SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

SMASHING INTO THE LEAD: C/1B Wes Clarke hit his 24th home run of the year on Friday, putting himself atop the Southern League home run leader board... Clarke's 24 home runs are the most he's hit in any season of his college and professional career... His 24 home runs are also tied for the fifth-most out of any player in Double-A.

lf the season ended today, Clarke's 24 home runs would be the second-most by a Shuckers' player in franchise history (since 2015)... The single-season franchise record is 27, set by **OF Corey Ray** in 2018.

MULTI-HIT MADNESS: OF Carlos Rodriguez has record multiple hits in four of his last six games, including tying his careerhigh with four on Friday... Entering today, Rodriguez leads the Southern League with a .297 average.

- 📚 If the season ended today, Rodriguez would own the third-highest single-season average in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... The only Shuckers player to finish the season in the top-three for the batting title was 18 Patrick Leonard, who finished runner-up in 2019 after hitting .301... No Shucker has won the Southern league batting title.
- 📚 In September, Rodriguez has tallied a hit in six of seven games, hitting .464 (13-24) with three doubles... Rodriguez has tallied a hit in 22 of his last 29 games since the start of August.

ONE OF A KIND: OF Jackson Chourio tallied his 40th stolen base of the year on Thursday, becoming the first Double-A player since at least 2005 to record at least 20 home runs and 40 stolen bases in a season... Chourio is also one of three players in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to reach 40 stolen bases in a season, joining INF Tyler Black (47, 2023) and OF Johnny Davis (52, 2017)... Chourio previously became the first teenager in Double-A and/or Triple-A to record a 20/20 season since **OF Delmon Young** in 2005.

BEST IN CLASS: Baseball-America released their Double-A Best Tools and Prospects Awards on Tuesday, as voted on by league managers... The Shuckers took home several Southern League honors, including; OF Jackson Chourio - Best Batting Prospect and Most Exciting Player, INF Tyler Black - Best Strike-Zone Judgment and RHP Jacob Misiorowski -Best Fastball.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would miss the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs for the first time since 2019; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

The Shuckers are a 1.5 games behind the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead with eight games remaining... The two teams will face each other for the final six games of the year at MGM Park... As it stands today, the Shuckers would need to win four of six against the Biscuits to make the playoffs.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TOBIAS MYERS [9-5, 5.27]: RHP Tobias Myers makes his third start of the road trip and his 25th start of the year... Entering today, Myers is seven strikeouts away from breaking the Shuckers' single-season record, set by RHP Alec Bettinger at 157 in 2019... Myers has gone at least six innings in each of his last three road starts... Last time out, he tied his career-high with seven innings, striking out seven to help secure Biloxi's first series sweep against the Tennessee Smokies since 2019.
