LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox fell to the Altoona Curve in a 5-1 defeat on Wednesday night. Bowie's lone run came in the eighth inning on an RBI single from **Jud Fabian**. OF **Dylan Beavers** also collected a pair of hits on the evening. Right-hander **Seth Johnson** allowed just one run in the opening five frames, striking out four and walking none. Altoona distanced itself with a four-run bottom of the seventh, aided by a pair of Bowie errors.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and will represent the Orioles at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX on Saturday. The No. 2 O's/No. 12 MLB prospect is the 14th Baysox player in franchise history to be named to the Futures Game and is the first since **Adley Rutschman** in '21. Basallo has reached base safely in 35 of his last 38 games dating back to May 21. He's tied for seventh in the Eastern League in home runs (12) and hits (77). He's the first teenager to hit double-digit home runs in an Eastern League season since **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** in 2018 (NH).

TERRY TWO BAGS

1B/OF **TT Bowens** ranks fourth in the Eastern League with 18 doubles this season. Bowens has notched multiple hits in three of his last five games and is hitting .276 with a team-high .806 OPS in the month of July with three home runs since June 22. Bowens is tied with **Jud Fabian** for the team lead with 41 RBI on the season.

FEAR THE BEARD

Between Double-A Bowie and High-A Aberdeen, OF/1B **Matthew Etzel's** 39 stolen bags this season are tied for seventh most in all of MiLB. The first member of the O's '23 draft class to reach Double-A, Etzel has hits in 16 of his first 21 starts at the level.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 59 of 71 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 6 prospect is tied for the team-lead in OBP (.339) and leads the team in walks (39), tied for the 4th-most in the Eastern League. Wednesday night was the 19th multi-hit game of the season for Beavers, who is hitting a team-high .300 in the month of July. Beavers is 5-for-7 this season against tonight's projected Curve starter, **Po-Yu Chen**, with a pair of home runs and a double.

ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff sports the fourth-best collective ERA in the Eastern League this season (3.86) and the best since June 1 (3.42). Bowie arms pace the league with 822 strikeouts. The Baysox bullpen has put in its shift, with the most innings (404.1) at the level and the third-best WHIP (1.19) in Minor League Baseball.

DON'T SWIPE ON SILAS!

C **Silas Ardoin** has set the standard when it comes to tossing out baserunners. Ardoin's 20 runners caught stealing are fourth-most in Double-A, while his 40.8 CS% is best in Minor League Baseball amongst qualifiers.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE?

The Altoona Curve enter tonight with a 36-47 record on the season - 7-7 in the second half. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, the Curve roster includes six of the Pirates' Top 30 prospects - RHP **Bubba Chandler** (No. 1 PIT/No. 51 MLB), RHP **Thomas Harrington** (No. 4 PIT), IF **Tsung-Che Cheng** (No. 7 PIT), OF **Jase Bowen** (No. 18 PIT), OF **Tres Gonzalez** (No. 25 PIT), 3B/OF **Charles MacAdoo** (No. 29 PIT). After winning six of the first seven in the season series, Bowie has dropped seven straight games to Altoona.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP **Po-Yu Chen** will be making his 15th start of the season tonight for Altoona and his fifth appearance of the campaign against Bowie. Chen has gone 1-2 with a 5.09 ERA (10 ER in 17.2 IP) against the Baysox this season. The international free agent signing out of Taiwan has settled in as the season has gone on, with a 2.68 ERA since the start of June, after posting a 7.98 ERA in the month of April.

2024: Has thrown 4th-most innings in O's system (67.2) and has struck out 2nd-most batters (90). Ended month of June with a 4.43 ERA, best of the season thus far. Baysox won nine of last 12 games that Pham has started in. Has struck out 7+ batters in five of last seven starts. Holds a 3.96 ERA in eight road starts. Has a 5.28 career ERA in four outings vs ALT in 15.1 IP. Stranded eight runners on base in 3.1 IP on 7/4 @ RIC. Threw first scoreless start of season by matching career-high 6.0 IP and 0 BB over 6 K to record win on 6/11 @ HBG. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. 163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing 7th in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
