The Round Rock Express and Sacramento River Cats face off in the series finale on Tuesday afternoon at Sutter Health Park. Express LHP Brock Burke is scheduled to get the start up against River Cats RHP Matt Frisbee. First pitch in Sacramento is set for 2:05 p.m. CT.

### LET'S RECAP

The Round Rock Express rallied for four runs in the final two innings to defeat the Sacramento River Cats by a final score of 7-5 on Monday night at Sutter Health Park. Round Rock scored first in the third as SS Ryan Dorow worked a two-out walk before scoring on a Yonny Hernandez single. The River Cats tied things up at 1-1 in the fourth when 1B Joe McCarthy scored on a single from LF Arismendy Alcántara. Round Rock LF Delino DeShields scored in the top of the fifth, but the 2-1 Express lead didn't hold as the River Cats took a 3-2 edge in the bottom of the frame. 2B Peter Maris came home thanks to a Braden Bishop triple before Bishop scored on a double from McCarthy. Round Rock CF Leody Taveras scored on a double from 1B Curtis Terry to tie the contest at 3-3 in the sixth. The River Cats plated a pair of runs in the bottom of the inning as Maris launched a two-run home run for a 5-3 lead. Terry hit a two-run homer for the Express in the eighth for the night's third tie at 5-5. In the ninth, DeShields scored as Yonny Hernandez reached on an error before a Yohel Pozo single added an insurance run to seal the 7-5 win.

### CLOSING IT OUT

Express LHP Brock Burke is set for the series finale start on Tuesday. The lefty has allowed just two runs across 12.2 total innings through three starts in July. Burke's season strikeout total of 53 ranks eighth in the Triple-A West League.

### DECISIONS, DECISIONS

Both Round Rock relievers earned decisions on Monday night. RHP Joe Gatto picked up his first win of the season after throwing 3.0 innings that saw two runs on two hits. The righty struck out three and finished his outing with 2.1 scoreless innings. RHP Jimmy Herget earned a save after keeping Sacramento off the board in the bottom of the ninth with a one-walk outing.

### CHANGING HANDS

Monday night's contest saw five lead changes and three ties as Round Rock and Sacramento battled back and forth throughout all nine innings. The game stayed within two runs with each score. After finding themselves down 5-3 in the seventh, the Express mounted their sixth comeback of the season, scoring four late runs for the victory.

### CLIMBING UP THE RANKINGS

Despite his average dropping over recent outings, Express 1B Curtis Terry finds himself among the Triple-A West League leaders after going 2-4 on Monday with a double, a home run and three RBI. The power hitter sits at second in the league for RBI (53), tied for third in total home runs (17) and fourth in total bases (133).

### TURNING THE TIDES

After falling in their last four six-game sets, the Express secured the series win over Sacramento thanks to Monday's 7-5 victory. Round Rock's last winning series was at Sugar Land from June 10-June 15, where the E-Train won four games to two. The Express are 5-5-1 in series play this season and have won at least one game in every series they have played.

### TOKYO BOUND!

Round Rock RHP Ryder Ryan has been placed on the Temporary Inactive List as he joins Team USA for the 2021 Olympics in Tokyo, Japan. Over 21 relief appearances, the righty has earned a 1-4 record and two saves. Ryan holds a 6.17 ERA (16 ER/23.1 IP) and has totaled 30 strikeouts. The Olympic baseball tournament begins on Wednesday, July 28 and Team USA takes the field for the first time on Friday, July 30 at 5 a.m. CT.

## ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twenty one members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, C Jose Felix, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

## STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 13 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon and Texas. Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

## AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 21 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, C Jose Felix, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

## EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
