### INDY BITS

**ABOUT SUNDAY:** The Indianapolis Indians scored all nine of their runs in the sixth inning in a 9-8 win over the Iowa Cubs on Sunday afternoon at Principal Park, completing their first six-game series sweep since Minor League Baseball transitioned to its weekly schedule in 2021. Trailing 1-0 after five innings because of top Cubs prospect Owen Caissie's RBI double in the fourth, the Indians jumped ahead of the I-Cubs with a nine-run top of the sixth. The inning started with a solo home run from Malcom Nuñez against Iowa starter Kyle McGowin, but the majority of the damage came against reliever Riley Martin. Martin allowed a solo homer to pinch hitter Henry Davis to open his day, and Indianapolis poured on for five more runs charged to Martin before he left the game, highlighted by a three-run double to straight-away center from Andrés Alvarez. Zac Leigh came on in replacement of Martin as the second pitching change of the inning and allowed back-to-back RBI hits to Liover Peguero and Davis. Iowa made things interesting against the Indians bullpen, with Fabián Pertuz clubbing a two-run home run in the seventh inning before things got a bit too close for comfort in the ninth. Iowa pinch hitter Moisés Ballesteros smacked a grand slam and Trayce Thompson went deep two hitters later.

**HOW SWEEP IT IS:** The Indians extended their season-high six-game winning streak to six games while clinching a sweep over the Iowa Cubs on Sunday afternoon at Principal Park. It is Indianapolis' first sweep in a six-game series since Minor League Baseball transitioned to the weekly schedule in 2021 and their second sweep of the season after taking all three games at Louisville from July 1-3. It was also Indianapolis' first sweep over Iowa in 14 seasons of the head-to-head rivalry (since 1988), with the two teams meeting as part of the American Association from 1988-96 and beginning again in 2021 when Iowa joined the International League.

**GONE STREAKIN':** The six-game winning streak is Indy's longest since winning six straight games from April 4-13, 2019. The last time the Indians won more than six in a row was June 2-9, 2018, when they logged a seven-game streak. Indianapolis' longest winning streak in the Victory Field era came in 1997, when they won 14 straight from July 28-Aug. 9.

**GERMÁN'S GOT SIX:** Domingo Germán extended his winning streak to six games since June 18 with arguably his best start in an Indianapolis Indians uniform on Sunday at Toledo. He allowed just one run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.2 innings, throwing 49 of his 72 pitches for strikes. Germán has now tossed at least 5.0 innings in 10 of 12 starts with Indianapolis since making his Indians debut on May 19 (1) vs. Toledo after being signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent. During his winning streak, he has a 3.96 ERA (16er/36.1p) and 36 strikeouts with two-or-less runs allowed in five of those seven starts.

**HANK'S HOMER:** Henry Davis launched the second pinch-hit home run by an Indians batter on Sunday afternoon, entering the game as a designated hitter replacement for Seth Beer. It was the first pinch-hit homer by an Indian since Eli Wilson on April 14 at Toledo, and the first of Davis' career in just three pinch-hit at-bats. His sixth-inning homer was his first of two hits in the frame as Indianapolis put nine runs on the board. The 2-for-3 performance extended his hitting streak to nine games since July 13 vs. Columbus. In that time, he is hitting .375 (15-for-40), with three doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI while driving in at least one in eight of nine games.

**MALCOM MASHED:** Malcom Nuñez continued a hot month of July with a game-tying solo home run to begin the Indians nine-run sixth inning on Sunday at Iowa. He went 2-for-4 with two runs, a homer and pair of RBI for his second consecutive multi-hit performance and fifth in 16 July games. For the month, he is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with 10 runs, six doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, a .524 slugging percentage and .901 OPS. In 89 total games with the Indians, he is hitting .263 (84-for-320) with 15 doubles, 10 home runs and 48 RBI.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians begin a six-game homestand at Victory Field against the Toledo Mud Hens, Triple-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, tonight at 7:05 PM. The two teams split a six-game series at Victory Field from May 14-29 and are both currently working six-game winning streaks. Kicking off the series for the Indians tonight is RHP Aaron Shortridge (1-0, 1.13), coming off his first win of the season out of the bullpen last week. Countering for the Mud Hens is RHP Garrett Hill (0-0, 10.80) to start a bullpen game.

**SHORTY SHINES:** Aaron Shortridge made his second appearance with the Indians and first out of the bullpen last Thursday, throwing 4.0 one-run innings (unearned) with just one hit, one walk and six strikeouts while piggybacking with Mike Burrows. The performance earned Shortridge his first win since Sept. 20, 2023, vs. Rochester in his Triple-A debut. Shortridge threw 44 of 68 pitches for strikes. In two games (one start) with Indy this season, he has allowed two runs (one earned) with eight strikeouts in 8.0 innings. The right-hander began the season on the injured list and began a minor league rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates on June 17. He made five appearances (four starts) between the FCL and High-A Bradenton, going 0-1 with a 1.76 ERA (3er/15.1p), 25 strikeouts, 0.91 WHIP and .222 batting average against.

**THIS DATE IN 2017:** Tyler Glasnow struck out 12 batters through 6.1 innings for his fifth of seven 10+ strikeout games on the season. After taking a 1-0 lead in the second inning, Pawtucket tied the game in the seventh. Both teams traded runs in the 10th, and Kevin Newman singled home Eric Wood to give the Indians a 3-2 win in the 12th frame. The bullpen excelled, adding seven strikeouts to Glasnow's 12 to set a season high of 19 strikeouts by the Indians staff in one game. The 19 strikeouts set a new Victory Field era home record and was one strikeout shy of the overall Victory Field era record, set on Aug. 15, 2003 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Charlotte.
