NEW HAMPSHIRE FISHER CATS (34-37) vs. PORTLAND SEA DOGS (45-27)

FISHER CATS WIN STREAK AT FOUR: Demi Orimoloye went 3-for-4 with a home run as the Fisher Cats held off the Sea Dogs 5-3 last night. Orimoloye's third homer of the season, a solo shot in the top of the second inning, staked the Fisher Cats to an early 2-0 lead. Samad Taylor, who went 2-for-5, singled home a pair of runs in the fourth inning to make it 4-1, and Otto Lopez doubled home a run in the top of the ninth to give New Hampshire (34-37) a 5-3 lead.

A PAIR OF FIRSTS: Johnny Barbato earned his win as a starter with five innings of four-hit ball. He walked one run. Barbato's other win came in his lone relief outing against Hartford on July 13. Mike Ellenbest earned his first Double-A save last night with a perfect ninth inning.

TRADE DEADLINE: Two Fisher Cats were involved in a deadline deal between the Blue Jays and Twins. The Blue Jays traded 2020 overall #5 pick Austin Martin and RHP Simeon Woods Richardson for Jose Berrios. Martin slashed .281/.424/.383 in 55 games for the Fisher Cats. Woods Richardson, who Toronto had acquired from the Mets in the Marcus Stroman deal, is currently with the US Olympic team in Tokyo. He went 2-4 with a 5.76 ERA in 11 starts for New Hampshire. Woods Richardson impressed with 67 strikeouts in just 45.1 IP. The pair have been added to the roster of Double-A Wichita Wind Surge.

UP NEXT: The Fisher Cats will return to Delta Dental Stadium for a six-game set against the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies) next week. New Hampshire won the last series between the teams July 13-18 at Dunkin Donuts Park. A pair of fireworks shows are planned Thursday and Saturday nights.

BOB LIPMAN'S *THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY*: July 31, 2018—The Fisher Cats pounded out fifteen hits in an 11-5 win over Richmond at Delta Dental Stadium. New Hampshire fell behind 4-1 in the top of the second inning, but took the lead with a seven-run third which featured a Harold Ramirez grand slam.Santiago Espinal went 3-for-4 with three RBI.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays returned to the Rogers Centre with a 6-4 win over the Royals. Bo Bichette homered in the 7th as the Jays opened a 6-2 lead. Jordan Romano earned his ninth save. Buffalo lost 6-2 at Worcester. Cullen Large drove in both runs with a double in the fourth inning. Spokane rallied for a a 15-11 win over Vancouver. Dunedin won 12-5 over Bradenton after falling behind 5-0 early. The FCL Jays lost 5-4 to the Tigers.

STARTERS:

Casey Lawrence, the winningest pitcher in Fisher Cats history, starts the first game. Lawrence earned his 25th win in a New Hampshire uniform last Friday in a 5-4 win over the Fightin Phils. He worked five scoreless innings. Tonight's start will be his 67th for the Fisher Cats, tying him with Deck McGuire for most in team history. This is his 10th start against Portland (3-3, 3.56).

Luis Quiñones makes his second start for New Hampshire. Set down Reading in the first three innings without allowing a hit last Saturday, but only retired one batter in the fourth, when the Fightin Phils scored all six of the game's runs.

2019-21: Pitched in Japan in 2019- and started this year with York (Atlantic League). Signed back by Blue Jays May 19 and sent to Buffalo.

2018: Appeared in 30G combined with Seattle (11 relief) and Tacoma.

2017: Given a chance on Blue Jays opening roster, but struggled in four starts, and sent back to Buffalo. Mariners would claim him on waivers and he spent the rest of the year between Seattle and Triple-A Tacoma.

2016: Made 13 starts for the Fisher Cats---including six more quality starts (31 for 61). Spent second half of season in Buffalo's rotation, finishing 5-6 there.

2015: Made 26 starts for the Fisher Cats, finishing with a 12-13 record and for the second consecutive season, notched more than 160 IP. Tossed a nine-inning complete game on 5/29 in a win at New Britain – 13 of his starts were quality starts. (25 of 48 over two seasons).

2014: First full season in the Fisher Cats rotation, went 9-9 in 26G, including 22 starts. Had back-to-back eight inning starts July 20 vs. Portland and July 25 at Harrisburg. 12 of his 22 starts were quality starts.

Early Years: Progressed through the Blue Jays system, advancing from Auburn (Short-Season) to Class-A Lansing to Adv. A Dunedin. Made his Double-A debut with the Fisher Cats on April 20, 2012 at New Britain, and first start with NH April 28, 2012. Would spend most of 2012-13 with Dunedin.

Career/Personal Notes: Originally signed as non-drafted free agent 6/17/2010 (Albright College, Reading, PA). Claimed off waivers by Mariners 5/11/2017. Signed as minor league free agent by Twins 1/28/2020. Started this season with York Revolution. Back with Blue Jays as of 5/19/21 and pitched in Buffalo until July 22.


