QUINTANA, SIX-RUN SEVENTH PROPELS SHRIMP

Lorenzo Quintana went 4-for-5 with two doubles, two home runs and five RBIs and the Jumbo Shrimp scored six runs in the seventh to beat the Bulls 13-5. Quintana's tworun bomb in the first got the scoring started and Demetrius Sims added a solo homer in the third. The teams traded runs in the next two half-innings before two Durham tallies in the fourth and two more in the sixth put the Bulls in front at 5-4. Jacksonville responded with the first seven men reaching in a six-run inning, their biggest of the season, with the big blow being a Quintana three-run bomb. The Jumbo Shrimp added three more runs in the ninth, highlighted by a Norel González two-run shot. All nine Jumbo Shrimp in the order collected at least one hit.

THEY'LL TELL THE STORY OF LAST NIGHT

A six-run seventh inning on Saturday - Jacksonville's best since plating nine runs in the ninth inning on July 27, 2021 at Charlotte - propelled the Jumbo Shrimp to a huge night offensively in a 13-5 victory at Durham. The 13 runs scored by Jacksonville marked the club's third-highest total over the last four seasons (since 2018), trailing a 15-run outburst at Chattanooga on July 19, 2019 and the 14 runs the club scored in that Charlotte game on July 27, 2021. The 17 hits tallied by the Jumbo Shrimp last night were bested during this same four-season span only by the 19 the club totaled in Chattanooga on July 19, 2019. Additionally, Jacksonville's four home runs equaled their most in one game (eight games of four homers, including last night) since blasting five on August 7, 2015 at Montgomery.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 17 home runs thus far in 2022, tied for third in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers. Entering play on Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp have homered in five consecutive games, their best such streak of 2022.

FRROR 404: NOT FOUND

While the Jumbo Shrimp have hit well to start 2022, the club's run prevention has struggled, with Jacksonville yielding 64 runs through 11 games, the fourth-most in the International League. The Jumbo Shrimp's run prevention struggles, though, are of little fault of the club's defense; Jacksonville's defense has turned 70.8 percent of balls put in play into outs, above the 70.0-percent average and a figure that would rank in the top 10 of MLB the last several seasons. Additionally, the Jumbo Shrimp's five errors are tied for the fifth-fewest in the circuit. Entering play on Sunday, Jacksonville has gone five games in a row without an error, totaling 47 straight miscue-free innings.

LEWIN AND CLARK BURDICK

Both **Lewin Díaz** and **Peyton Burdick** have gotten off to a strong starts to the season. Díaz is 12-for-43 to begin the campaign, slashing .279/.360/.465/.825 with two doubles, two home runs, nine RBIs and nine runs scored. Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, is 11-for-38, slashing .289/.400/.553/.953 with a double, three homers, six RBIs and a league-leading 14 runs. Thus, of the 67 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks tied for fifth in the International League - the pair have accounted for 34 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs by the pair), a ratio of 50.7 percent.

SHRIMP ON THE BARBIE

The Jumbo Shrimp rank in a tie for fifth in the International League in runs (67; 6.1 per game), and the biggest indication as to why has been the club's strong performance with runners on base. With the bases empty, Jacksonville is hitting .238/.328/.390, producing a .718 OPS that ranks 12th in the 20-team league. However, with runners on base, the club's batting line has surged to .293/.360/.552, with the resulting .912 OPS placing third in the circuit.

SHRIMP SPECKS

A win on Sunday over Durham would net Jacksonville its first series win of the season. The Jumbo Shrimp went just 1-3-2 in their sets against the Bulls in 2021... Erik González has collected at least one hit in seven straight games (12-for-28, .429, 2B, HR, 6 RBIs, 5 R)

ABOUT MATTHEW

-It took Kent until his third season at Texas A&M University to move into the Aggies' starting rotation. He totaled six starts out of 45 total appearances between his freshman and sophomore years in 2013-14. In 2015, the left-hander started 14 games out of his 19 appearances, going 9-1 with a 2.76 ERA (98.0 IP, 103 H, 12 BB, 84 K). That performance helped convince the Boston Red Sox to select Kent in the 13th round of the 2015 draft.

-After six seasons in the Red Sox organization, Kent elected free agency on November 7, 2021. Less than a month later, on December 3, 2021, he inked a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

2022 SEASON

2021 SEASON

-Kent started just three games out of 27 appearances in 2021. In his previous four campaigns, he started all but eight of his 112 outings.

-The southpaw held left-handed hitters to a .161 average and .450 OPS in 56 at-bats. However, over 178 at-bats, righties batted .315 with an .823 OPS against him.

-Kent struggled pitching with runners on base. With Double-A Portland and the bases empty, opponents recorded a ..256 average and 674 OPS in 133 at-bats. In comparison, with runners on, opposing hitters hit .307 with a .809 OPS in 101 at-bats.

2019 SEASON

-Kent still had platoon splits in 2019, but far less pronounced than he would experience in 2021. In Double-A, opposing right-handed hitters posted a .755 OPS against him in 294 atbats compared to a .629 OPS for left-handed batters in 187 at-bats.

2018 SEASON

-Over 170 at-bats while Kent pitched for Double-A Portland, left-handed hitters collected a .650 OPS. In comparison, right-handed batters registered a .723 mark in 387 at-bats.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-An outstanding hitter in addition to his pitching prowess at Midway High School in Waco, Texas, Kent went 10-1 with a 0.63 ERA and 122 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched as a senior while also batting .421 with 24 extra-base hits. In the district playoffs, he tossed three consecutive no-hitters.
