THURSDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats split the doubleheader to the Akron RubberDucks on Thursday night, winning the first game 9-7 and losing the second game 8-3 at Delta Dental Stadium. In the first game, the Fisher Cats hit four home runs to right field leading them to a 9-7 victory over the RubberDucks. Will Robertson launched a solo home run in the third to open the scoring for New Hampshire. Kekai Rios tied up the score 2-2 with a base hit up the middle in the fourth to bring home Riley Tirotta. Leo Jimenez broke the tie with a three-run home run to right field, his fourth homer of the season and his first home run at Delta Dental Stadium. Zac Cook's two-run homer added insurance in the fifth, his fourth of the season and Tirotta hit his second home run of the season in the sixth to make it a 9-6 game after six innings. Left-handed reliever Mason Fluharty collected the win after 1.1 innings pitched with a strikeout while right-hander Connor Cooke received his first Double-A save with four strikeouts in 1.2 innings thrown. In the second game, New Hampshire mustered three runs on only four hits in an 8-3 defeat. On the mound, left-hander Trenton Wallace made his first start at Delta Dental Stadium since being promoted from High-A Vancouver last week. Wallace threw four innings, allowing five runs (three earned) on five hits and two walks while striking out six, receiving the loss. Damiano Palmegiani lifted his ninth homer of the year with a towering shot off the Hilton Garden Inn in left-center field in the first. Cook homered for the second straight game with his fifth dinger of the year to right field in the seventh.

DO THE SPLITS: Yesterday was the fifth doubleheader for the Fisher Cats this season and all five have ended in splits. In the first game, New Hampshire collected seven extra-base hits which matched a season-high and the offense hit four homers, one shy of matching the season-high.

WE GOT HOME RUN HITTERS: New Hampshire's offense has hit 68 homers on the year, good for 3rd-best in the league behind Somerset (85) and Erie (75). Yesterday, the Fisher Cats hit six home runs in the doubleheader, four in the first game and two in the second game. Zac Cook had two homers on the day while Will Robertson, Leo Jimenez, Riley Tirotta and Damiano Palmegiani all hit one each.

NOT DA VINCI BUT HE IS A LEO: Leo Jimenez has hit left-handed pitching very well so far this season, hitting .379 (11for-29) with two doubles, two homers and three RBIs. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect was a triple shy of the cycle in the first game of the doubleheader and now has 11 extra-base hits since being activated off the IL on May 23. Before that, he had only one extra-base hit.

STARTING SUMMER OFF RIGHT: Several Fisher Cat hitters have hit well since the calendar flipped to the month of June. Phil Clarke (.367, 11-for-30, 2B, HR, 3 RBI), Damiano Palmegiani (.326, 14-for-43, 3 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI), Orelvis Martinez (.318, 14-for-44, 5 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI) and Leo Jimenez (.306, 15-for-49, 4 2B, 3 HR, 9 RBI) have led the way on offense most recently.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (June 16, 2005) - The Fisher Cats won 14-6 at Binghamton and Miguel Negron hit three home runs, still the only time it's happened in New Hampshire's history. Negron hit a solo homer in the first inning. a three-run homer in the second inning, and a two-run shot in the third inning to build an 11-0 lead. Negron, Toronto's top draft pick in 2000, entered the game with one homer. He would go on to play 139 games at Triple-A, but never made it to the Majors.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (38-32) dropped the rubber game of the series at Camden Yards, falling 4-2 to the Orioles yesterday afternoon. Danny Jansen went 3-for-4 with two homers. Blue Jays play in Texas this weekend ... Triple-A Buffalo (30-36) won 7-4 over Syracuse. Trevor Schwecke went 2-for-4 with a two-run homer. Casey Lawrence improved to 2-5, allowing one earned run in his 6th innings. He struck out six...High-A Vancouver (33-26) lost at home to Hillsboro 4-2...Class-A Dunedin (30-30) mounted a late rally, but fell short in a 4-3 loss at home to Lakeland.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their home stand against the Akron RubberDucks this weekend. Promotions include Cats Con Night Saturday, courtesy of Belletetes, with postgame Atlas Fireworks and Father's Day Sunday, with Kids Run the Bases postgame, sponsored by the New Hampshire Liquor Commission Division of Enforcement. The first 1,000 fans will also receive a free hat, courtesy of Delta Dental.
