ROUGHRIDERS TAKE SERIES OPENER OVER SAN ANTONIO IN FRONT OF MASSIVE CROWD:

With 11,495 in attendance, the Frisco RoughRiders bested the San Antonio Missions 4-3 on Tuesday afternoon from Riders Field. The crowd was the second-largest day game crowd in franchise history. Frisco (18-10) starter **Ryan Garcia** cruised through the first two innings before allowing a two-run homer to Missions (13-14) catcher Michael De La Cruz in the top of the third. In the bottom of the third inning, **Aaron Zavala** plated Daniel Mateo with a two-out single to center, cutting the deficit to 2-1. Garcia did not allow any runs outside of the third inning, exiting in the fifth. He finished with a final line of 5.1 innings pitched, surrendering two runs on three hits and no walks while tying his career-high with nine strikeouts. With the Riders trailing 2-1 in the bottom of the sixth inning, Strahm belted his second homer of the season, a solo shot to left field, which tied the game at 2-2. In the bottom of the seventh, **Geisel Cepeda** launched his first career Double-A home run to give the Riders their first lead, 3-2. San Antonio tied the game with an RBI single by Cole Cummings in the eighth inning against **Seth Clark**. Clark exited with two outs, giving way to **Anthony Ho'opi'i-Tuionetoa** (1-0). Cepeda made a run-saving, diving play in left field to end the frame. **Keyber Rodriguez** gave the Riders a 4-3 lead with a sacrifice fly to left field against Jayvien Sandridge (1-2) in the home half of the eighth, driving in **Josh Hatcher**. Offensively, Strahm led the RoughRiders with a 4-for-4 day, matching his career-high for hits. Zavala added a multi-hit performance with a pair of singles.

TRADE WITH THE SOX:

This morning, reliever **Anthony Ho'opi'i-Tuionetoa** was dealt to the Chicago White Sox in exchange for OF **Robbie Grossman**, who was a member of the 2023 World Series champion Rangers. Ho'opi'i-Tuionetoa had not allowed an earned run over 10 outings across 12.1 innings with 16 strikeouts to four walks.

MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders face their division opponents for the first time this season, but the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2023, Frisco went 13-11 against San Antonio and have gone 42-25 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021. **Evan Carter** was amazing against San Antonio last year, blasting six home runs and hitting .380/.505/.684/1.189 across 21 games. Of returners, **Aaron Zavala** led the way with 15 hits across 16 games, batting .288/.435/.285/.820. **Kellen Strahm's** game one homer in the series was his first against the Missions in 38 games, batting .265 (36-for-136).

POWER SURGE:

The RoughRiders have had more home run power recently as the calendar has moved along. Over their last 13 games, they have hit 15 home runs, which is second in the Texas League. During that same span, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just nine doubles, leading to a .380 SLG over their last 13 games, which is sixth in the league. For contrast, the Riders hit just six home runs in their first 15 games.

FIRING BLANKS:

After the RoughRiders' shutout win on Saturday, Frisco is second in the league with three shutouts on the mound this season. Over the last 12 games, the Riders are first in the Texas League with a 2.58 ERA. In the six games of the series against the Hooks, all but one starter went at least five innings.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Part of the RoughRiders' dominance on the mound has been the Frisco bullpen. Over the last seven games, the bullpen has allowed just five runs over 25.1 innings (1.78 ERA). On the season, the bullpen is fourth in the Texas League with a 3.83 ERA.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE (MAN):

Cody Freeman had a monster game last Thursday against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaine Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. Over his last 14 games, he is batting .321 (17-for-53)/.357/.585/.942 with two doubles, four home runs, eight RBIs and seven runs scored. In his last 11 games, he has batted .349/.364/.674/1.038 with all four of his homers.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's capper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .342/.398/.526/.924. Hatcher is fourth in the league in batting average (.342), eighth in slugging percentage (.526) and ninth in OPS (.924).

DOUBLE A-RON IN DOUBLE-A:

Aaron Zavala reached in his first 18 games of the season, slashing .279/.438/.393/.831 with four doubles, a home run and nine RBIs. Over his last five games in May, he has hit .368 (7-for-19) with a 1.087 OPS and 6 RBIs. He has both walked and struck out a lot this season, placing ninth in the Texas League in walk rate (17%) and seventh in strikeout rate (33%).

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.
