BLUE JAYS NOTES

- The Dunedin Blue Jays fell 9-5 to the Tampa Tarpons in their series finale on Sunday afternoon at TD Ballpark.
- RHP Austin Cates** (5 IP, 1 R, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K) hurled five frames of one-run ball with four strikeouts and did not factor into a decision.
 - Cates did not allow a hit through his first 3.1 frames.
 - Over his last three outings, Cates has allowed three runs in 11.2 innings (2.31 ERA) with 13 strikeouts.
 - He's allowed one run or less in his last three outings.
- RHP Colby Martin** (1 IP, 0 R, 0 H, 1 BB, 0 K) fired a shutout ninth inning with no hits and one walk.
 - Martin has opened the season with 14 consecutive scoreless outings for Dunedin, recording 18 strikeouts in 15.1 innings and allowing only one hit.
 - His 14-game scoreless streak is tied for the longest in Minor League Baseball this season.
 - Martin has gone 11 outings without giving up a hit, with his last yielded hit coming on April 13 @JUP.
 - During that span, he's faced 43 batters without allowing a hit.
- 3B Tucker Toman** (2-for-5, 3 RBI, 2 2B) ripped a two-run double off the right field wall in the 3rd inning to make it 3-0, then lined an RBI double in the 5th to make it 4-1.
 - Sunday marked Toman's eighth multi-hit and fourth multi-RBI game of the season.
- C Edward Duran** (1-for-4, R, BB) extended his hit streak to 18 games with a single in the 1st inning.
 - Duran's hit streak is the longest in the FSL this season and tied with Jac Caglianone for the second longest active streak in Minor League Baseball.
 - Duran is batting .342 over the streak with nine extra base hits and 15 RBI.
 - Duran has reached base in 23 of his last 24 games and is batting .344 with 19 RBI and a .942 OPS over that stretch.
