SUNDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox salvaged the series finale on Sunday in Erie by a final of 12-4. Chesapeake recorded a season-high in runs and matched their season-high in hits. Four players collected two hits each (Enrique Bradfield, Reed Trimble, Adam Retzbach and Max Wagner) with Creed Willems notching a game-high three RBI. Braxton Bragg returned from the IL and struck out five in 4.1 frames. Blake Money picked up his first Double-A win with five strikeouts in three innings of relief.

START THE SECOND HALF

Today, the records have been reset as the second half of the 2025 Eastern League season begins. After spending the majority of the first half on the road, the Baysox play 39 of their 69 remaining regular season games at Prince George's Stadium. **54** of those games are against opponents who held a sub .500 record in the first half.

ALL SET FOR O'NEILL

Orioles' OF **Tyler O'Neill** is scheduled to continue his rehab assignment tonight and this week here at Prince George's Stadium. **O'Neill is recovering from a left shoulder impingement that has kept him on the injured list since May 18.** The 30-year-old began his rehab assignment in Aberdeen on Sunday. He would be the third Oriole this season to make a rehab assignment with the Baysox.

LEAVE THE RETZ TO ADAM

C/1B **Adam Retzbach** is having a career year in his first full season with the Baysox. **Retzbach currently has career-highs in AVG (.262), OBP (.362), SLG (.446), OPS (.808) and 2B (11).** Additionally, he is one home run away from matching a career-high from last season in 31 fewer games played. Over his last 10 games, Retzbach is batting .306 (11-for-36).

C Creed Willems has been one of the best performers in the Orioles system this year. Amongst O's minor leaguers, the Orioles No. 11 prospect is tied for third in extra base hits (23), third in doubles (14), tied for fourth in home runs (8) and sixth in total bases (91). Willems is tied for the team-lead with 27 RBI.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.96 ERA, which is fourth-best in Double-A and sixth-best in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 350 hitters, which is third-most in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

Chesapeake has won 16 one-run games this season - **most in the Eastern League.** The Baysox have played 28 one-run games this season, **which is the most in all of Double-A.** Additionally, Chesapeake won its eighth extra-inning game of the season on Friday. Eight extra-inning wins are the second-most amongst full-season MiLB clubs (Quad Cities - High-A KC).

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

The Altoona Curve - Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates - finished the first half with a 30-38 record. Despite winning four of six in Bowie in the most recent series meeting April 22 - 27, Altoona recorded the second-worst road record in the first half (10-20) behind Richmond. Altoona's roster includes only two of the Pirates' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - 2B/SS Termarr Johnson (No. 4), OF Mitch Jebb (No. 13).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Wilber Dotel makes his 14th start of the season for the Curve. The 22-year-old struck out eight in six scoreless innings in his most recent start on Wednesday vs Richmond. The Santo Domingo native has faced the Baysox twice this season and has not given up a run in 10 innings pitched. Dotel has pitched into the sixth inning in each of his last three starts.

Recorded a 2.41 ERA in 18.2 IP with 16 K over just 3 BB in April. First scoreless start of season with 5.0 IP on 4/15 @ RIC. Enters third season with Chesapeake.

Fared better as a reliever (4.10 ERA) than as a starter (5.66 ERA). Right-handed batters hit only .196 against him. Went at least 4.0 IP in half of his outings on the season. August was best month as he recorded a 3.55 ERA in 12.2 IP across three appearances. Made AAA debut on 8/23 vs Worcester, threw 4.2 IP, and gave up 7 R on 8 H. Threw season-high and matched career-high with 6.0 IP on 7/23 @ Akron. Struck out season-high seven batters in 4.0 scoreless innings on 4/25 @ Richmond. Was his first scoreless start of Double-A career.

Manager

The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
