CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: Lake County closed its series at Lansing on a high note, defeating the Lugnuts 13-9 in 10 innings. The Captains are now 2-0 in extra-inning games this year.

With 1 out in the top of the 9th inning, Lake County forced extras after **Alex Mooney** hit a sacrifice fly and **C.J. Kayfus** brought home the tying run after a fielder's choice and a throwing error.

The Captains exploded for 4 runs in the 10th inning. 3B **Maick Collado** hit a 2-run single, **Advincula** sac-bunted in a run, and 2B **Nate Furman** plated the game's final run on an RBI single.

The bullpen threw 5 shutout innings. RHP **Magnus Ellerts** (1-1) earned the win with 2 shutout innings and 3 strikeouts. RHP **Jay Driver** extended his scoreless appearance streak to 8, the longest active streak in the Midwest League.

SENSATIONAL SIX: **Furman** (4-5, 2 R, 2 RBI, 2 BB) and **Mooney** (3-3, 2 R, RBI, 3 BB) both reached base 6 times. This marked **Furman's** 2nd 4-hit game of the year, and **Mooney's** 4th 3-hit game of the season.

2024 VERSUS WEST MICHIGAN: Lake County leads the season series 7-2 through two series. The Captains took 2 of 3 games April 5-7 at home and won 5 of 6 contests April 23-28.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

LIPSCOMB LEADING THE WAY: Captains OF **Guy Lipscomb** leads qualified High-A hitters with a .378 AVG. He also ranks 2nd among qualified High-A hitters with a .482 OBP. Earlier this week, the 2022 5th-round pick became the only player from Single-A through Triple-A with a .479+ OBP, 9+ SB, 11-or-fewer strikeouts, and 96+ PA through 35 team games since 2005. The last MLB player to achieve these numbers was Hall-of-Fame 2B Joe Morgan, who did so in 1975 with the Cincinnati Reds.

THE FURMANATOR VS. LANSING: Lake County INF **Nate Furman** has performed very well at the plate against Lansing so far this season. In 8 games against the Lugnuts, the 22-year-old is slashing .447/.462/.684, while leading the Captains in hits (17), runs (9), home runs (3), and RBI (14). **Furman** has hit 3 of his 5 career Minor League home runs (all this season) against the Lugnuts.

SHAKE AND BAKE: Captains INF **Nate Furman** and OF **Guy Lipscomb** have been Lake County's offensive catalysts in May. **Lipscomb** (.459) and **Furman** (.400) are 1st and 2nd in MWL in batting average and have combined to bat .429 (48-for-112) with 6 homers, 25 RBI, 27 runs and 10 stolen bases.

TOP QUALITY: Through 39 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 11 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the most in High-A. RHPs **Austin Peterson** (4), **Trenton Denholm** (3), and **Carter Spivey** (3) have each recorded at least 3, while LHP **Parker Messick**, MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, has also recorded 1 this season (4/25 @ West Michigan, W).

BASH BROS 2.0: Captains INF **Alex Mooney**, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, and INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus**, MLB Pipeline's No. 28 Cleveland prospect, have accounted for 31.0% of Lake County's RBI, while hitting 12 of the team's 31 home runs.

YOU MAY BE RIGHT, GUY'S MAY BE CRAZY: But it just may be a **Lipscomb** that you're looking for. With another single on Friday, **Captains OF Guy Lipscomb leads all of High-A with a .456 AVG and leads the Midwest League with a .536 OBP (2nd High-A)**. He has reached base in all 15 of his games played this month, and is 1 of 8 qualified Midwest League hitters with a 1.000+ OPS during this span.

FURMAN SETTING THE TABLE: On Saturday night, Lake County INF **Nate Furman** hit a leadoff home run in the team's 2nd consecutive game. He became the first Captain to record a leadoff home run in consecutive games since OF Adam White in 2008, who did so on 5/5 and 5/6 (G1) vs. Kannapolis.

By the Numbers

33 INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus**, MLB Pipeline's No. 28 Cleveland prospect, has knocked in 33 runs through his first 30 High-A games. **Kayfus** has the most RBI by a Captain through 30 games since at least 2005.

87 Lake County and Lansing combined for 87 runs in the previous series, tied for the most combined runs in a High-A series last week. The Spokane Indians (High-A Affiliate of the Colorado Rockies) and Vancouver Canadians (High-A Affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays) also scored 87 runs in a Northwest League set.

