TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds welcome the Iowa Cubs to AutoZone Park to start a six-game series on Tuesday afternoon. RHP Jake Woodford

ABOUT SUNDAY: Lars Nootbaar powered the Redbirds to a 10-4 victory over Gwinnett, slugging three home runs, including a grand slam, and totaling 7 RBIs. The offense went off, tallying 16 hits, with multi-hit games from Conner Capel (4 hits), Alec Burleson (3 doubles), Evan Mendoza (3) and Ali Sanchez (2). Johan Oviedo earned his fourth win of the year and second of the series with a five-inning, eight-strikeout appearance in which he allowed just two hits and one run.

REDBIRDS VS I-CUBS: For the first time since 2019, Memphis and Iowa will play one another over a six-game series at AutoZone Park. It is the only meeting between the Redbirds and Cubs in Memphis this season, while the teams will square off at Principal Park in Des Moines in September. The rivalry runs deep between these two franchise. The Redbirds opened AutoZone Park facing Iowa on April 14, 2000, securing a 14-3 victory in front of 14,131. More recently, the I-Cubs knocked Memphis out of playoff contention in 2019 on the second to last day of the season after the Redbirds won the final 29 of 40 games. Memphis has an overall record of 174-144 dating back to their inaugural season in 1998.

NOOT INTENSIFYING: Lars Nootbaar cemented his name into the Redbirds record book on Sunday. The outfielder hit three home runs in a game for just the eighth time in Memphis Redbirds history. He was one home run shy of the home run cycle, slugging a solo shot in the first, a two-run blast in the third and a grand slam in the fourth inning. His three homers and 7 RBIs were the most for a Redbirds' player this season, while it was the team's first grand slam as well. The last Redbirds to have a 3-HR game were Adolis Garcia and Tyler O'Neil four days apart in 2018.

A FLURRY OF MOVES: RHP Junior Fernandez, LHP Matthew Liberatore, OF Lars Nootbaar and C Ivan Herrera were recalled by St. Louis on Monday. RHP Angel Rondon, who earned his first MLB win on Sunday, was optioned following the game. Herrera will make his MLB debut in his first appearance, joining Liberatore, Nolan Gorman, Jake Walsh, Juan Ypez, Kramer Robertson, and Brendan Donovan in making their major league debuts this season. Packy Naughton has also pitched with St. Louis this season. OF Justin Toerner was also transferred to Springfield (AA) on Monday.

GOIN' HOME - ELVIS PRESLEY: Memphis wrapped up their 12-game road trip on Sunday with a victory, finishing the trip with a winning record at 7-5. The team started the road trip losing their fifth straight game, then rattled off a six-game winning streak, then lost four straight before closing out the series finale against Gwinnett. Over those 12 games, the pitching staff has posted a 3.84 ERA (44 ER in 103IP) with 105 strikeouts. Their ERA is the 7th best mark in Triple-A over that span. The offense hit just .251/.328/.419 with 13 homers, 42 walks, 62 runs scored and 19 stolen bases. Individually, Johan Oviedo dominated, going 2-0 with a 2.81 ERA and 19 strikeouts over three starts. Burleson crushed the ball, hitting .413 with a 1.143 OPS and 13 RBIs.

BURLY TIME: Alec Burleson has been unstoppable. The 23-year-old had his third-straight three hit game on Sunday, setting a career-high by hitting three doubles. Burleson is riding an 8-game hitting streak where he is hitting .471/.471/.853 with four doubles, three home runs, six runs and 11 RBIs. Since May 7, he is slashing .407/.418/.685 with six doubles, three homers, and 16 RBIs. The Charlotte-native ranks in the IL top 10 in batting average, home runs, RBIs, slugging percentage, OPS, hits, and total bases. His .591 SLG% is 10th among Triple-A leaders.

WHEN IT MATTERS: When runners are in scoring position, Burleson doesn't miss. The Redbirds' outfielder ranks among the best in Triple-A in batting average (.424, 4th), homers (4, 6th), slugging percentage (.848, 4th) and OPS (1.320, 3rd) in that situation. His 22 RBIs rank 15th while his 36 plate appearances are tied for 130th most out of 200 qualified hitters. With RISP as a team, Memphis ranks 1st in Triple-A with a .527 slugging percentage, 3rd with 20 home runs, 6th with an .869 OPS, and 8th with a .278 batting average. They have also left the least amount of baserunners on in Triple-A, stranding just 356 runners this season, an average of 8.48 per game. They've also had the third fewest plate appearances with RISP (386).

