### TODAY'S HEADLINES

### Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 230-205 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints fell behind 6-0 after the first two innings and were Current Streak L2 unable to climb out of the hole in a 9-7 loss to lowa on Tuesday. The I-Cubs plated two runs in the first inning and dropped four in the second, clubbing three home runs in the game. The Saints responded with a four-spot in the fourth, hitting three home runs in four at-bats. Michael Helman got his first of the season to lead off the inning, followed by Jair Camargo and Yunior Severino, who went back-to-back to close the gap at 6-4. Trailing 9-5 in the ninth, the Saints cobbled together three hits and a pair of runs but fell just short in the loss.

CAMARGO CRUSHES THE CUBS: Jair Camargo picked up where he left off last year against lowa, hitting his sixth career homer against the Cubs on Tuesday. His six long balls are tied for the most against the Cubs in franchise history with former Saints Mark Contreras and Brent Rooker. His .633 slugging percentage is the second-highest for any Saint with at least 65 plate appearances against lowa (Jake Cave - .655). His 17 hits against lowa are seven more than he's had against any other opponent and his six homers are 

> THREE HOMERS HELPS, USUALLY: Tuesday marked just the seventh time in franchise history that the Saints homered three times in a game and did not come out with a win. Prior to Tuesday, the Saints were 58-6 in games where they homer three times in one game. It was also only the second time that the Saints have ever lost a game when they hit three home runs in one inning. The other instance came on April 6, 2023 in a 12-11 loss to the lowa Cubs.

SLOW OUT OF THE GATE: Offensively, the Saints have gotten off to a slower start than they have in previous years. Below is how the offense has fared through the teams first nine games of last four years:

Saints Get Quality Start ......0-0 RISP ASSESSMENT: Over the first four games of the season, the Saints were hitting .429 with runners in scoring position, ranking second in Triple-A. However, over the last five games they have gone 5-for-40 (.125) with runners in Most Games Under .500.................0, 0-0 scoring position, the lowest average in Triple-A. They also rank last in the Longest Win Streak 2, 2x, 3/30-31, 4/5-6 International League and 29th in Triple-A in exit velocity with runners in scoring Longest Losing Streak ............2, 4/7-active position in that span with an average exit velocity of 82.4 miles per hour. On the season, the Saints are 20th in Triple-A in exit velocity with runners in scoring position, with an average exit of 85.2 miles per hour.

Saints Get 10+ Hits ......0-0 HAVING A GRAND OL' TIME: The St. Paul Saints thrived with the bases loaded in 2023, clubbing 14 grand slams, the most in all of baseball. The 14 slam tied the modern day record (since 2005 in the Minor Leagues, as far back as minor league stats are available), matching Albuquerque who did it in 2022, Cleveland, who accomplished it in 2006 and Oakland who did so in 2000. No Major League team had hit more than 14 grand slams in a season in the Modern Era (since 1901).

with the bats. Across Minor League Baseball over the last three seasons in day games, the Saints are second in home runs (157), fourth in runs scored (604), and total bases (1595). Contrast that during night games and the Saints are 16th in homers (421), 25th in runs (1769), and 26th in total bases (4680).

> TWINS UPDATE: The Twins dropped their second straight game to the Los Angeles Dodgers on Tuesday, 6-3. Tyler Glasnow struck out 14 Twins in 7.0 innings without walking a batter. Louie Varland allowed a pair of three-run homers in his 5.0 innings. Cole Sands pitched 2.0 shutout innings to follow. The Twins scored all three of their runs on solo homers in the last two innings

LAST START: 4/4 @ NASH...threw 3.2 innings in start, allowing one run on three hits, walking four and striking out four...allowed two baserunners in the first inning...started the fourth inning with two walks, then allowing a single to score the lone run allowed before retiring his final two batters...primarily threw slider (27 times, 34%), throwing 52% of them for strikes...did not factor into decision in 4-3 Saints loss in 10 innings

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 3/31 v COL...came out of the bullpen to piggyback David Festa after originally scheduled Opening Day was cancelled...entered the game in the fourth inning, retiring his first 10 batters...14 consecutive Clippers retired between Festa and Dobnak from second to seventh innings...of first 10 retired, all came either groundout or strikeout...lone run came in the seventh came off a pair of doubles from Jhonkensy Noel and Daniel Schneeman...threw slider 43% of total pitches (24)...got 11 whiffs...received first victory in 8-1 Saints win.

SAINTS RANDY: In 2023, Dobnak was a workhorse for the Saints, setting a number of single-season records. He set the franchise record for starts (26), innings pitched (126.1 IP), and strikeouts (115). The 2023 season was Dobnak's third with the Saints and consequently he is the franchise leader in two of those three categories as well: his 33 starts are four more than the #2 pitcher. Simeon Woods Richardson. his 164.1 IP are 12.0 more than Ronny Henriquez, and his 147 strikeouts are just eight shy of Ronny Henriquez.

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often fo to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield

TWILIGHT SPARKLE MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBL

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything

NOT QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancées in full attire.

CANDLESTICKS MAKE A NICE GIFT: Before getting married, some of Dobnak's wedding registry gifts wound up in the Twins game notes on September 20 (Amazon Echo, 67-inch leaf rake and Pine-Sol). All of it was the handiwork of intern lan Kraft. The publicity of their registry becoming public made the soon to be married couple ask fans to donate to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, which has always been important to Aerial Dobnak due to her lifelong desire to be involved with children and her experience with the loss of a friend to cancer during her freshman year of college at Alderson Broaddus University, instead of buying them gifts. Their initial goal was \$2,000 and within 8 hours that goal was met. Eventually they raised \$4,093. But the story didn't end there. A representative of St. Jude reached out to her on social media afterward, wondering if the couple would be willing to engage in more significant involvement with the hospital once the wedding buzz had died down. They jumped at the opportunity, and the Dobnak's were flown to the hospital in Memphis for a weekend in January to meet patients, connect with fundraising coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement.
