SUNDAY: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (28-23, 64-55) defeated the Tulsa Drillers (29-22, 75-45), 7-4, on Sunday afternoon at ONEOK Field. The Sodpoodles opened the scoring in the third when **Avery Owusu-Asiedu** crushed a two-run home run. Amarillo got back in the run column in the sixth on RBI singles by **Angel Ortiz** and **Cristofer Torin**. On the other side of the ball, **Wellington Aracena** held the Drillers scoreless over 4.2 innings pitched. **Logan Mercado** maintained the shutout for the Sod Poodles until the seventh, where a Kole Myers solo homer put the hosts on the board. After loading the bases in the eighth, Owusu-Asiedu's two-run double and a run-scoring single by **Jansel Luis** plated a trio of insurance runs for Amarillo. A couple of home runs between the final two frames brought the Drillers within three runs, but it would not be enough.

AOA-OK: With his go-ahead two-run home run in the third on Sunday, **Avery Owusu-Asiedu** extended his hit streak to 12 games...the outfielder finished with two hits and four RBI...since joining the Sod Poodles on August 11, he is batting .468 (22x47) with 13 runs scored, four doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 21 RBI and a 1.658 OPS...between Amarillo and High-A Hillsboro, he has now hit safely 19 straight contests (8/1-c)...since August 11, he leads Double-A baseball in hits (22), total bases (52) and RBI (21)...over his most recent 28 games (7/22-c) between Amarillo and High-A Hillsboro, he is batting .400 (42x105) with 13 home runs, 33 RBI, and a 1.307 OPS...in that same timeframe, he ranks first across MiLB in total bases (89), second in home runs, fifth in OPS (min. 55 PA), and sixth in hits.

GRAN TORIN-O: **Cristofer Torin** posted his third game with 4+ hits this season on Sunday, continuing a big month of August...over 16 August games, the shortstop is batting .388 (26x67) with 18 runs, five doubles, two home runs, and a .983 OPS...he is tied with Frisco's Rafe Perich and Midland's Casey Yamauchi for first in the Texas League in runs scored this month.

WELL DONE: **Wellington Aracena** was very successful pitching to contact in his second start of the week against Tulsa, holding the hosts scoreless over 4.2 IP on four hits in just 68 pitches...however, Aracena struck out just one batter...among 10 career scoreless outings of 4.2 IP or more, the one punchout on Sunday was the fewest...only Kenny Hernandez had more success in a start while striking out one batter or fewer in franchise history when he blanked Frisco across five full frames on September 15, 2021 with just one punchout.

HITTING IS CONTAGIOUS: All nine batters in the Amarillo order recorded a hit Sunday, a feat the team had not achieved since July 8 vs. Arkansas (W, 13-8).

WHERE THE NORTH WAS WON: The Sodpoodles wrapped up their regular season slate against the Texas League North Division on Sunday...Amarillo finished with a 15-12 overall record in road games, matching a single-season high in wins from the 2022 and 2023 seasons.

HOOK 'EM: Amarillo's team batting average against the Hooks (.218) is the worst against any Texas League opponent in 2026...individually, **Cristofer Torin** leads active Sodpoodles with nine hits against the Hooks this year, while **Trent Youngblood** posted a .333/.467/.583 slash line in four games at Whataburger Field in the most recent series between the two clubs back in late July...the pitching staff's 3.87 ERA and 1.24 WHIP against Corpus Christi are both the second-lowest clips against one opponent in 2026...**Josh Grosz** leads active Sodpoodles in strikeouts, having sat down 11 Hooks on strikes this season.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Jack Spanier collected four hits, four runs, and three RBI in Single-A Visalia's 20-2 beatdown of Rancho Cucamonga n Sunday...it is the most runs the Rawhide have scored in a single game since 2013.

SUMMARY

- Currently ranked the No. 4 D-backs prospect by MLB Pipeline.
- Acquired by the Diamondbacks via trade with the Rangers on July 31, 2025 in a deal that sent Merrill Kelly to Texas in exchange for LHP Kohl Drake, LHP Mitch Bratt and Hagaman.
- Selected by the Texas Rangers in the fourth round (133rd ovr.) of the 2024 MLB Draft...agreed to a \$515,000 signing bonus.
- Did not play in 2024 after signing with the Rangers as he was placed on the full-season injured list...underwent internal brace surgery late in May 2024.
- Graduated from Holy Spirit High School in Absecon, New Jersey...was a Cape Atlantic League National Conference All-Star and Perfect Game/Rawlings Preseason All-America High Honorable Mention in 2021...previously played at Cedar Creek High School.

LAST TIME OUT

- Hagaman was solid across the first three innings of the game, but self-inflicted wounds by the defense allowed Tulsa to scratch across the tying run in the bottom of the fourth...after a leadoff single and fielder's choice, Kole Myers advanced to second base on a disengagement violation and moved up to third base on a wild pitch, later scoring on a sacrifice fly by Elijah Hainline.
- Held Tulsa to just one run over 4.2 innings pitched...he now owns a 1.65 ERA (3 ER/16.1 IP) and is tied for second in the Texas League with Corpus Christi's Nolan DeVos (min. 3 GS & 16.1 IP).

REVERSE SPLITS

- Left-handed hitters in High-A batted just .178 against Hagaman this season...among starting pitchers at the level with at least 15 games played, Hagaman's BAA was second-best and his 1.09 WHIP ranked fourth following his last start on August 1.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Won his second NWL Pitcher of the Week award for the week of June 28 following his June 24 performance against Vancouver...over 6.0 scoreless innings, Hagaman allowed just two hits and three walks while striking out eight.
- Turned in the longest outing of his career on June 30 vs. Spokane by tossing in seven shutout innings to extend his then-active scoreless streak to 13.0 innings pitched.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made his professional debut on June 5 with the ACL Rangers...turned in two perfect innings and struck out four as the starting pitcher.
- Made two more starts in the Arizona Complex League before being called up to Single-A Hickory...was the starting pitcher for the Crawdads on June 29, where he shut out the Salem Red Sox over three no-hit frames, walking one and striking out two in his team debut.
- Had one of the best outings of his young career during his third start with High-A Hillsboro on August 20 against Eugene...set career highs with 5.0 innings pitched and eight strikeouts, earning his first win as a pro in the process.
- Followed up that start with four no-hit innings vs. Vancouver on August 27, where he walked one and struck out seven Canadians...his performance led to him being crowned the Northwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 24.
- His 27 strikeouts from August 6 - September 3 were tied for ninth-most in the NWL.
- Pitched 12 innings in the Arizona Fall League with the Salt River Rafter...allowed six earned runs while striking out 14 and walking seven batters.

COUNTRY ROADS

- Played collegiately at West Virginia from 2023-2024 after redshirting his true freshman season in 2022...was a NCBWA Freshman All-American and All-Big 12 Honorable Mention in 2023.