WALK THIS WAY: In the fourth inning of Sunday's game, Kramer Robertson drew his team-leading 22 walk of the year. Robertson now has more walks than base hits (21), while his on-base percentage (.361) is a full .163 points above his batting average (.198). The Waco, TX native's 16.5% walk rate ranks 13th among qualified Triple-A hitters (via FanGraphs). He has reached base in all but three games this year. Among Triple-A East leaders last season, Robertson ranked third in walks (62) and ninth in OBP (.366).

DINGERS: On the season, Memphis has hit 68 homers which leads all of Triple-A. That mark ranks 2nd in MiLB, trailing only Greenville (70, Reds Low-A). Overall, Memphis has hit home runs in 33 of 42 contests. Out of the 68 homers, 39 have been solo shots and 11 have been three-run jacks. The Redbirds became the first professional baseball team to hit 50 home runs in 2022, doing so in 26 games. In 16 games since May 6, Memphis has hit 18 home runs. The Redbirds have also hit 45 of their 68 homers on the road, the most in minor league baseball.

PROSPECTS: Memphis started the 2022 season with 11 of the top 30 Cardinals prospects on their roster, according to MLB Pipeline.

TODAY'S STARTER: Jake Woodford makes his second start of the season with Memphis.

LAST TIME OUT: Woodford made his Triple-A debut last Wednesday against Gwinnett. In his first start of 2022, the Floridian gave up a pair of runs on four hits and walked two batters over three innings. In the second inning, the Stripers dribbled two infield singles and took advantage of a double and groundball single up the middle to score two runs. Woodford threw 50 pitches.

MLB: Woodford started the 2022 season in St. Louis where he made 7 relief outings to the tune of a 2.08 ERA. He was optioned on 4/15.

THE SPINNER: Woodford utilizes an elite curveball to go along with the rest of his repitior. In each of his MLB seasons before 2022, his curveball ranked in the top-11 in all of Major League Baseball in average vertical movement. In 2021, he ranked 11th with an average 7.2 inches of vertical break. In 2020, the breaking ball dove 8.0 inches, 10th best in all of baseball.

CARDINALS DEBUT: Following a 17-day layoff due to a team-wide COVID-19 outbreak in the middle of the 2020 shortened season, Woodford made his Major League debut in the second game of a double header against the Chicago White Sox. The right-hander tossed 3.0 innings in the start and received a no-decision after allowing just one run on one hit, a solo homer run by Luis Robert. His first-career strikeout came against future 2020 AL MVP Jose Abreu in the second inning, one of three strikeouts for Woodford in the appearance. Woodford earned his first-career MLB win a little over one month later against the Pittsburgh Pirates.

HEY NOW, HE'S AN ALL-STAR: Woodford is a three-time Minor League All-Star through his first five professional seasons, earning honors in the Pacific Coast League (2019 w/ Memphis), Texas League (2018 w/ Springfield) and Midwest League (2016 w/ Peoria)... He was named the starting pitcher for the Pacific Coast League in the 2019 Triple-A All-Star Game, tossing two scoreless innings with two strikeouts and earning the win.

WOODFORD WINNER: Woodford was a key contributor to two league championship teams during his Minor League career. In 2018 with Memphis, the right-handed pitcher started the clinching game of the 2018 PCL Championship, throwing 7.1 innings of scoreless baseball and allowed just three hits and struck out six batters in Game 4 vs. the Fresno Grizzlies. Woodford also pitched for the 2017 league-champion Palm Beach Cardinals.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Drafted by the Cardinals in the first round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of high school... Has made 35 career appearances with Triple-A Memphis (2018-19, 2021), sharing time with the Redbirds and St. Louis in 2021.

RETURNING TO MEMPHIS: Woodford was optioned to Memphis on May 15 to make room for Adam Wainright's return to the St. Louis active roster.
