TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue a six-game road trip tonight, with game five of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (AZ). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, May 13th, taking on the Inland Empire 66ers in a six-game series. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the fifth of 24 head-to-head meetings and the fifth of 15 here at Valley Strong Ballpark. Last season, the Quakes went 14-16 against the Rawhide, 7-8 here in Visalia.

LAST GAME: The Quakes let a four-run lead slip away, as the Rawhide got three in the eighth and two in the ninth, as Visalia defeated Rancho on Friday night by a final of 6-5 at Valley Strong Ballpark. Marco Corcho walked Trent Youngblood with the bases loaded to end it, as the Rawhide won for the second time in four games in the series. Rancho reliever Felix Cabrera (1-3) was charged with the loss, after allowing three in the eighth and then the final two in the ninth. Visalia reliever Adonys Perez (2-3) got the win, despite allowing four runs in the eighth. Mike Sirota (5) cracked a two-run homer, while Kellon Lindsey, Eduardo Quintero and Jose Meza each had two hits, to pace Rancho's nine-hit attack.

LONG-BALLS: The Quakes have launched six home runs over the first four games of this series, giving them a league-high 25 in 31 games. Stockton and San Jose are next, with each club at 19. Eduardo Quintero is tied with Cameron Leary of Stockton for the league lead with six, while Mike Sirota is just one back at five round-trippers.

ZED, ZERO, NADA: Thursday's shutout gave the Quakes three over a five-game span and a total of four here in 2025, tied for most in the league. Entering Saturday's action, Rancho's team ERA is at 3.32, now second in the league, just behind San Jose at 3.30. Rancho's staff also leads the league in strikeouts with 363, 51 more than the next closest team (Fresno with 312).

SUBSTANTIAL ROSTER MOVES: On Thursday, the Quakes promoted two of their most valuable arms to High-A Great Lakes. Starting pitcher Sean Paul Linan, who leads all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts with 50 strikeouts over just 29.2 innings will be making his first trip to High-A. Reliever Alex Makarewich, who has not allowed an earned run over his first 13 innings and has 27 strikeouts over 13 innings, will also be heading to High-A for the first time. Taking one of those respective spots on the roster will be RHP Shawndrick Oduber, who joins the team from the ACL, where he made just one appearance (two scoreless innings).

WEEKLY AWARDS SWEEP: The Quakes had a great home stand and the Cal League's weekly awards reflect that. Quakes' starting pitcher Sterling Patick (five perfect innings against Stockton) was named the Pitcher of the Week, while Mike Sirota (7-for-20, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 7 R, 4 BB, .458 OBP, 1.208 OPS) was named Hitter of the week.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his sixth start and seventh appearance, his first against Visalia. In his last outing overall, he fired three innings of scoreless, hitless relief to earn his first pro win, a victory over Stockton on May 4th. Last year, Foeller got a brief taste of the Cal League, striking out four, without surrendering a hit or run over three scoreless innings for Rancho. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

WILKIN PAREDES: 21-year-old left-hander Wilkin Paredes makes his sixth start of the year, his first against Rancho. In his last game overall, he allowed two runs on three hits over seven innings in a no-decision against Fresno on May 3rd. Last season, he went 6-5 with a 5.49 ERA across 16 starts for the Rawhide, covering 82 Cal League innings. Paredes signed with the Diamondbacks in January of 2023 out of the Dominican Republic.
