NORTH LITTLE ROCK, AR – Northwest Arkansas Naturals first baseman **CJ Alexander** homered twice and drove in three of the Naturals' four runs, but the Arkansas Travelers came out ahead, 6-4 on Thursday night.

- The Travelers jumped out to an early 5-0 lead, scoring runs in each of the first three innings. After **Tyler Gentry** walked in the fourth, Alexander blasted a two-run home run to right field, extending his hitting streak to nine games.
- After a flyout, **Seuly Matias** connected on his second hit of the day, a loud solo homer to left field, his 15th of the season, to bring the Naturals within two runs at a 5-3 score.
- While the Travs added a run in the eighth to inch a run away, Alexander responded with a two-strike, two-out home run, his 22nd overall this season and seventh with the Naturals – and third multi-homer game of the year.
- Through eight games in August, Alexander is hitting .353 with hits in every game, eight home runs and now 15 RBI this month, with 23 total through 21 games for Northwest Arkansas.
- After allowing five runs over the first three innings, starter **Anthony Veneziano** settled down to throw two scoreless innings to end his outing. Right-hander **Will Klein** followed with 2.0 more scoreless frames, then **Jonah Dipoto** surrendered a run in the eighth but struck out two.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 6-5 all-time when playing on August 12

On August 12, 2011, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals shut out the Frisco RoughRiders, 2-0 at Dr. Pepper Ballpark. Starting pitcher **Jake Odorizzi** allowed two hits and three walks over 6.1 scoreless frames with two strikeouts and was followed by **Edgar Alberto Garcia**, who threw 2.2 perfect innings in relief and struck out two, to earn his third save of the season. **Nick Francis** brought in the Naturals' first run of the game on a sacrifice fly in the second inning. **Rey Navarro**, who went 2-for-3, stole third base and scored on a throwing error in the fifth inning for the second and final run of the game.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 13 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 4 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Jake Means and John Rave.**

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 34-8, while when scoring six runs or less, just 10-52.
- The Naturals are 31-13 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 14-46.
- The Naturals are 41-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 3-46 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 28-20, whereas 15-39 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 5-17 in one-run games this season, meaning 17 of their 60 losses (28.33%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 20 losses this season (including 13 of their one-run losses).

Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 104 games, the Naturals have stolen 135 bases in 167 attempts (average 1.30 steals/game, 80.84% success rate).

- 135 steals leads the Texas League, ranks fifth in Double-A and tied 27th in the Minors ... 80.84% success rate is 27th among 120 full-season MiLB teams.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 68 of 104 games this season (65.38%), including 34 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 17 times, meaning 34 of 135 steals this year (25.19%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 14 times, SIX of those occasions being Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
- Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks fourth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks seventh in the league.

TUCK(ER) AND ROLL

Naturals outfielder **Tucker Bradley** has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 74 of 90 games this season (82.22%) and reached base multiple times on 48 occasions, which ranks second on the Naturals behind Logan Porter's 49 ... he has hits in 64 of 90 games and has a team-best 28 multi-hit games, as well as 13 multi-run games and nine multi-RBI games.
- Bradley's .306 batting average leagues qualified Naturals hitters, ranks sixth in the Texas League and third among Kansas City's minor league hitters ... his .389 on-base percentage also ranks third in the system, while 99 hits are tied third, 18 doubles are tied sixth, 57 runs scored and 144 total bases rank tied eighth and his .833 OPS is ninth,
- The Georgia native has hit first in the order 22 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .315 hitter (28-for-89) with a .419 on-base percentage and .840 OPS ... when leading off innings, he hits .217 (27-for-85) with a .402 on-base percentage.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks **FIFTH** in batting average (.330) when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.330) and OPS (.977), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.424) and slugging percentage (.553) ... his 16 home runs between the River Bandits and Naturals are tied fifth in the system, while 61 runs batted in are sixth.
- Gentry has reached base in 38 of 43 games (88.37%) and has hits in 30 of his 43 games with the Naturals, with already 17 multi-hit games.
- In 43 games since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .325 (53-for-163) with nine doubles, 11 home runs and 38 runs batted in and a .998 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 20 of 41 games, with 10 multi-RBI games ... he leads the Naturals in nearly every category since then, with the highest average (.325), most total bases (95) and most runs batted in on the team (38) ... his 38 RBIs are tied for the most in the Texas League since then and .998 OPS ranks third since joining the circuit.
- Gentry's 18-game on-base streak between June 26 and July 17 is the longest for a Naturals player this season ... in that span, he hit .382 (26-for-68) with 10 extra-base hits and 12 walks, with an on-base percentage of .459 in that span.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- Over 21 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .264 (23-for-87) with 10 extra-base hits (seven home runs) and 23 runs batted in, with 13 runs scored as well.
- He has hits in 14 of 21 games with the Naturals, nine of which are two-hit performances, with hits in nine straight games, including all eight he's played this month ... he's driven in runs in 8 of 21, including already SIX multi-RBI games.
- In the month of August, Alexander is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with seven extra base hits (six home runs) and 15 runs batted in ... 31 total bases, 6 homers and 15 RBI all lead the Texas League this month
- In last week's series against Tulsa, CJ homered in four straight games, August 3 to 6 ... he is the third Natural this season and just the sixth all-time to homer in four consecutive games.
- Alexander began his Naturals tenure 0-for-12 over his first three games, then homered on July 16 @ Corpus Christi for his first hit with the team and went 4-for-10 in his next two games.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman **Robbie Glendinning** has returned to form, with a hot stretch that has carried through July into August.

- Glendinning's 65 runs batted in this season rank seventh in the Texas League ... his 64 runs scored are tied for the fifth-most in the Texas League, 160 total bases are tied ninth and 37 extra-base hits are tied ninth as well.
- He has reached base in 78 of 88 games he's played this season (88.64%), reaching multiple times in 41 games this season ... he has hits in 58 of 88 games, including 26 multi-hit games this season.
- Among Royals minor league hitters, Glendinning ranks as one of the top hitters in nearly every category ... he is third in the system with 37 extra-base hits and 64 runs scored and tied third in the system with 17 home runs and 65 runs batted in, fourth with 160 total bases ... his .482 slugging percentage and .849 OPS rank as the seventh-best in the organization, while his .367 on-base percentage ranks ninth.
- In 20 games in July, Glendinning hit .313 (26-for-83) with 11 extra-base hits and 21 runs batted in ... his 21 runs batted were are tied for the fourth-most in the Texas League in the month of July, seven home runs were tied fourth in the league and 51 total bases ranked tied fifth.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (3)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.
- June 27 to July 3: OF Tyler Gentry** ... hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, which was tied for the most in the league. Recorded 24 total bases with a 1.043 slugging percentage 1.543 OPS.

Pitchers of the Week (4)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
- May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.
- June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
- July 25 to July 31: LHP Dante Biasi** ... threw 5.0 scoreless innings on July 27 @ Wichita in an eventual 5-0 shutout win ... held the Wind Surge to just one hit and three walks while striking out five, on 79 pitches, his second straight scoreless start.

#24 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.

- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
