LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned their 2nd-straight win and their 6th victory in 7 games in Wednesday afternoon's 4-0 triumph over Winston-Salem...RHP **Cameron Foster** (5.0 IP), RHP **Robert Colina** (2.0), and RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (2.0) united on a 5-hit shutout...LF **Alex Ramírez** smashed the first pitch of the home 1st for a solo home run, collecting 2 hits and reaching base 3 times...2B **Kevin Kendall** went 2-for-2 with a run scored, an RBI, and a stolen base...Cyclones played in front of their largest crowd of the season: 6,483 fans at Maimonides Park.

TUNE UP TIME: C **Omar Narváez** joins the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment on Thursday...The 31-year-old landed on the Mets' 10-day injured list on April 7 (retro 4/6) with a left calf strain...Narváez was transferred to the 60-day IL on May 4...In 5 games with New York, the Maracay, Venezuela native was 4-for-14 with the bat (.286), adding a pair of RBI...Narváez has appeared in 605 Major League games, slashing .258/.343/.385 and a .728 OPS with the Mets, Milwaukee Brewers, Seattle Mariners, and Chicago White Sox...He was named a National League All-Star with Milwaukee in 2021...Narváez played against Brooklyn with the Hudson Valley Renegades in 2013, when both were members of the New York-Penn League...He was 1-for-8 with 3 strikeouts in 2 games on Coney Island.

BINGO BOUND: OF **Joe Suozzi** and INF **Warren Saunders** were transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday and Thursday, respectively...Suozzi finished his tenure on Coney Island with a season-best 10-game on-base streak...the Glen Cove, N.Y. native is 12-for-his-last-31 (.387) with 5 runs scored, 3 doubles, 5 RBI, 4 walks, and a stolen base...Suozzi has registered a .943 OPS and 158 wRC+ in those 10 contests...Suozzi led the squad with a .283 batting average (28-99) with 11 RBI in 29 games...Saunders appeared in 10 games for Brooklyn in 2023...He was 5-for-36 at the plate (.139) with 2 RBI.

IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Thursday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (174), at-bats (574), plate appearances (685), runs scored (92), walks (92), and stolen bases (43)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** (21) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (64) on Tuesday and is 5 behind INF **José Peraza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie native is 2nd all-time in total bases (188), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (110).

START ME UP: After not registering a win in the team's first 31 games, Brooklyn starters collected 4-straight victories during the team's season-high win streak between May 17 and Game 1 of Sunday's double-header at Hudson Valley, and 6-of-the-last-7 games total...In their last 7, Cyclones starting pitchers have amassed a 6-0 record with a 0.74 ERA (3 ER in 36.1 IP)...Brooklyn's starters have walked 16 and struck out 40.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 7 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 4 earned runs (10 total) on 35 hits through the last 60.2 innings...That is good for a microscopic 0.59 ERA...Cyclones' pitching has walked 26 and struck out 72 in that span...Brooklyn's strikeout rate is 30.3% during the streak...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 38-10, over the 7-game stretch...Brooklyn is 6-1 during that span.

THRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** has picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 13 games played dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old is slashing .311/.367/.556 with a .923 OPS...Estep has accumulated 7 runs scored, 6 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 10 RBI in 49 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 142 wRC+...Estep has garnered at least one knock in 11 of those 13 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21.

OMAR ON THE RUN: In addition to his 16 stolen bases in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 86 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (93), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (92), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (91)...De Los Santos has also snagged 50 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 36...Omar is already 16 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the White Sox High-A affiliate... The Dash poses 9 of Chicago's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...RHP **Norge Vera** (8), RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (11), RHP **Kohl Simas** (13), RHP **Jared Kelley** (14), OF **Wilfred Veras** (17), INF **Wes Kath** (18), OF **Terrell Tatum** (24), INF **Loidel Chapellí** (26), and RHP **Andrew Dalquist** (28) are featured...The Cyclones went dropped 5-of-6 to Winston-Salem in their first meeting at Truist Stadium from April 11-16...In last year's meeting at Maimonides Park, Brooklyn split the 6-game set from August 2-7.

GUIGUE GUNSLINGER: Guigue, Venezuela's LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023... In his first 12 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted an earned run (1 total) on 5 hits and 6 walks, striking out 24 (13.79 K/9)...In 17 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 2 unearned runs in 20.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 25 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 10 hits allowed, 15 walks, and 39 strikeouts in 30.1 innings...Since the streak began, no pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings without allowing an earned run.

STU'S CRUISE: RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 14.2 innings with 6.1 spotless frames in game one at Hudson Valley on Sunday...Stuart punched out 8 batters for his first pro win and leads the SAL in ERA (1.13)...Stuart is also 4th in the league in batting average against (.197) and 6th in WHIP (1.13)...Analytically, the right-hander is also among the SAL's best...Stuart is 2nd in FIP (2.86), 3rd in xFIP (3.49), 4th in strikeout rate (32.3%), and 5th in strikeouts per nine innings (11.81).

RAMÍ ROCKETS: OF **Alex Ramírez** reached base 4 times and tied a season-high with 3 hits on Thursday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old doubled twice, worked a walk, scored a run and drove in another... It was Ramírez's first multi-extra base hit game since he doubled twice on August 25, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in hits (100), doubles (25), and total bases (151)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** in extra-base hits (34) and is tied with Jersey Shore's 1B **Rixon Wingrove** in RBI (57).

ROAD WARRIOR: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has thrived away from Maimonides Park in 2023...Coming into Wednesday, the 22-year-old has posted a batting average 114 points higher on the road (.313) than at home (.182)... Away from home, Consuegra is slashing .296/.342/.577 with a .919 OPS adding 10 of his 15 extra-base hits and all 5 of his home runs...17 of his 19 RBI have been on the road, as well...As a team, the Cyclones are hitting 18 points better in visiting parks (.223) than on Coney Island (.205).

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (2/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (5/9)...INF **William Lugo** (24/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win of the season last Friday night at Hudson Valley...Permitted 1 run on 4 hits over 5.0 innings...Only run came in on a RF **Grant Richardson** home run in the 5th...Walked 2 and struck out 6...Induced a double play...Tossed a season-high-tying 86 pitches and a season-best 52 strikes (60.5%)...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Tebrake** to start the bottom of the 6th with Brooklyn leading, 2-1...Cyclones scored 3 in the 7th and added another in the 9th to defeat the Renegades, 6-1.

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by *Baseball America*...Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

2022: Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

COMEBACK TRAIL: Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
