SHUTOUT FOR THE FIRST TIME - Last night's 3-0 loss to the Senators was the first time the Sea Dogs were shutout in 2021. Unable to cross the plate, Portland recorded three hits and only reached second-base twice.

FELTMAN DOES NOT FALTER -Durbin Feltman has pitched in three games this series facing the Harrisburg Senators. He has not allowed a run or a hit in his 2.1 innings and has only walked one batter.

WINCKOWSKI HURLS - After his last start, Josh Winckowski now has thrown the second-most amount of innings in the Double-A Northeast. So far this season he has tossed 32.0 innings allowing 12 runs (eight earned) on 12 hits while walking nine and striking out 28. He has held opponents to a .190 average.

STRONG RELIEF - Sea Dogs relievers have been solid in the first month of the season. They have a combined record of 11-1 with a 3.92 ERA. Collectively, they have pitched 121.2 innings and have struck out 149 opposing hitters. Opponents are hitting .243 against them.

ON THE MOUND - Lefty Matthew Kent makes his first start of the 2021 season this afternoon. Kent has solely come out of the bullpen this season and has a 3-0 record with 1.38 ERA. In 2019, he received MiLB's Rawlings Gold Glove Award as a pitcher (38 TC, 0 E). He ranked among Double-A Portland leaders in starts (2nd, 18), innings (2nd, 122.1), and strikeouts (3rd, 85)

<p>Hernández snapped an 0-for-27 skid with a tiebreaking double in the eighth inning and the Red Sox completed their major league-best 20th come-from-behind victory, beating the New York Yankees 7-3 Saturday night. Hernández got his first RBI since May 20 by roping a two-out, two-strike fastball from Chad Green (0-4) to the wall in left, scoring Rafael Devers from first. Christian Vázquez scored Hernández a batter later with a grounder that skipped over the first-base bag, and Bobby Dalbec followed with a two-run homer estimated at 453 feet. Boston had 10 comeback wins while finishing last in the AL East during last year's coronavirus-shortened 60-game season. They've doubled that total through 58 games this year, helping them tie for the second-best record in the American League.</p>

<p>The first eight batters of the game all recorded hits against WooSox starter Kevin McCarthy, in a first inning that saw nine hits and eight runs for Rochester. Brandon Snyder, Rafael Bautista and Blake Swihart hit back-to-back-to-back home runs, the first time that had ever been done at Polar Park. The eight runs scored were the most allowed by a Red Sox Triple-A franchise in an inning since the Pawtucket Red Sox gave up eight against Buffalo on April 11, 2018. The frame also marked the first time the Sox Triple-A affiliate allowed three homers in an inning since July 5, 2011, also against Red Wings.</p>

Cottam, Devlin Granberg, solo home run, and Christian Koss each tallied multi-hit efforts. Koss reached base four times, two walks, and extended his hit-streak to 10. Salem center fielder Ceddanne Rafeala reached on a one out walk and then swiped second to move into scoring position. Jaxx Groshans knocked a single to left field, scoring Rafeala and putting Salem up one. Jones was unfazed by the early run, lasting two outs into the sixth for the second longest outing of a Hillcats pitcher in 2021. The righty fanned five batters, even picking off Jake MacKenzie in the second inning with the help of Lynchburg first basemen Jhonkensy Noel. With the bases loaded and two outs in the top of the sixth, the Hillcats sent out Jaime Arias to get out of the jam. The southpaw immediately struck out Salem's Dean Miller and kept the Hillcats within one run.</p>
