Became the first player from WVU to be drafted by the Pirates since Kim West in 1972.

• Became the highest-drafted Mountaineer since Alek Manoah was selected 11th overall by the Blue Jays in 2019

• At WVU: Was an All-Big 12 first-team selection in 2023...went 2-1 with seven saves, a 2.61 ERA (38.0 IP, 11 ER) and 60 strikeouts in 25 appearances in 2023.
