### LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped both seven-inning contests in Wednesday's doubleheader with the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 5-1 in game one and 2-0 in game two. Right-hander Mychal Givens started game one for Bowie on a rehab assignment, allowing back-to-back doubles with two outs in the first inning to give Richmond a 1-0 lead. After 1.1 innings from Givens, Connor Gillispie came on for the Baysox. The right-hander allowed a pair of home runs - a two-run shot from Marco Luciano in the third and a solo homer from Carter Aldrete in the fourth - to make it 4-0 Flying Squirrels. Richmond tacked on another run in the seventh to make it 5-0, as Bowie avoided the shutout with a solo home run by Billy Cook in the bottom half - his sixth home run of the season. In game two, right-hander Justin Armbruester went all seven innings, but did allow a leadoff double from Brandon Martorano to score on a wild pitch in the second. Richmond added an additional run in the fifth on a sacrifice fly from Simon Whiteman. Kai-Wei Teng threw five shutout frames to open for the Flying Squirrels on just 49 pitches with three hits and five strikeouts, before Jose Cruz pitched the final two innings, as the Baysox were shutout for the second time this season.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter today with a record of 27-32 - fifth place in the Southwest division and 2.5 games ahead of the Baysox. Since entering their series in Bowie against the Baysox in late April atop the division standings, the Flying Squirrels are 14-25, having lost three of their series, while splitting the other three, and dropping five games out of first place in the process. Richmond has the second-fewest errors (41) in the Eastern League and the fewest home runs hit away from home (21) of any team in Double-A, but are going against a Baysox team with the second-most errors (56) and home runs allowed at home (58) in the league. The Flying Squirrels roster includes 10 of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Wisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Randy Rodriguez (No. 25 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

The Flying Squirrels are set to start right-hander Ryan Murphy tonight. Murphy has allowed plenty of contact in 2023, with opponents hitting .303 against him, with 50 hits across his 41.2 innings, including seven home runs. The right-hander has struck out just 36 batters compared to 21 walks. Murphy is coming off his best start of the season, tossing four shutout innings this past Saturday against Altoona with four hits, two walks, and two strikeouts. Murphy threw four innings in Bowie against the Baysox back on 4/29, allowing two runs (one earned) on a pair of hits, with a walk and four strikeouts. Murphy pitched collegiately at Division II Le Moyne (NY) alongside MLB arm Josiah Gray in 2018. Currently the No. 27 prospect in the Giants' system, Murphy features a Low-90s fastball, along with a slider, curveball, and changeup.

### DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 20 doubles and is second with 30 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles' No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has hits in eight of nine games, batting .324 (11-for-34) with five extra-base hits. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 35 walks, 29 RBI, a .407 OBP, and a .929 OPS. He is in the midst of a 28-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 29, Heston Kjerstad - 29) and the fourth-longest such streak in the Eastern League.

### LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook is currently riding a season-long, eight-game hitting streak. During that stretch, Cook has hit .355 (11-for-31) with four doubles and two home runs. Cook has hit particularly well at Prince George's Stadium this season, where he is hitting .261 with nine extra base hits, including all six of his home runs.

### HOBBLING AT HOME

Despite a strong showing each of the past two series on the road, the Baysox are still looking to get back on track at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie's 11-21 record at home this season is second-worst in the Eastern League. The Baysox have yet to win a series at home this season and have only split at home on one occasion this season in five attempts. This, in part, stems from a staff ERA that jumps to 5.04 at home (third-highest in the league), compared to 3.42 away from home (lowest in Double-A). 50 of Bowie's 73 home runs allowed this season have come at home - the second-highest mark in the league.

## CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

## NOTES BY OUTING\*

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/5 Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.
- 5/11 Struck out seven of first 11 batters faced. Faced one over the minimum through four innings, but allowed two singles to start the fifth inning before striking out the side. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/17 Allowed each of the first three batters to reach base, and all to score on two sacrifice flies and a double. Allowed two more runners to move into scoring position, but none to third base.
- 5/23 After Bowie had taken a 2-0 lead in the second, allowed a walk and game-tying two-run home run in the bottom of the frame. Only allowed two baserunners over final three innings.
- 5/28 Faced the minimum over the first two innings thanks to a double play. Allowed three doubles. First five batters reached safely in the fifth inning.
- 6/3 Gave up a single and home run to the first two batters. Needed 71 pitches for just the first three innings. Allowed a second two-run home run in the fourth. Career high in hits allowed
- 6/9 Gave up a two-run home run to second batter of the second inning. Allowed two more runs in the following innings on three-consecutive two-out hits.
