NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 13-8, on Saturday at Delta Dental Stadium. The Ponies brought 15 batters to the plate and scored nine runs on 11 hits in the top of the first inning. The 11 hits marked a franchise record for most hits in an inning. Matt Rudick led the way with four hits and four runs batted in.

RUDY: Mets outfield prospect Matt Rudick recorded a career-high four hits and a career-high-tying four runs batted in on Saturday at New Hampshire. He hit a single and RBI double and scored twice in the first inning. Rudick drew an RBI walk in the second and hit a two-run double in the eighth inning. Rudick is currently riding a three-game hitting streak, hitting .538 (7-for-13) in that span with seven runs batted in, five runs scored, two homers and two doubles.

LET'S GET ROWDEY: Mets infield/outfield prospect Rowdey Jordan gave Binghamton a 2-0 lead two batters into Saturday's game with a two-run homer. He recorded his first four-hit game at the Double-A level and second of his professional career on Friday, with two doubles, two singles, an RBI, and stolen base. Jordan is starting to heat up and is currently riding a four-game hitting streak. He is batting .368 (7-for-19) with four runs batted in, five runs scored, a homer, and two doubles over his four-game hitting streak.

GUTS GLORY RAM: Mets No. 16 prospect Alex Ramírez recorded his team-leading seventh multi-hit game with a single and two-run double in the first inning on Saturday. Ramírez has dominated in this series and is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with five runs batted in, three runs scored, four doubles, five walks, and seven stolen bases over the first five games this week. Here are the 21-year-old's current Eastern League ranks: 1 st in stolen bases (11), 3rd in hits (24), T-3rd in doubles (6), 4th in average (.343), 9th in OBP (.409), and 9th in OPS (.905).

FOREVER YOUNG: Mets infield prospect Wyatt Young reached base twice on Friday night and scored a run. Young has scored four runs in the series and hit his second home run of the season with a solo shot on Wednesday night. Over his last three games, Young has two hits, three walks, a hit by pitch and four runs scored. Young hit two home runs over 90 games with Binghamton last season and already has two homers in his first 12 games this season.

MATTY D: Mets catching prospect Matt O'Neill reached base four times on Saturday. He hit an RBI single and scored in the first and also drew three walks. O'Neill is hitting .333 (3-for-9) with a .538 on-base percentage over three games with Binghamton this season. The Ponies are 3-0 with O'Neill behind the dish.

BLADE HAS BEEN SHARP: Mets No. 2 pitching prospect Blade Tidwell is slated to make his fourth appearance and second start of the season today. Tidwell has been strong over his first three appearances. In his last appearance on Sunday against Reading, Tidwell struck out three batters over four innings, while allowing one earned run out of the bullpen, after Max Kranick's rehab start. The 22-year-old struck out 10 batters over five innings out of the bullpen on April 16 against Reading after Kranick's first rehab start. Tidwell did not allow an earned run over 5.2 innings with five strikeouts at Erie on April 9, in his only start of the season thus far.

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

-AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.
