A WEEKEND IN MARYLAND: After dropping three one-run games in the first four of this series, the FredNats need two wins on the weekend to salvage a split in the six-game set with the Delmarva Shorebirds, Single-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles as the Beltway Series in the Carolina League continues as the Major League Beltway Series plays out this weekend at Camden Yards. LHP Angel Roman gets the Saturday start for Fredericksburg aiming to build on a much better stretch recently.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT**: The FredNats fell to 4-8 in one-run games and endured a fourth walk-off loss in the first 36 games this year in a 2-1 defeat to Delmarva. The FredNats managed just four total hits on offense, and Jackson Ross's game-tying RBI single in the 8th was the only run. Yoel Tejeda Jr. pitched six innings of one-run ball for his best professional start, and Robert Cranz and Merrick Baldo covered three scoreless relief innings for the bullpen.

WHAT IS HAPPENING: In the three losses this week to the Shorebirds, the FredNat pitching staff has allowed a total of five runs (four earned). In 30.2 total innings this series, Fredericksburg pitching has allowed just five total earned runs with 42 strikeouts and 17 walks. That is an ERA of 1.47, which is the fifth best in MiLB this week. Outside of the 12-run explosion on Thursday for the FredNat offense, the team has scored a total of two runs in the other three games of the series.

HE MIGHT BE GOOD: Nationals No. 6 prospect Luke Dickerson made his full-season debut with the FredNats on Wednesday in the twinbill and is off to a scorching hot start as a FredNat. He hit two doubles in first two at-bats on Wednesday, and last night, slugged a three-run homer to effectively put Thursday night's game to bed. In four FredNat games, Dickerson is 5-for-13 with a homer, two doubles, five RBIs, and a walk. Dickerson was taken 44th overall by Washington out of Morris Knolls HS in New Jersey, and his \$3.8 million signing bonus is the largest for someone taken outside of the first round in the bonus pool era.

**HE'S A SLUGGER**: FredNat infielder Jackson Ross is second in the Carolina League in slugging heading into tonight's game, and he continues to be near the top of the league leadeboard in several other categories. Ross is slugging .551 on the season, and his .899 OPS ranks sixth in the league. Ross is also tied for the lead on the FredNat team with eight doubles on the year, and his 14 extra-base hits is tied for 3rd in the Carolina League.

**DON'T EVEN TRY IT:** The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 38.6% of base runners this year which is first in all of Single-A baseball among qualified catchers, and he ranks second in all of MiLB with 17 caught stealings. Rombach has 11 caught stealings, which is 7th in the Carolina League and 10th in Single-A. Rombach is throwing out 33% of potential base stealers this year, which is Top-15 in Single-A percentage wise.

**LET'S TRY THIS AGAIN?**: The 2024 Carolina League Champion FredNat squad absolutely obliterated the Shorebirds all of last season. In 21 meetings between the two teams last year, Fredericksburg went a staggering 18-3 and outscored Delmarva 120-62. The FredNat pitching staff had a team ERA of 2.58 against the Shorebirds, and struck out a total of 199 Delmarva hitters. In 192 innings pitched against Delmarva, the Shorebirds only had 137 hits compared to Fredericksburg's 164. Fredericksburg also went 44/49 stealing bases against Delmarva last year.

**2024 CHAMPIONS**: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

**MEET HIM:** Angel Felix Del Valle Roman (Pronounced: Row-mon) spent 2022 and 2023 in the DSL before coming stateside last year to play in the FCL and with the FredNats.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Roman started on Saturday last week against Lynchburg and found some tough luck. He gave up seven hits and five total runs, although only three of them were earned. His defense struggled behind him at times but he was stuck with the loss, his third of the year.

**ROLE REVERSAL:** Roman has been almost exclusively a reliever in his three years in Nationals' system, with just five starts in 52 total appearances. Tonight, he makes his sixth start this season with two relief appearances.

**PART OF HISTORY:** Roman pitched the 7th and 8th innings during Fredericksburg's first nine-inning no hitter in franchise history on 8/9/2024 vs Carolina.

### **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



### JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
