FRES-NOTES

STATEMENT TO END MAY: The Fresno Grizziles (29-19) made a statement, roaring past the San Jose Giants (27-21) 11-4 Friday night from Excite Ball-park. Fresno ended May on a high note, finishing the month 16-12 with a 10-6 away record. The Grizziles improved to 16-3 on the road against the California League North Division, which includes a 6-1 mark in the South Bay. The Grizziles offense etched 11 runs on 14 hits and three walks, notching a run in four different frames. Fresno plated a season-high fiver uns in the first and three runs in the eighth. Every Fresno starter reached base at least once with eight of the nine batters tallying a hit. A trio of players logged multi-hit games while a quartet of batters picked up two or more RB. The Grizziles also swiped three bags, giving them 12 stolen bases in the series. Caleb Hobson reached base four times at the top of the lineup, continuing his unbelievable stretch as the leadoff hitter. Hobson swatted three singles and scored a trio of times. GJ Hill was unreal once again, going 4-for-5 with a homer (fifth of season, most on club, fourth in last five games), double, three RBI, four runs and a stolen base. Hill enjoyed career-highs in hits (4), runs (4), wallops (1) and RBI (3). Andy Perez lined an early RBI triple and provided a late RBI single. Perez is two triples shy of joining the Grizziles Career Record Books in that category. Jason Hinchman knocked in two RBI with a sacrifice fly and single. He also drew a walk and stole a base. Felix Teno powered a two-run shot to highlight the five-run first, his second clout of the year. Tena extended his hit streets to nine agames, grabbing eight RBI in that span. Ben McCabe blasted his first bomb of 2024, a solo shot in the eighth (Hill also went deep in that inning). EJ Andrews Jr. whacked a double and Nick Gile mustered a run in the first. GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS: The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Excite Ballpark. This is the third of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the second of three sets in San Jose. In the first series of 2024, the Grizzlies enjoyed their first series sweep of the Giants since the California League Playoffs in 2022. Fresno also sweep their first series of Excite Ballpark since joining the league in 2021. The Grizzlies are now 55-45 overall in the regular season (2-3 in playoffs) against the Giants since joining the California

FROM FRIEND TO FOE: The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 76.1 innings. Another frans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington, Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10), 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15), Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach fons may remember is Giants Manager Ydwin Villegas. The always smilling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a 962 fielding percentage. .962 fielding percentage

COUPET GETS THE NOD: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Isaiah Coupet. Coupet was selected by the Rockies in the 4th round (Pick 109) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. The lefty joined Fresno for three games at the tail end of the 2023 season, all in relief. Coupet is known for generating more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his new role as the team's leadoff hitter. Since Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 17 times in 28 plate appearances (six games). In four of those six games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score nine runs. This includes starting the gam of 4-for-5 with a walk. All four hits have been singles with half of them as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped eight bases, picking up two of them in three of the six games.

HITMAN HINCHMAN AND HILL: Grizzlies' OF/1B Jason Hinchman has reached base safely in 23 straight games and 31 of 32 contests this season (Apri 26-May 31 for the streak). In those 23 games, Hinchman is 22-for-74 (297) with 16 walks. Grizzlies' OF/2B GJ Hill has reached base safely in 17 straight games and 19 of 20 contests since joining Fresno (April 30-May 31 for the streak). In those 17 games, Hill is 17-for-60 (283) with 12 walks.

CLUTCH(INCHMAN): Grizzlies' OF/1B Jason Hinchman has provided the clutch hit in all three of Fresno's comeback claws wins in the seventh inning or later this season. Hinchman had a go-ahead two-RBI double in the 7th inning May 9 vs. Modesto, a walk-off two-run homer in the 9th inning May 26 vs. Visalia and a game-tying two-RBI single in the 9th frame May 30 at San Jose.

HILL HOMERS AGAIN: Grizzlies' OF/2B GJ Hill has homered four times over his last five games (May 26-31), giving him a club-high five clouts. Hill went deep in three straight games from May 26-29. Before joining Fresno, Hill had 12 professional longballs (2019-22 in the Diamondbacks system).

TENA IS ON A TEAR: Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is currently riding a nine-game hitting streak, the longest active streak on the team. He has one homer, one triple, one double, eight RBI and two runs in that span.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has had an outstanding season (46 games), going 52-for-185 (.281 AVG/.323 OBP/.432 SLG/.755 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), four triples, eight doubles, 29 RBI, 20 runs, 12 walks and two stolen bases. Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on May 31 at San Jose was his 11th of Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kleschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.
