FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: In their second doubleheader of the season on Wednesday, Bradenton Marauders were swept by the Dunedin Blue Jays 8-4 and 2-1. In game one, **Omar Alfonzo** clubbed a two-run home run, his third of the season. **Javier Rivas** plated the Marauders' lone run in the second on a solo-home run to right-center field. **Antwone Kelly** struck out a career-high eight in a career-high six innings.

JAVVY'S MASHIN: Over his last 10 games, **Javier Rivas** is slashing .448/.515/1.000 with two doubles, a triple, four home runs, eight RBIs, two walks, and seven runs scored. Rivas is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak and an eight game on-base streak entering Thursday night in Dunedin. Since June 1, the Marauders infielder leads the Pirates organization in AVG, HR, OBP, SLG, OPS, H (13), and XBH (7). During this stretch, his batting average on the season has been raised from .172 to .209.

FROM START TO FINISH: RHP **Antwone Kelly** tossed a six-inning complete game on Thursday night, becoming the second Marauder and third pitcher in the Florida State League this season to do so. Kelly joins fellow Marauder Christian Curtis and Juan Salas (Palm Beach) as the only other pitchers to complete this feat.

WEEKLY HONORS: On Monday, Major League Baseball announced that INF **Javier Rivas** and RHP **Carlson Reed** were named the Florida State League Player and Pitcher of the Week. In five games versus the Clearwater Threshers, Rivas went 9-for-16 with two doubles, a triple, two home runs, six RBIs, and four runs scored. The .563 batting average was the highest among qualified hitters in both the FSL and all of Single-A this past week. In his start on Thursday, Reed punched out a career-high nine batters in five scoreless innings while only issuing one walk and allowing two hits. Reed and Rivas join Omar Alfonzo as the only Marauders to win weekly awards this year as Alfonzo was named the Florida State League Player of the Week for the week of May 6 - 12. They're also the first duo to sweep the weekly awards since June 12 - 18, 2023 when Shalin Polanco and Alessandro Ercolani were named player and pitcher of the week. Since 2021, the only other same week winners for Bradenton are Tsung-Che Cheng and Valentin Linarez (Aug. 8-14, 2022) and Jase Bowen and Po-Yu Chen (July 25-31, 2022).

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games the second-most in the FSL with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. This came after the Marauders had only 10 longballs in 22 games in April. So far in June, Bradenton has 14 home runs in 11 games which is the most in the FSL and second-most in all of Single-A only trailing the Modesto Nuts (SEA) who have 15 in 10 games. Bradenton has homered in six-straight games which is tied for the longest active streak in the FSL with Fort Myers and Tampa.

WELCOME TO THE K ZONE: Bradenton's pitching racked up a season-high 17 strikeouts en route to an 8-0 victory over Clearwater on Thursday night. It's the third-most total by a team in the FSL this season with Clearwater having struck out 18 Lakeland hitters on 5/29 to lead the way. Bradenton struck out 17 hitters in game twice last year, with the most recent one on 6/9 vs Dunedin. The franchise-record is 21 set on 7/9/22 @ Lakeland. On the week, the Marauders punched out 76 batters in 54.0 innings, the second-most in Minor League baseball only trailing the Great Lakes Loons (High-A, LAD) who had 80.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the addition of **OF Enmanuel Terrero** last Wednesday night, the Bradenton Marauders now hold seven of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system. The Altoona Curve (Double-A) are the closest team holding six of the Top 30 with five of the Pirates top eight prospects there. **LHP Michael Kennedy** is the highest-rated player on the Marauders roster at No. 14.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Wednesday's loss in game two of a doubleheader in Dunedin marked the Marauders 23rd one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 11-1 record in those games with 40 of their first 59 (67.7%) games having been decided by three runs or less. Only two of the six games against Clearwater last week were decided by three runs or less.

GOT EMI: **Michael Kennedy** picked off Keaton Anthony in the second inning on Friday night for the Marauders 15th pickoff of the season. As of Thursday, the Marauders are currently fifth in MiLB, with the Quad Cities River Bandits (High-A, KC) leading the way with 20. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

Last Time Out: After allowing a leadoff single and a two-out walk to Pierce Bennett and Dakota Katowski in the first inning, Reed retired 13 of the final 14 batters in five scoreless frames. Struck out a career-high nine as well.

2024 Highlights:

- Named Opening Day starter. Struck out a career-high six batters in four innings of work. Four of the five runners left on-base were in scoring position.
- Struck out a career-high eight vs DAY (4/20)
- In a career-high six innings, allowed just one run in a 3-1 win vs Tampa (5/16)...also needed just 69 pitches in his outing. Became second Marauder this season, joining Michael Kennedy, to toss six innings.
- Earned the win in an 8-0 shutout after striking out nine in five scoreless frames against CLR (6/6). Was named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on 6/10 becoming the first Marauders pitcher to pick up that honor this season.
- **Enters start on 6/13 with the second-best GB% in the Pirates org. and fourth-best in the FSL among pitchers with at least 30.0 innings thrown.**

Personal:

- Enters the 2024 season as the Pirates' No. 26 prospect per Baseball America...moved up to No. 25 in May re-rankings.
- Became the first player from WVU to be drafted by the Pirates since Kim West in 1972.
- Became the highest-drafted Mountaineer since Alek Manoah was selected 11th overall by the Blue Jays in 2019.
- At WVU: Was an All-Big 12 first-team selection in 2023...went 2-1 with seven saves, a 2.61 ERA (38.0 IP, 11 ER) and 60 strikeouts in 25 appearances in 2023.
- Made three appearances (three starts) for the WV Black Bears and the Trenton Thunder in the 2023 in the MLB Draft League.
- Named to 2023 National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper-of-the-Year Award watch list.
- Was West Virginia's Opening Day Starter in 2022 against Central Michigan.
- Inspiration to become a pitcher came from older players such as Satchel Paige. Read a few books about him growing up and took an interest.
- Grew up playing the saxophone.
