LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox fell short on Wednesday, suffering another loss to the Hartford Yard Goats 6-3. Bowie was aided by a strong start from Dean Kremer on a Major League Rehab Assignment, but Hartford plated five runs against Antonio Velez. Gunnar Henderson helped break through for a late Bowie rally with a two-run home run, his third homer in two games. Kremer pitched two scoreless frames, and threw an immaculate inning, striking out the side on nine pitches, in the first inning. Bowie continues to slide with a season-high six-game losing streak, but still got good days from Henderson and later Zach Watson. On a 1-for-3 day with a walk and a run scored, Watson has pushed to a five-game hit streak, his longest of the season.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Hartford and Bowie have settled to some very similar numbers over the first six weeks of the season. Entering the series, both teams have scored exactly 155 runs, while Bowie does have a slightly higher ERA, compared to Hartford's 4.40. Hartford has relied plenty on their speed, as they lead the league with 62 stolen bases, despite only having two players with double-digit steals so far this year. Hartford has had to coast on their early offense this season, as their starting pitchers have the third-highest ERA in the league, while their bullpen arms have the second-lowest ERA in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Noah Gotsis is surging at the Double-A level after only making one appearance above Low-A in his career prior to this month. While he opened the season with Low-A Fresno as a reliever, he joined the Hartford rotation on May 1st and opened his career with 11 scoreless innings. A contact pitcher that has only struck out six total batters in his three Double-A starts, Gotsis works on the top half of the zone, as he draws 65% fly balls.

POWER PACKED

Bowie has been relying on their home runs recently. In their last four games, Bowie has scored nine of their 13 runs on home runs. Bowie has scored about 35% of their runs on home runs this season, sitting in the middle of the league.

ORTIZ ON IT

Infielder Joey Ortiz has taken a big step in the right direction this month. In 18 games in April, Ortiz only hit .188 with a .535 OPS. In 12 May games, he's bounced back to hit .275 with a .908 OPS, as well six walks to only eight strikeouts (6BB, 22K in April) Ortiz was ranked as the Orioles #15 prospect entering the 2022 season according to *MLB Pipeline*, and #16 according to *Baseball America*. This rebound comes after Ortiz only played 35 games in 2021 due to a torn labrum in his left shoulder in late June that required surgery.

STARTER SHORTAGES

Behind a handful of factors, Bowie has been having to rely on many of their bullpen arms for spot starts recently. While Conner Loeprich and Griffin McLarty each have starting experience in their careers, both have shifted into full-time relief roles before being called upon in the last two weeks to start. Since the start of Bowie's series with Harrisburg on May 3rd, Baysox starters have only accumulated 47.1 innings of work, an average of less than three innings per start, and the ERA from starting pitchers has risen from 3.70 to 4.40.

TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson is on a stellar stretch in May. This month, Gunnar has hit .370 with an 1.209 OPS. He's also drawn 11 walks and only struck out 10 times. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to over 20% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to *MLB Pipeline*. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by *Baseball America*. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

Career Notes

- After initially being drafted as a reliever for the Pirates, began the transition into more starting roles in May 2019. Made 33 appearances out of the bullpen before making his first career start.
- Return to High-A after recovering from his torn meniscus was tough, allowed 17 earned runs over eight innings, including five home runs. Allowed only 18 earned runs over his following 38 innings to complete the season.

Notes by Outing*

- 4/12 @ BNG Second pitch thrown in his Double-A career was served to left field for a solo home run by Ronny Mauricio. Would go on to allow a career-high three home runs.
- 4/17 v AKR Followed Zach Peek in relief. Struck out three batters in his first inning, but also allowed a walk and a two-run home run, allowed five additional hits and three runs in his second inning. Bowie still lead by six runs when he departed.
- 4/24 v AKR Again followed Peek. This time faced only two batters over the minimum. Allowed a runner to reach third base because of a catcher's error, but worked scoreless.
- 4/30 @ RIC Followed Zach Peek, only other reliever used was Nolan Hoffman for the eighth inning. Allowed a two-run home run to Will Wilson in the sixth inning.
- 5/8 v HBG First start of the season, came in back end of a doubleheader. Only baserunner charged to him was a two-out single in the first inning. Batter also reached on error in the third inning.
- 5/13 @ REA Bowie jumped to an early lead, and Loeprich followed with a scoreless inning around a walk, but allowed a two-run home run to Jack Conely in the second inning. Allowed two more base hits in the third inning, but stranded both runners.

Manager: Kyle Moore

Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
