### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Last night was Indianapolis' second postponement of the 2024 season after having five in 2023 — three at Victory Field — and two cancellations. The Indians and Mud Hens will make up the game on Saturday with a doubleheader starting at 2:35 PM ET.

**ABOUT WEDNESDAY NIGHT:** Billy McKinney roped a tiebreaking RBI single in the ninth inning to lift the Indianapolis Indians past the Toledo Mud Hens on a rainy Wednesday night at Fifth Third Field, 4-3. Indianapolis pushed two across in the sixth to plate the first runs of the game on a two-out, bases-loaded walk by Carter Bins. On the next play, Matt Gorski hit a hard grounder to third for an infield single that scored Malcom Nuñez. Following a one-out double to Justice Bigbie in the bottom of the sixth, Wily Peralta uncorked a wild pitch that led to a throwing error by Bins and Toledo's first run. The Indians extended their lead back to two in the seventh when Gonzales drilled a two-bagger to open the frame and scored on Lamb's ground ball through the left side of the infield. After the Mud Hens tied the game in the bottom of the eighth, Indy responded in the top half of the ninth with McKinney's game-winning knock.

**LAST AT-BAT WINS:** The Indians recorded their first win in their last at-bat on Wednesday night, courtesy of Billy McKinney's RBI single to score Gonzales in the top of the ninth. During the 2023 season, the Indians recorded 12 last at-bat wins (including three walk-offs), with their first not coming until two days after the second half began (June 30 at Louisville).

**TWO HITS FOR TOLEDO:** Indianapolis pitching did not allow a hit through five innings on Wednesday night at Toledo and finished the contest with just two total hits surrendered. In his first start of the season, Eric Lauer tossed 3.2 hitless innings with five strikeouts. The bullpen provided strong pitching as well, with Kyle Nicolas, Wily Peralta, J.C. Flowers and Geronimo Franzua striking out five through the end of the game. All three of Toledo's runs scored were unearned for the Indians' pitching staff.

**GONZO'S DOUBLES:** Nick Gonzales continued his hot stretch to begin the season on Wednesday night, going 2-for-5 with two runs and two doubles. He scored the game-winning run after doubling in the top of the ninth inning. Since the season began, he owns a .391 batting average (18-for-46) with 14 runs, eight extra-base hits and eight RBI. Seven of his 11 games have featured multi-hit performances. He had his six-game hitting streak snapped in Game 1 of last Saturday's doubleheader vs. Memphis but walked twice and is now tied with teammate Jake Lamb with 11-game on-base streaks, which are tied with six others for the longest in the International League. Gonzales split the 2023 season between Indianapolis and Pittsburgh and logged a season-high 13-game on-base streak with Indy from 4/6-19.

**JAKE ON BASE:** Jake Lamb has joined Nick Gonzales in jumping out to a hot start to begin the 2024 season, hitting .371 (13-for-35) with four runs, three extra-base hits, six RBI, eight walks, a .488 on-base percentage and 1.059 OPS in 11 games. On Wednesday night, he went 2-for-4 with a run and RBI. He spent the majority of the 2023 season in Triple-A and logged a 24-game on-base streak with Salt Lake from 5/23-23. During that stretch, he hit .337 (30-for-89) with 19 runs, eight extra-base hits, 22 RBI, 20 walks, a .473 on-base percentage and .990 OPS.

**BAE BOMB:** Utilityman Ji Hwan Bae continued his rehab assignment with the Indians on Tuesday night and went 2-for-4 with a run, home run, walk and two RBI. He was placed on the 10-day injured list with a strain of his left hip muscle on March 28 (retroactive to March 25) after undergoing an injury during spring training. Bae began his rehab assignment with Single-A Bradenton on April 7 and went 2-for-3 with a double and RBI before being transferred to Indianapolis. He has fared well when returning to Triple-A after making his big-league debut in September 2022, hitting .344 (11-for-32) with nine runs and four extra-base hits in nine games of a rehab assignment with Indianapolis last season.

