YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 6-3, their second straight win in the series. With the score tied, 2-2, entering the eighth, Dayson Croes hit a go-ahead single to give Richmond the lead. Aeverson Arteaga brought home Justin Wishkoski with a sacrifice fly and Croes scored as Onil Perez was caught in a rundown between first and second. After an Erie run in the bottom of the eighth closed the score to 5-3, Turner Hill hit a two-out double in the top of the ninth and scored on a single by Scott Bandura, extending the lead to 6-3. Tyler Myrick closed out his league-leading 10th save of the season with a 1-2-3 ninth. The Flying Squirrels took a 2-0 lead in the sixth with a pair of two-out, bases-loaded walks. Max Anderson cut the score to 2-1 in the bottom of the sixth with a sacrifice fly and Ben Malgeri hit a tying homer in the seventh. Trystan Vrieling made his Giants organization debut and threw 5.1 innings, allowing one run.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third as a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the third and final series between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels went 2-4 against the Sea-Wolves at The Diamond from May 13-18. They also went 2-4 at UPMC Park from June 3-8.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,556 fans per home game, which ranks seventh among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are in second place in the Southwest Division second-half standings, 2.5 games behind Altoona. Last week, they dropped four of six at Somerset. It was their second straight series loss after winning their previous three series. After going 10-2 from July 4-20, they are 5-8 in their last 13 games since July 22. Of Richmond's 62 losses this season, 35 of them have been by two runs or less (22 by one, 13 by two). Their 22 one-run losses are second-most in the EL, one behind Reading. Richmond's +14 run differential in the second half is third-best in the league. In their last 13 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .195 (23-for-118) with runners in scoring position and left 91 on base.

THE SEAWOLVES won the Southwest Division first-half title to clinch their fourth consecutive postseason appearance. They are in third place in the division's second-half standings. Erie split last week's series at Akron, winning three straight from Thursday through Saturday before dropping the finale on Sunday. The Erie offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.260), runs (534), hits (887), total bases (1413), doubles, (202), RBIs (491), OBP (.347), SLG (.414) and OPS (.761). The Erie pitching staff is second in the EL in ERA (3.25). Erie's roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including SS/2B Kevin McGonigle (No. 1), OF Max Clark (No. 2), C Thayron Liranzo (No. 4), C Josue Briceño (No. 5), RHP Jaden Hamm (No. 7), 2B Max Anderson (No. 13) and OF Justice Bigbie (No. 27). There are also four players on Baseball America's top-100 prospects list, including McGonigle (No. 2), Clark (No. 6), Liranzo (No. 6) and Briceño (No. 75). MLB.com's top 30 Tigers prospects list features nine Erie players, including McGonigle (No. 1), Clark (No. 2), Briceño (No. 4), Liranzo (No. 5), Anderson (No. 9), Hamm (No. 10), OF Roberto Campos (No. 20), Bigbie (No. 26) and RHP Yosber Sanchez (No. 30). MLB.com's top-100 prospects list features four Erie players, including McGonigle (No. 6), Clark (No. 10), Briceño (No. 51) and Liranzo (No. 76).

**STRONG ARMS:** Since June 18, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 3.14 ERA (116 ER/333.0 IP) in 39 games, which is fourth in the Eastern League. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 2.82 ERA (51 ER/160.1 IP) in that stretch. In their last 20 road games since June 18, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.74 ERA (53 ER/174.0 IP).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Shane Rademacher makes his second Double-A start. In his debut last Friday, he threw 3.2 FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Shane Rademacher makes his second Double-A start. In his debut last Friday, he threw 3.2 innings and allowed one run on three hits in a no-decision at Somerset. He started the season with High-A Eugene and went 6-5 with a 2.60 ERA in 18 outings (16 starts) before being promoted to Double-A on Tuesday. With the Emeralds, he was leading the Northwest League in ERA (2.60) BAA (.219), WHIP (0.98) and BB/9 (1.39). For the year, he leads the Giants organization in ERA (2.59), WHIP (1.01) and BAA (.219). After allowing one run in four relief innings in his High-A debut, Rademacher threw four consecutive scoreless starts from April 13-May 1, earning two Northwest League Pitcher of the Week awards and was named the league's April Player of the Month. In Rademacher pitched at NCAA DII Chowan University in North Carolina for four seasons and signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2023. For more on Rademacher, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Garrett Burhenn makes his 19th start of the season and his sixth against the Flying Squirrels in his career. He last pitched on Friday against Akron and threw seven scoreless innings in a win. For the year, he leads the Eastern League in wins (11) and ranks sixth in WHIP (1.16), eighth in ERA (3.55) and ninth in BAA (.234). In five career starts against Richmond, Burhenn is 1-1 with a 6.86 ERA (16 ER/21.0 IP). Burhenn joined the SeaWolves last May and pitched 20 Double-A games to close the season. Burhenn was selected by the Tigers in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State, where he was a teammate of Seth Lonsway.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of Adrián Sugastey, Zach Morgan and Onil Perez have combined to catch 54 stolen base attempts this season, which first among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 39 runners caught stealing. Sugastey has set a franchise record for the most caught stealing in a season in Flying Squirrels history, passing Jackson Williams' mark of 35 set in 2015 with his 36th on July 26 against Portland. For his career with Richmond, Sugastey's 52 runners caught stealing for his career is third-most in franchise history, trailing Eliezer Zambrano (53, 2010-2017).

