BIG BEN IS BACK: Yankees No. 5 Prospect Ben Hess returns to the mound for Somerset for the first time since starting at Binghamton 4/11. Activated off the 7-day IL Thursday, Hess has a 3.52 ERA with 14 K to 8 BB in two starts (7.2 IP) this season. Against Portland 4/3, Hess set a team-record for the most consecutive strikeouts to open a game with seven.

Across his last seven starts with Somerset dating back to 2025, Hess has a 4-0 record, 2.04 ERA, 1.05 WHIP, .158 BAA with 49 K to 18 BB in 35.1 IP.

TOP OF THE HEAP: Somerset enters today leading all 120 MiLB teams with a .495 SLG while ranking among the nation's leaders with 61 HR (3rd), .850 OPS (3rd) and a .279 AVG (T-6th).

PATRIOTS POWER PITCHING: Somerset's pitching staff has tallied double-digit strikeouts in six consecutive games, powering the Patriots to a Double-A leading 11.1 K/9. Somerset's 3-0 shutout win on Tuesday was its third shutout win of the season, all coming over the last 10 games, since 5/2. Over that span, no other team in Minor League Baseball has three shutout wins. Across the last seven games, Somerset ranks among MiLB's leaders in WHIP (1.03 - T-2nd), K/BB (4.17 - 4th) and ERA (2.95 - 6th).

RED HOT RELIEVERS: Over the past seven games, Somerset's bullpen has a 1.82 ERA (2nd in Double-A, 4th in MiLB), 3.63 SO/BB ratio (2nd in Double-A, 8th in MiLB) and 0.93 WHIP (3rd in Double-A and MiLB).

BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS: The Somerset Patriots lead all Double-A teams with 61 HR this season, which ranks 3rd in MiLB. From 4/26-5/8, the Patriots homered multiple times in 12 straight games, setting a modern MiLB record (since 2005), while a Major League club has never accomplished the feat. Somerset's 14-game home run streak was also snapped on Saturday 5/9, tying for the Patriots' 2nd-longest home run streak in franchise history.

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: Following Owen Cobb's fifth inning home run Wednesday, Somerset has collected an extra base hit in all 35 games this season. Somerset's 35-game XBH streak is tied for the longest in Double-A and is tied for the second-longest in Minor League Baseball (ELP - Triple-A - 41).

EARLY PUNCHERS: With Coby Morales' first inning sacrifice fly to score Jace Avina Wednesday, Somerset scored its Eastern League-leading 34th first inning run this season. Somerset's 34 first inning runs are tied for third in Double-A and tied for eighth in MiLB.

JACE THE ACE: Jace Avina extended his on-base streak to a season-high 13 games with a leadoff walk in the first inning Wednesday. The 13-game on-base streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the Eastern League. During the streak, Avina is slashing .345/.397/.707 with 20 hits and 14 runs. He's raised his line from .155/.242/.310 to .246/.314/.532 in that span.

MARTIN MACHINE: Garrett Martin secured his ninth multi-hit game of the season Wednesday, extending his on-base streak to eight games. With hits in seven of those games, Martin is 12- for-36 with four XBH in that stretch and has raised his slash line from .234/.291/.521 to .262/.322/.546. Martin's 11 HR lead the Eastern League, are tied for second in Double-A and are tied for eighth in MiLB.

PONY PUNISHER: Owen Cobb tied a career-high with three hits in a 3-for-4 day Wednesday with a HR and 2 RBI. It was his fourth multi-hit game of the year and first three-hit game since 5/21/25 at Dunedin. In six games against the Rumble Ponies this year, Cobb is 7-for-20 (.350) with two HR and eight RBI. Both of Cobb's Double-A home runs in his career have come this year against Binghamton.

2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.

After being traded to the Yankees from the Cubs entering the 2025 season, Arias spent the year on the Yankees' 40-man roster. He broke camp on the 7-day IL for Triple-A SWB, before being reinstated following a minor league rehab assignment on 7/19 and having his option transferred to Double-A Somerset. Ended the season in Somerset with 17 relief appearances in which he went 3-0 with a 2.57 ERA, 2 HLD, 1/3 SV, 15 BB and 29 K in 21.0 IP.

Career Notes

Re-signed with the Yankees as a minor league free agent on 11/26/25 and was extended a non-roster invite to Major League Spring Training. Arias was originally acquired by the Yankees from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for cash considerations on 1/15/25, after he was designated for assignment by the Cubs on 1/12/25. Initially signed an international free agent contract with Blue Jays in 2018, but did not appear in a game before his release in 2020. Signed with the Cubs in 2021 and spent the first four seasons of his career in the Cubs minor league system.
