LAST NIGHT: The Skeeters continued their offensive outburst Monday with a 10-1 win over El Paso. Jose Siri and Michael Papierski each hit two-run homers. Papierski and JJ Matijevec each logged four hits.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Skeeters have scored a combined 34 runs over their last two games, also collecting 44 hits. The Skeeters have hit a combined .478 (44x92) over the last two games. It's the most runs the Skeeters have scored over a two-game stretch this season and is the second time this year they've scored double digits in back-to-back nights.

CJ2B: CJ Hinojosa is amidst a 10-game hitting streak and has hit .381 (16x42) with seven RBIs over the streak. It's the second-longest active streak in Triple A West. Hinojosa is tied for fifth in Triple A West with 13 doubles.

RECORD NIGHT: The Skeeters set the following franchise records in Sunday's win, including their time from 2012-19 as an independent team in the Atlantic League of Professional Baseball:

- 24 runs scored was a single-game record ... Surpassed previous record of 18 runs (accomplished twice and last done on September 9, 2016 vs. the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs ... Most from a Triple A team this season and tied for second-most from any MiLB team
- 7 home runs were a single-game record ... Surpassed previous high of six home runs from July 2, 2019 vs. the Long Island Ducks ... Tied for the most from a Triple A team this season and tied for second-most in all of MiLB
- 23 hits were a single-game record ... Surpassed previous record of 22 hits on September 9, 2016, vs. the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs ... Second-most from a Triple A team this season
- Jake Meyers became the first player in Skeeters history to hit three home runs in a game
- 12 extra-base hits matched Skeeters single-game record set on September 9, 2016, and are the most from a Triple A team this season and tied for second-most of all MiLB teams
- 50 total bases is a franchise record ... Surpassed previous high of 37 from July 2, 2019 ... Most from a MiLB team this season

JAKE RAKES: Over his last four games, Jake Meyers has hit .611 (11x18) with six home runs and 10 RBIs. He leads the Skeeters with three multi-homer games this season. His 12 home runs lead the Skeeters and are third-most in Triple A West. He's set his career high in home runs, surpassing his previous mark of nine homers from '19 with Fayetteville (A+) and Corpus Christi (AA)

CRUZIN': Bryan De La Cruz logged his second multi-homer game of the season on Sunday. He also recorded his 17th multi-hit game of the season Monday (2x6), which leads the Skeeters. De La Cruz has hit .375 (12x32) with two home runs and 10 RBIs over his last seven games. He's second in Triple A West in hits (50), third in runs (33) and tied for 10th in RBIs (27).

YOU CAN'T BE 'SIRI'OUS: Jose Siri hit a two-run homer Monday, giving him home runs in back-to-back games. It was the second time this year he's homered in back-to-back games. Siri leads Triple A West and is seventh in MiLB with 38 RBIs. He's collected four-or-more RBIs in five games this season to lead the Skeeters (no other player has recorded more than one of such games). Siri is also tied for 10th in Triple A West in average (.324) and is tied for third with eight stolen bases.

OH SO SWEET: The Skeeters are tied for second in all of Minor League Baseball with a .289 average.

VS. EL PASO: The Skeeters have won nine-of-10 vs. El Paso to open the season, including sweeping a five-game series at Constellation Field (5/20-5/25). The Skeeters have hit .342 (123x360) with 16 homers against the Chihuahuas this season. Jake Meyers has hit .486 (17x35) with six homers and 12 RBIs, Bryan De La Cruz has hit .447 (21x47) with three homers and 15 RBIs and Jose Siri has hit .400 (12x30) with three homers and 10 RBIs against El Paso.

LEADOFF LEGEND: When batting out of the lead-off spot this season (10 G), Alex De Goti has hit .340 (16x47) with two home runs and eight RBIs.

FANTASTIC FOURS: CJ Hinojosa (4x6) and Jake Meyers (4x5) recorded the first two four-hit games for the Skeeters this season in Sunday's win. Michael Papierski (4x6) and JJ Matijevec (4x5) followed with four-hit games in Monday's win.

WALK THIS WAY: Ronnie Dawson is tied for second in Triple A West with 28 walks and is eighth in the league with a .425 on-base percentage.

