAL) 8-3...**C CALEB LOMAVITA** finished a double shy of the cycle, going 3-for-4 with four RBI, a walk, and two runs scored.

**✓ CHECK MATE:** On a muggy Friday evening in Charlotte, the Rochester Red Wings evened the series at two games apiece against the Charlotte Knights with a final score of 6-2...LHP **ZACH PENROD** provided a near-flawless 3.0 inning effort in his sixth start (27th app.) of the season, and RHP **ROBERT CRANZ** picked up his first Triple-A win with 1.0 scoreless inning in relief...CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** ignited the Red Wings' offense with a two-run homer in the fourth, and 1B **ABIMELEC ORTIZ** kept the train moving with three hits that drove in three RBI over the course of the game...Rochester looks to climb back over .500 in the second half and take a 3-2 series lead in game five tonight, sending LHP **JACKSON KENT** to the mound against fellow Knights southpaw Shane Murphy..

**✓** Rochester is now 14-3 against left-handed starting pitchers this season.

**✓** The Red Wings are the only International League team, and one of two Triple-A teams (OKC) to score a run in every game in 2026.

**✓ COMPLETE KENT-ROL:** LHP **JACKSON KENT** will get the ball tonight for Rochester, his seventh Triple-A start and 14th of the season overall...his last start came on the final day of the first half, where the southpaw took the loss after allowing five earned on six hits across 3.0 innings, with three strikeouts and a walk...despite the loss, Kent still leads all Nationals Minor League pitchers (min. 50.0 IP) with a 1.02 WHIP and .202 batting average against, while ranking fifth with 70 total strikeouts...the Illinois native also owns the third-lowest road ERA in full-season MiLB (min. 25.0 IP), boasting a 1.01 mark (3 ER/26.2 IP) across six starts...he is also T-7th in WHIP (0.79), and T-13th in BAA (.152) away from home.

**✓ PINCK ME I MUST BE DREAMING:** CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** opened the scoring for the Red Wings last night, sending a 1-1 cutter 109.4 MPH the other way to right field for a two-run shot, his 11th of the season and second against a left-handed pitcher...the Alabama native finished the contest 2-for-3, adding a base knock in the sixth and a walk in the seventh...his homer marked the sixth-hardest-hit opposite field home run in the International League this year, surpassing his own 109.2 MPH shot against Toledo on 6/21 to give him the sixth and seventh spots on the leaderboard...he holds a share of the Triple-A lead with four homers in his last seven games since 6/19, hitting .370 (10-for-27) with an .815 SLG and 1.248 OPS over that stretch...

**✓** He now has 32 homers with Rochester since making his Triple-A debut in 2024, one shy of tying Jake Noll for second-most by a Red Wing in the Nationals era (since 2021) behind Travis Blankenhorn (49).

**✓ THREEBI-LEC:** 1B **ABIMELEC ORTIZ** was an on-base machine Friday night, logging three hits in five trips to the plate, extending his on-base streak to seven games, while also driving in three runners...he now has four multi-hit games this month, two of which have been three-hit games, the other being on 6/4 at LHV...the three RBI helped him get to 56 on the season, taking sole possession of third on the International League leaders list...Ortiz's four two-baggers this month is tied for second on the team alongside 3B **BRADY HOUSE**, behind LF **CHRISTIAN FRANKLIN**, who has six.

**✓ FULL HOUSE:** 3B **BRADY HOUSE** went 3-for-5 in yesterday's win, notching a double in the effort...the Georgia native extended his hitting streak to six consecutive games dating back to 6/20 vs. TOL...House also logged a run, scoring on a home run from CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY**...in June, the third baseman leads the Red Wings in batting average (.305) and hits (25)...over the course of his hitting streak, House has a .393 batting average (11-for-28), .433 on-base percentage, .500 slugging, and .933 OPS...

**✓** In 12 away games with Rochester this season, House is batting .345 (20-for-58), with four of his five doubles being hit outside of ESL Ballpark.

**✓ WRITTEN IN INK:** LHP **ZACH PENROD** worked 3.0 scoreless innings to kick things off on the mound last night, allowing just one hit while striking out a pair and walking one...this marked his longest start since 2024 as a member of the Worcester Red Sox, and his second strikeout was the 200th of his professional career (MLB & MiLB)...across six outings as a starter in 2026, the Idaho-born southpaw boasts a 2.00 ERA (2 ER/9.0 IP) with a .194 BAA.

**✓ 17 AGAIN:** DH **PHILLIP GLASSER** drew two walks and scored a run in last night's game...his two free passes extended his on-base streak to 17 games (since 5/27), the longest active streak on the team and the second-longest by a Red Wing this season, trailing only CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY**'s 20-game streak...over the course of his on-base streak, he leads all full-season Minor League hitters (min. 50 AB) with a .418 batting average, and ranks third in the International League with a .460 OBP.

### THIS DAY IN RED WINGS HISTORY...

**...1993:** 33 years ago today, RHP **KEVIN MCGEEHEE** twirled 11.0 masterful innings in a 3-2 win over Toledo at Silver Stadium...needing just 111 pitches, the 70th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 1987 allowed one earned run en route to his fourth Triple-A win...no Red Wing has thrown more than 9.0 innings in an outing since at least 2004...McGehee went on to win 28 games with Rochester in three seasons from 1993-95.

Entering his third professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the fourth round of the 2024 MLB Draft, out of the University of Arizona...named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/13/2025 with High-A Wilmington.

- When starting games on Saturdays this season, the lefty has a 1.50 ERA and 1.00 WHIP in two games between Double-A Harrisburg and Rochester.
- Made his Sixth start with Rochester on 6/21....on 6/10, he turned in his second quality start of 2026, and first as a Red Wing (6.0 IP, 1 ER)...has a road ERA of 1.01 (3 ER/26.2 IP) across six starts with Triple-A Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg, with a 0.79 WHIP and .152 BAA.
- Kent ranks sixth, and is one of nine qualified pitchers in full-season Minor League Baseball with a WHIP under 1.00 this season (0.95).
- Leads all Nationals MiLB pitchers with a .187 BAA, and ranks third with a 3.11 ERA (19 ER/55.0 IP) in 12 starts between Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...made seven starts with the team to start the season, logging a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with 38 strikeouts and eight walks, a 0.88 WHIP and .176 batting average against...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 5/21 for his Triple-A debut two days later.
- At the time of his promotion to Rochester, he led the Eastern League (min. 25.0 IP) in WHIP, held a share of the league-lead in fewest runs allowed (8), and ranked fourth in batting average against, H/9 (5.58) and K/BB (4.75)...turned in at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs in each of his last three starts, and four of his last five.
- Split his first professional season between High-A Wilmington (18 GS), and Double-A Harrisburg...combined to log a 4.61 ERA (63 ER/123.0 IP), with 132 strikeouts, 38 walks, a 1.22 WHIP and .243 batting average against.
- Began the season with High-A Wilmington...set career-highs with 7.2 innings pitched and 11 strikeouts on 5/6 vs. Hudson Valley (NYY)...turned in 6.0 scoreless innings in his final start with the team on 8/5, and was transferred to Harrisburg on 8/12 for his Double-A debut.
- Turned in at least 5.0 and struck out at least five batters in five of his six starts at Double-A.