**TONIGHT:** With the series at Toledo tied at one win apiece, the Indians will look to take the advantage in the six-game series tonight at 7:05 PM ET. Indianapolis saw success vs. the Mud Hens in 2023, finishing the season series with a 14-4 record while going 5-1 at Fifth Third Field. Tonight marks the third of 24 meetings between the two teams, with 12 games coming at Victory Field from May 14-19 and July 30-Aug. 4. Continuing the series tonight for Indy is RHP Paul Skenes (0-0, 0.00), who is making his third Triple-A start as the Pirates No. 1 overall prospect. Countering for the Tigers affiliate is RHP Keider Montero (0-0, 0.00), their No. 8 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Montero has 10 strikeouts through 8.0 innings so far this season (two starts) after making eight appearances (seven starts) with Toledo in 2023.

**PS, SKENES SHOVES:** Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated by the No. 3 prospect in Minor League Baseball, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) made his second Triple-A start and Victory Field debut last Friday vs. Memphis and punched out six across 3.0 shutout innings. Skenes needed just 12 pitches to strike out the side of César Prieto, Thomas Saggese and major league rehabber Lars Nootbaar in the first inning. In the second inning, Skenes yielded a leadoff single to Luken Baker and two-out walk to José Fermín during a 10-pitch at-bat but put away Matt Koperniak on three straight fastballs to escape the threat. He ended the night with a 10-pitch third and froze Saggese for his sixth punchout on a 100.5 mph four-seamer. He threw 32 of 44 pitches for strikes, topped 100 mph 13 times and maxed out at 101.3 mph during the battle with Fermín.

**THIS DATE 2009:** Third baseman Neil Walker scored shortstop Brian Bixler from first base with a one-out double to left in the bottom of the 14th inning to give the Indians a 3-2 walk-off win over Toledo. Indy right-hander Daniel McCutchen helped the Indians snap their 0-3 start to the season by striking out seven hitters in 5.0 innings of two-run ball. Six Indians relievers combined to blank the Mud Hens over the final nine innings, yielding only three hits and two walks with nine strikeouts.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER

**Paul Skenes:** The hard-throwing right-hander Skenes will make his third Triple-A start and second on the road tonight at Toledo.

**Last Outing:** Skenes punched out a career-high six batters over 6.0 shutout innings vs. Memphis. He allowed one hit and one walk in the outing.

**Against the Mud Hens:** Skenes has never faced Toledo

**Triple Digits:** Skenes' fastball topped out at 101.3 mph during his last start on a week ago vs. Memphis. In his Triple-A debut on 3/30 at Louisville, four of his five strikeouts coming on triple-digit four-seamers. The hardest-thrown fastball in Triple-A since velocity began being tracked in the minors in 2021 was 102.9 mph in 2023.

**Prospectus:** Enters the 2024 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect by both *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. ... Is rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 3 prospect in baseball and No. 9 by *Baseball America*. ... Is also rated as the No. 1 right-handed pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline. ... Was rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft and No. 2 by *Baseball America*. ... Was also rated first in "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball" and "Best Athlete, third in "Best Control" and fifth in "Best Changeup" by *Baseball America* in the Class of 2023.

**Geaux Tigers:** Went 13-2 with five shutouts, two complete games, 1.69 ERA (23er/122.2ip), SEC-leading 209 strikeouts, 20 walks and a .165 batting average against in 19 starts, leading the LSU Tigers to an NCAA Championship in 2023. ... Was named the College World Series Most Outstanding Player after going 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA and 21 strikeouts in two starts. ... Took home D1Baseball Player of the Year honors and was the SEC Pitcher of the Year. ... Also was the Dick Howser Award (for the national college baseball player of the year) after finishing second in the nation in ERA, third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.45) and fifth in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (5.28).