BACK ON TOP: The Skeeters re-took first place in the East Division of Triple A West with their win Friday night. The Skeeters hold a 1.5-game lead over Round Rock. The Skeeters re-took the division lead after falling in second place on June 12. The Skeeters have finished 29 of their 40 games in first place in their division.

MILB HONORS: RHP Brett Conine was named the Triple A West Pitcher of the Month for May by Minor League Baseball. Conine went 4-0 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19 IP) through four games (three starts) in May. He recorded the lowest ERA in Triple A West and led the league in wins, opponent batting average (.167) and WHIP (0.95) at the end of the month.

CRAZY COMEBACK: The Skeeters four-run comeback last Thursday in El Paso was their largest of the season. It was also the first game this season the Skeeters won when trailing through six innings.

RONNIE SALAMI: Ronnie Dawson hit the Skeeters' third grand slam of the season on 5/30 vs. ABQ. The Skeeters are tied for fourth in Minor League Baseball with three grand slams.

HOMESTAND: The Skeeters went 2-4 in their last homestand, which ended Tuesday, against the Round Rock Express. It matched their worst series record of the season, also against Round Rock (5/13-5/18)

CLOSE TO HOME: Based on approximate mileage, the Skeeters are located second-closest to the stadium of their parent club out of Triple A teams. The St. Paul Saints are located approximately 11 miles from Minnesota's Target Field.

MAJOR TALENT: The Skeeters roster features eight players with Major League service time: OF **Ronnie Dawson**, IF **Alex De Goti**, RHP **Ryan Eades**, RHP **Tyler Ivey**, RHP **Francis Martes**, RHP **Andre Scrubb**, RHP **Peter Solomon**, RHP **Hector Velazquez**. All but Eades, Rivera and Velazquez have appeared at the Majors with the Astros.

PUT IT ON THE MANTEL: **Ronnie Dawson**, **Alex De Goti** and **Peter Solomon** each made their Major League debuts with the Astros this season. Dawson went 1x5 with a run through 3 G, De Goti went 2x6 with a run and RBI through 6 G and Solomon tossed a scoreless 2 IP in relief, allowing just one hit and striking out two. **Ralph Garza Jr.** recieved his first promotion to the Major Leagues on May 26. He made his Major League debut on May 29 vs. San Diego and threw an inning of relief.

FRANCHISE RECORD: Jose Siri drove in seven runs on May 13 at Round Rock, setting the Skeeters franchise record, including their n--ine seasons as an independent franchise. Siri accomplished the feat with a grand slam and three-run double. Five players in Skeeters history had recorded six RBIs in a single game. The seven RBIs are tied for the second-most in a game this season of Triple A players.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: **Mickey Storey** is entering his third year as the manager of the Astros Triple A affiliate. He led Round Rock to the best record in Triple A in 2019 (84-56) and to the Pacific Coast League Finals. Storey got his first managerial job in the Astros system in 2018 with Class A Quad Cities, winning the Western Division of the Midwest League. Storey appeared at the MLB level with the Astros in 2012 and the Blue Jays in 2013 as a right-handed pitcher. He still holds numerous career pitching records for Florida Atlantic University. He finished his career second all-time in strikeouts, tied for second in wins and finished top 10 in strikeouts per nine innings, games started, fewest walks per nine innings and innings pitched. REST OF THE CREW: Joining Mickey Storey on his staff are pitching cocach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Ben Rosenthal and development coach Sean Connole. John Gregorich and A.J. Smith are the Skeeters' athletic trainers and Hazael Wessin is the team's strength and conditioning coach. Abreu is in his eighth season with the Astros organization and his first as the organization's Triple A pitching coach. Rosenthal is in his fifth season with the Astros and third as the hting coach for their Triple A affiliate. Connole is in his second season with the Astros and his first as the development coach for the team's Triple A affiliate.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through their first nine seasons, the Skeeters played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the post-season in five of nine seasons. The Skeeters still hold the Atlantic League single-season record for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from their '13 season. The Skeeters have been managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, the Skeeters went 601-502. Notable people to appear for the Skeeters include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino
