Prospecting: The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Athletics prospects: No. 8 prospect (**Tommy White**), No. 11 (**Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**), No. 13 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Ryan Lasko**), No. 18 (**Rodney Green, Jr.**) and No. 28 (**Nate Nankil**).

Ball Magnet: The leader in HBPs in Major League Baseball is Minnesota's Ty France with 12. In Minor League Baseball, it's Everett's Michael Arroyo with 20... but Lansing's **T.J. Schofield-Sam** is charging fast. Schofield-Sam was hit by two more pitches yesterday to give him 17 in 51 games this year, pulling him into a three-way tie for 2nd in MiLB. This comes after T.J. was hit by 19 pitches in 98 games all of last year, and by 14 pitches in 114 games in 2023. The bruising truth: it's getting worse. Schofield-Sam was struck by four pitches in 16 games in April, seven pitches in 27 games in May, and six pitches in eight games in June. He has been hit 11 times at home and six times on the road; seven times in day games and 10 times at night; six times on Tuesdays, twice on Wednesdays, twice on Thursdays, twice on Fridays, twice on Saturdays and three times on Sundays; seven times by left-handed pitchers and 10 times by righties; and 12 times with runners on base compared to five times with the bases empty, including twice with the bases loaded(!).

Best in Class: Of course, that's not all T.J. has done this year. Lansing's first baseman leads all High-A hitters with a .349 batting average and ranks atop the Midwest League in hits (68), tied for 1st in triples (4), tied for 1st in total bases (104), 2nd in OPS (.955), 2nd in slugging percentage (.533), 3rd in runs scored (41) and 5th in on-base percentage (.422).

Catching Up: Third baseman **Tommy White** has missed time this year due to injury, limiting him to 34 of the Lugnuts' 58 games and leaving him 30 plate appearances shy of qualifying for the league's leaderboard. If White did, his slugging percentage (.553) would rank 2nd and his OPS (.942) would rank 3rd.

Mark it Down: Closer **Mark Adamiak** trails the Hartford Yard Goats' Welinton Herrera for the Minor League save lead, 11-10. (Herrera notched 10 saves with Spokane before moving up to Hartford). Adamiak trails only teammate **Blaze Pontes** for the most appearances in the Midwest League, 21-20.

Denzel with a Capital D: On Monday night, A's center fielder **Denzel Clarke** turned in his latest mind-blowing highlight, climbing the wall and suspending himself halfway over the fence to steal a home run from Nolan Schanuel. Clarke, who played in 51 games for the Lugnuts in 2022 and hit inside-the-park home runs in consecutive games vs. the West Michigan Whitecaps, had already earned the Electric Play of the Week honor the previous two weeks.

RoY Front-Runner: A's shortstop **Jacob Wilson**, who played in 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023, is the presumptive American League All-Star starter at shortstop and favorite to become the first Lugnut since Carlos Beltran to win Rookie of the Year. Wilson is 2nd in the Majors in batting average (.366) and base hits (93). His A's teammate, **Lawrence Butler**, is tied for 1st in the Majors in doubles (22); Butler played for the Lugnuts in 2021 and 2022.

A Gauge on Gage: 2025 Lugnuts Opening Day starter **Gage Jump** jumped into MLB Pipeline's Top 100 prospects at No. 100, replacing Baltimore's Coby Mayo. Jump was named Minor League Baseball's May Pitcher of the Month for the Texas League, going 4-0 in four starts with a 0.72 ERA: 25 innings, 15 hits, 2 runs, 5 walks, 29 strikeouts, 0.80 WHIP, .176 avg.

Welcome to Lansing: The newest Lugnut is 6-foot-8 left-hander **Jack Mahoney**, whose contract was purchased from the Atlantic League's Staten Island FerryHawks and joined the Nuts today. Mahoney hails from Appleton, Wisconsin, home of the Midwest League's Timber Rattlers. He pitched five seasons at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (UWM) before working his way from the American Association to the Frontier League to the Australian Baseball League to the Atlantic League, and now into affiliated baseball.

JUNE 11TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2017: After five straight losses to Fort Wayne, scoring no more than four runs in any of them, J.B. Woodman's three-run homer capped a five-run seventh and Edward Olivares broke a 5-5 tie with a home run in the eighth for a 6-5 victory at Parkview Field. The game ended when, with tying and winning runs aboard, Fernando Tatis, Jr., attempted to move up on a bounced slider by Connor Eller and was easily thrown out at second base by catcher Ryan Hissey.

2018: The Nuts punched a ticket to the postseason, their 14th in 23 years, with a 4-2 win at Fort Wayne. Colton Laws tossed five scoreless innings in the win.

2019: Griffin Conine dominated again, going 4-for-5 with three runs scored, a double, two home runs (including a 430-foot drive over the batter's eye in center field in a five-run seventh inning) and five RBIs, and the Lansing Lugnuts scored nine unanswered runs to win at South Bend, 11-7. The Lugnuts improved to 5-3 on their 11-game, 10-day road trip to Great Lakes, Lake County and South Bend.

No-Hit History: On June 13, 2024, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area; a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean. Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing and died in Jupiter.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who was homeschooled and played for Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... the Garland family was originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before Jake was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams.

College Days: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes previously played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Pro Ball: The 514th player selected in 2022, a 17th-rounder, signed for \$100,000... debuted in Complex ball in 2022, then excelled for Stockton in 2023 to earn May 16 call-up to the Midwest League... spent the remainder of 2023 with the Nuts and returned to Lansing to open 2024... promoted to Midland Sept. 12, 2024... promoted to Las Vegas Sept. 21, 2024.
