FIREWORK FRIDAY: After splitting the series at Carolina last week, the FredNats have dropped the first three games of the series against the Columbia Fireflies at home, losing the first two games by two runs, and then suffered the first shutout loss of the season last night in a 6-0 defeat. The team has fallen 12 games under .500 for the first time this year, and will try to get back in the win column tonight behind RHP Riley Cornelio, who struggled to find the zone in his last start at Carolina. The 7th round draft pick out of TCU had a strong first month of his pro career, but has struggled with walks in his last couple starts. The FredNat offense has scored just five runs through the first three games of this series, and the team is now 4-12 at home this year.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Columbia lefty and the Carolina League strikeout leader Frank Mozzicato spun six shutout innings, allowing just one hit with seven punchouts, and the Fireflies scored five runs combined in the 6th and 7th innings off the FredNat bullpen to pull away for a 6-0 win on Thirsty Thursday. The FredNats only managed three hits in the game, and also made two errors defensively. Jarlin Susana gave up just one unearned run in four innings on the mound.

TOUGH SLEDDING: In three games so far this series, the Columbia bullpen has dominated the FredNat lineup. In the first three games this week, the Firefly relief pitchers have tossed 13 scoreless innings - six on Tuesday, four on Wednesday, and three more yesterday. Columbia holds the second-lowest team ERA in the Carolina League (3.00), and the Fireflies have struck out 398 batters this year, tied with Carolina for the league lead. This is the third straight week the FredNats have played a team that is in first place in their respective division, and the FredNats have played 28 of the 34 games this year against teams that are over .500, which is the second-most in the league.

SOLID SANCHEZ: After giving up eight earned runs in one relief appearance a month ago in Fayetteville, Bryan Sanchez has turned his season around for the FredNats. In his last eight innings, he's allowed just six hits and one earned run with nine strikeouts and just three walks. He has transitioned from a back-end bullpen guy to a starting pitcher for the FredNats.

STEHLY POWER: Despite only playing 2-3 games per week, FredNat infielder Murphy Stehly has the longest hitting streak of the season for a FredNat at 12 games. Stehly, a 10th round draft pick of the Washington Nationals last summer out of Texas, played one game with the FredNats last year after the draft before being injured in that game.

HOLDING CORT: In his second year as a FredNat, Cortland Lawson has stepped up in a big way. He drove in four runs last series, and in the month of May, he's hitting .367 with two doubles, a triple, eight RBI, four walks, and an OPS of .972.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Riley Cornelio made his professional debut for the Fredericksburg Nationals in a start at Fayetteville this season, after being selected in the 7th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. The 22 year-old righty more than answered the bell, firing five innings with just one earned run, while picking up seven punchouts to just a pair of walks. However, he was saddled with the loss in a 3-2 defeat against the Woodpeckes

A stalwart for the TCU Horned Frogs, Cornelio led the team in '22 with 15 starts, and also finished first with 77 strikeouts in 75.0 innings of work.

The right-hander excelled in Big 12 action, posting a 3.12 ERA with 40 strikeouts in just seven starts. His work earned him 2nd Team All Big-12 honors.

HIGH HONORS: Cornelio was a highly touted arm coming out of Pine Creek HS in Monument, Colorado. Baseball America tabbed him as the top overall draft prospect in the state for 2019, as he earned both the Perfect Game and Gatorade Colorado Player of the Year award in his senior campaign

LAST TIME OUT: Riley Cornelio had a hard time locating his pitches during his last start against the Carolina Mudcats. Riley lasted just two innings while walking five hitters, though he managed to allow just one earned run.