26 OF **Guy Lipscomb** has recorded 26 hits so far this month, which are the most in the Midwest League and tied for the most in High-A. He is batting .456 (26-for-57) during this span, which leads all of High-A.

2-OUT HITTING: As a team, the Captains have driven in 15 runs with 2 outs over their last 2 games. Lake County's .280 AVG with 2 outs this season ranks 3rd in Minor League Baseball.

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,773 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,395-1,378 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-4 in the Midwest League in: wins (13, 1st), fewest walks (47, 1st), strikeouts (179, 2nd), innings pitched (184.2, 2nd), and WHIP (1.29, 5th).

HEROIC HITTING: Captains hitters have been having a strong season at the plate so far this season. The team ranks top-3 in the Midwest League in: AVG (.260, 1st), OPS (.748, 2nd), OBP (.356, T-2nd), fewest strikeouts (299, 3rd), runs per game (5.1, 3rd), hits per game (8.5), and (walks (76, 3rd).

LAST TIME OUT: In his first appearance back from Triple-A Columbus on May 15 at Lansing, **Juan Zapata** (ND) did not record a decision in his 2nd start and 8th appearance as a Captain this year. The right-hander spun 3 innings, allowing 2 earned runs on 4 hits, while striking out 1 and walking 2 in the 3-2 win. **Zapata** pitched two scoreless innings before the Lugnuts tallied 2 runs in the 3rd on a pair of RBI singles.

5/9 WITH TRIPLE-A COLUMBUS: After being assigned to Triple-A Columbus for the 2nd time this year on May 9 at Iowa (Triple-A, CHC), **Juan Zapata** made his 1st appearance of the season as a Clipper. He earned the victory after pitching 3 shutout innings, while allowing only one baserunner on a walk. He pitched innings 7-9 in the eventual 6-4 win in 10 innings. **Zapata** garnered his 2nd Triple-A victory in 3 appearances, and his first since 6/4/2023, which also came against Iowa.

TRAVELIN' MAN: In 2023, **Zapata** was the only pitcher in the Cleveland player development system to pitch at all 4 affiliated levels (Single-A through Triple-A). In total, the right-hander made 28 appearances (5 starts), going 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA, 60 strikeouts, and 19 walks in 78.2 innings of work.

LIFETIME AS A STARTER: In 43 career starts, **Zapata** is 4-16 with a 4.47 ERA, 134 strikeouts, and 56 walks in 197 innings of work, and is averaging 4.6 innings per start. The 25-year-old has recorded 5 quality starts, including a career-high 2 in 2022 with Single-A Lynchburg.

MIDWEST LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: **Zapata** was named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week after his only Lake County start of the 2023 season. On June 21, 2023 at Dayton, **Zapata** pitched a career-high 6.2 shutout innings, while striking out a career-high 9 in the 1-0 loss.

2023 WITH LAKE COUNTY: While his first quality start at Dayton was his lone start of the season with Lake County, **Zapata** made 20 total appearances as a Captain in 2023. He tossed 54.2 innings, the second-most among Lake County pitchers with under 10 starts. **Zapata** went 5-2 with a 4.28 ERA, 48 strikeouts, and 10 walks in 54.2 innings.

2023 WITH TRIPLE-A COLUMBUS: **Zapata** appeared in relief for the Triple-A Columbus Clippers on June 4 at Iowa (CHC) and Sept. 3 at St. Paul (MIN). He earned his first career Triple-A victory against Iowa, pitching 2.2 hitless innings in the 10-7 win.

OTHER NOTABLE BANÍ NATIVES: **Zapata** hails from Baní, Dominican Republic, a capital town of the Peravia Province. Other professional baseball players from Baní include: former Captain, 5-time MLB All-Star, and current Cleveland Guardians 3B **José Ramírez**, 6-time MLB All-Star Miguel Tejada, 2-time World Series Champion Juan Uribe and 3-time MLB All-Star Mario Melvin Soto.

Two former Lake County Captains have been promoted to the Cleveland Guardians during the 2024 season.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Monday, May 20, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians. He scheduled to make his MLB debut with Cleveland tonight against the New York Mets, as he is slated to bat 7th in the Guardians’ order and start in right field. **Rodríguez** played in 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, **RHP Cade Smith** made his MLB debut on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. **Smith** made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
