Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the finale in a six-game series at the first half East Division champion Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The 15-game season series is tied 7-7; a Nuts win today would split the six-game series and win the season series, while a Dayton win would take both.

Last Night: Lugnuts 4, Dragons 3. In front of 7,647 at Day Air Ballpark, **Nathan Dettmer** fanned seven Dragons in 5 2/3 innings and **Jared Sprague-Lott** carried the offense with a sacrifice fly, RBI single and go-ahead two-run double for an Independence Day victory. **Pedro Pineda** went 3-for-3 with an HBP in the winning cause.

Starting Spotlight: A rematch from the opener, as **Steven Echavarria** looks to follow up his quality start on Tuesday (6 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 6 K, his third quality start of the year) against Dragons northpaw **Ty Floyd** (2 1/3 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 3 BB, 2 K on Tuesday). That opener, by the way, went 11 innings to leave both starters with no-decisions.

On Deck: After a day off tomorrow, the Lugnuts continue their two-week Ohio road trip to Lake County. The next home game: 12 days away, following the All-Star Break, beginning a three-game mini-series from July 17-19 vs. Fort Wayne.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 15 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 22 (**Nate Nankill**) and No. 29 (**Nathan Dettmer**). Baseball America's re-ranking of A's prospects placed Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Lugnut All-Stars: Among yesterday's MLB All-Stars were 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** (Toronto Blue Jays first baseman, A.L. All-Star starter at first base, announced he will sit out the ASG, replaced by the A's **Nick Kurtz** in the starting lineup); 2019 Nut **Otto López** (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve, leading the Major Leagues with 120 base hits and a .341 batting average, tied for 1st in MLB with 24 doubles); and 2022 Nut **Mason Miller** (San Diego Padres closer, 21-for-21 saves, 1.01 ERA, 66 K in 35 2/3 IP).

Lugnut Future Star: 2025 Lugnuts shortstop **Leo De Vries** was named to the American League All-Star Futures Game roster alongside fellow Athletics prospect / Midland RockHounds southpaw **Jamie Arnold**. De Vries competed in the Futures Game last year, too, when he was in the Padres' organization... and struck out on three pitches against fello 2025 Lugnut **Gage Jump**.

RBIs in Bunches: Before yesterday's 4-RBI performance, **Jared Sprague-Lott** had knocked in a total of four runs in his last 15 games dating back to June 16. What happened 16 games ago? He hit for the cycle and drove in four runs against Cedar Rapids on June 13... after only driving in six runs combined in his first 20 games for the Lugnuts. Notably, both yesterday and June 13 were Saturday nights. Sprague-Lott's High-A RBIs by day of the week: 2 on Tuesday, 1 on Wednesday, 2 on Thursday, 2 on Friday, 11 on Saturday, 0 on Sunday.

See You Next Year: After today, the Lugnuts and Dragons will not meet up again in a regular season game until the 2027 season, marking the earliest point this year that Lansing closes out a season series with an East Division foe. Days for the season series finale vs. the other division opponents: Fort Wayne - Sept. 6, Great Lakes - August 30, Lake County - August 9, West Michigan - August 16.

Lugnut League Leaders:

- **Zane Taylor** leads the MWL in ERA (3.55), ranks 3rd in innings (71), 2nd in WHIP (1.24) and 5th in opponent avg. (.240).
- **Samuel Dutton** is 1st in the league in innings (72), 5th in ERA (4.25) and 7th in WHIP (1.50).
- **Steven Echavarria** is 8th in innings (66 2/3), 4th in lowest average (.239), and 6th in WHIP (1.40).

Be Back Soon: Right-hander **Tzu-Chen Sha** has returned to Taiwan to fulfill a military obligation and is expected to rejoin the Lugnuts next week in Lake County.

Pitcher's Best Friend: These are the top two teams in the Midwest League at turning double plays, with the Lugnuts' total of 84 double plays in 78 games leading all of High-A, while the Dragons (78 double plays) rank second.

Cooperstown Bound: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

JULY 5 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

1999: Midwest League Prospect of the Year Corey Patterson became the first Lugnuts player to hit for the cycle, accomplishing the feat against the South Bend Silver Hawks.

2024: Starter Blaze Pontes gave up one run in four innings, Will Johnston struck out eight in four scoreless innings of relief, and the Lugnuts homered in three straight innings (Cameron Masterman in the 6th, Luke Mann in the 7th, Danny Bautista Jr. in the 8th) to rout Fort Wayne, 9-3.

2025: Pitching in front of his father and brother for the first time, Tzu-Chen Sha tosses two-hit ball over five innings to earn his first High-A win to lift the Lansing Locos over las Manzanas Luchadoras de Fort Wayne, 5-1.

MLB Pipeline's No. 15 A's prospect / No. 8 pitcher (behind Jamie Arnold, Gage Jump, Wei-En Lin, Braden Nett, Kade Morris, Shotaro Morii, Henry Baez); Fastball 55, Curve 45, Slider 55, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... topped the 2025 Lugnuts in starts (25)... closed A's 2026 Spring Breakout win, tossing the final two innings vs. Brewers prospects.

2026 Campaign: 2026 Lugnuts Opening Day starter... limited opposition to .195 avg. with 3.86 ERA in April, but allowed .260 avg. with 7.23 ERA in May, .263 avg. with 6.93 ERA in June... .218 avg. with bases empty, .268 with runners on... has allowed 16 of 18 stolen base attempts... opponents are batting .339 in the 1st inning, .149 in the 2nd, .167 in the 3rd, .340 in the 4th... in last outing, recorded third quality start of 2026: 6 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 6 K at Dayton, June 30.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Pro Ball: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