**BERI BOMBS:** Victor Bericoto hit his ninth homer of the season in the second game last Friday's doubleheader, which leads active Richmond players for the year. It was the 31st homer of his Flying Squirrels career, moving him into third place on the franchise's all-time home run list, passing **Jarrett Parker** (2013-14). He is now two homers behind **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22) for second place on the list and six behind **Ricky Oropesa's** (2013-16) franchise record of 37. He also drove the 118th RBI of his Richmond career in the first game of Friday's doubleheader, moving him ahead of **Hunter Cole** (2015-17) for second place on the franchise's all-time RBI list. Bericoto now has 121 career RBIs with Richmond, trailing only Oropesa's record of 165. In his last four games since Friday, Bericoto has six hits, four walks, two doubles, a homer and four RBIs.

**UNTUCK:** Tyler Myrick recorded his 10th save of the season in Wednesday's 6-3 win at Erie. It was his second straight day closing out a save. For the year, he is tied for the league lead in saves. It was the 22nd save of his Flying Squirrels career, moving him into a tie for fifth place on the franchise's all-time saves list with **Josh Osich** (2013-16). His next save will tie him with **Rafael Cova** (2010) for fourth on the franchise's all-time saves list with 23. Myrick has converted six of his seven save attempts since July 1 over 11 appearances. He picked up his first win of the season on July 25 against the Sea Dogs, working the final four outs. Since June 28, Myrick has posted a 1.23 ERA (2 ER/14.0 IP) in 12 appearances.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is ranked sixth in walks (51) and sixth in hits (91). Turner Hill is tied for fourth in triples (5). Seth Lonsway is 10th in innings pitched (92.0) and seventh in ERA (3.52). John Michael Bertrand is third in innings pitched (100.0), fourth in ERA (3.06) and ninth in WHIP (1.28). Jack Choate is third in strikeouts (102), sixth in ERA (3.43) and tied for eighth in BAA (.232). Joe Whitman is seventh in strikeouts (95). Tyler Myrick is first in saves (10).

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 243 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Richmond's roster features four players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bo Davidson** (No. 4), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 8), **Joe Whitman** (No. 9) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. **Adrian Sugastey** is ranked as the top defensive catcher. **Aeverson Arteaga** is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 5), Whitman (No. 14) and Velasquez (No. 21).

# THIS DATE IN RICHMOND

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1964: The Richmond Virginians beat the Buffalo Bisons, 4-3, in 10 innings at Parker Field. Early homers by Mickey Harrington and Art Lopez gave the Vees a 2-1 lead in the fourth. Buffalo tied the game in the sixth and took a 3-2 lead in the seventh. In the bottom of the ninth, Elvio Jimenez tied the score with a solo homer. Billy Muffet worked out of a bases-loaded jam in the top of the 10th. With the bases loaded and two outs in the 10th, Buffalo pitcher Ed Bauta balked to bring home Horace Clarke for the winning run. 1989: The Richmond Braves split a doubleheader with the Toledo Mud Hens. The first game lasted 21 innings and took five hours and 21 minutes. Richmond scored a run in the first on a sacrifice fly by Ron Gant. Toledo tied the score in the fourth on a double play, one of eight by Richmond in the game. The Mud Hens stranded 21 runners on base. Larry See brought in the go-ahead run in the top of the 21st on an infield single and Chris Alcarez hit a two-run single to lift Toledo to a 4-1 win. The second game started near midnight and the R-Braves won, 3-0. Dwayne Henry threw six innings and Mike Stanton closed out his second save. Drew Denson drove in the first run in the second with a double. Kash Beauchamp added a sacrifice fly in the fourth and Mark Lemke hit an RBI single in the fifth. The second game ended at 1:57 a.m. and the doubleheader lasted seven hours and 57 minutes. 1990: The Richmond Braves split a doubleheader with the Rochester Red Wings. In the first game, Geronimo Berroa tied the score in the bottom of the seventh and Bruce Crabbe won it, 6-3, with a walk-off, three-run homer. Rochester won the second game, 4-3. 2022: The Flying Squirrels beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 19-1, in Manchester. Richmond Scored seven runs in the top of the first. Brett Auerbach hit a two-run double and later scored on a wild pitch. Riley Mahan hit a grand slam, the 128th homer of the year for the Flying Squirrels, breaking the franchise's single-season record of
