### Leading Off

Tonight, Reading continues a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats. Reading leads the season-series 8-7. Phillies No. 3 Prospect Griff McGarry starts tonight opposite West Chester, PA native Chris McMahon.

### Looking Back

It was an all-around 8-3 win for Reading on Thursday night to regain the series lead. Mick Abel was solid over five innings, allowing two-earned runs and had seven strikeouts. The bullpen combined to allow one-run over four innings. Madison Stokes had three hits and drove in two runs, while Carlos De La Cruz and Johan Rojas each chipped in base knocks.

### The Big 3-0 for Carlos

With a triple in the first last night, Carlos De La Cruz extended his on-base streak to 30 games, which dates back to May 12. De La Cruz is the first R-Phil to have a 30-or-more game on-base streak since Cameron Perkins reached base in 33-straight games in 2014.

### Rojas Rolling

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Offensively, he hit .423 last week and is .453 against Hartford so far. Entering this week, Rojas led all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks fifth in the Eastern League with a .305 average.

### Consistent Kroon

Matthew Kroon has established himself as one of the most consistent bats in the Reading lineup. After missing all, but two games, in 2022 with an injury, Kroon has played in nearly every game this season and leads the team with a .312 average; which also ranks third in the Eastern League. Kroon also has played third base and all the outfield positions this season.

### Bullpen Blues

Reading's bullpen bounced back last night, allowing just one-run over the game's final four innings. In wins this season, Reading's bullpen has a 2.31 ERA, but in losses it's a 7.43 ERA.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies took three-of-four from Arizona to jump over .500 and begin a three-game series in Oakland this weekend. Lehigh Valley lost 4-3 to Toledo in 12 innings at home last night. Jersey Shore topped Wilmington 8-5 to improve to 31-28 on the season. Finally, first-half champion Clearwater beat Tampa 8-4 to improve to a minor-league best 42-17 on the season.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 16, 2005:** At Reading, Allen Davis becomes the first Reading pitcher in nearly three years to fire a 9-inning complete game as he shuts down New Britain, 8-1, on a four-hitter. Four R-Phils homer in the game: Chris Roberson, Ryan Barthelemy, Juan Richardson and Randy Ruiz.

### The Goats

This is the third series of the season between Reading and Hartford. The Yard Goats currently sit in fifth in the Northeast Standings, two games ahead of Reading. Last week, Hartford dropped five-of-six games to Somerset at home, winning on Wednesday. After this week, the Yard Goats return home to host Erie for a six-game series to close the first half. Reading is hitting .324 against Hartford this season.

### Local Goat

Chris McMahon, out of nearby West Chester, gets the start for Hartford tonight. He is 1-2 with a 5.89 ERA over 11 starts this season. McMahon went six innings, and allowed four runs on five hits at Somerset last Saturday, with seven strikeouts. In three starts against Reading, he is 0-1 with 13 runs allowed in 11.1 innings pitched. McMahon played at West Chester Rustin High School and was selected by Atlanta in the 2017 draft, but opted to go to Miami. He was selected by Colorado in the second round in 2020 and spent most of 2021 and '22 with high-A Spokane.

## BIO

Phillies Number Three Prosepect. Started season on injured list. McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.
