VILMINGTON: After sweeping their 2nd-straight home

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn's 7-game winning streak was halted in a 2-0 pitcher's duel defeat at Wilmington on Wednesday night...RHP Travis Sthele tossed a complete game, 1-hit shutout, facing just 1 batter over the minimum...The Blue Rocks' starter struck out only 2 and retired the final 23 batters in order...The 9.0-inning complete game shutout was the first against Brooklyn in Minor League Baseball's digital era (2005-present)...LHP Jonathan Santucci was outstanding for the Cyclones, tossing 51 innings of 5-hit shutout ball, striking out 5 without allowing a walk. SS Marco Vargas garnered Brooklyn's only hit with a leadoff single in the 2nd...Wilmington scored the game's only runs in the 7th on back-to-back ground-rule doubles from C Matt Suggs and 3B Jackson Ross...The game was completed in an hour and 48 minutes...It was the Cyclones' shortest 9-inning game since a 3-1 loss at Aberdeen on May 3, 2022, was also played in an hour and 48 minutes.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Thursday, Brooklyn holds a 1.5-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division...The Cyclones are 4.5 games up on 3rd-place Hudson Valley with 13 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn's magic number to clinch the first half division crown is 13...Any Cyclones wins or Grasshoppers losses will decrease the number...Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half... Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

YOU SAY IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY: Cyclones hitting coach **Bryan Muñiz** celebrates his 32nd birthday on Thursday...Muñiz is in his 1st season with the Cyclones and the New York Mets' organization after spending the last two seasons as Asheville's hitting coach.

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 3-0 over his last 4 outings (3 starts), including a career-high-tying 5.1 scoreless inning performance in a no-decision Wednesday at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP) with 11 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 22 strikeouts...Santucci has also thrown 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to the 2nd inning in game one of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (0.44), is tied for 1st in wins (3), 2nd in innings pitched (20.2), 3rd in batting average against (.153), 5th in WHIP (0.82), and 6th in strikeouts (22).

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 53 games of the 2025 season with last Friday's win over Aberdeen, clinching another series victory...Through Brooklyn's first 9 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 7-0-2 record...h home series, Brooklyn is 4-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13... The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 9-0-2 in a series of any length.

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS: Brooklyn secured its 2nd-straight home sweep with a 4-3 walk-off win vs. Aberdeen on Sunday...The Cyclones secured their 1st sweep vs. Winston-Salem in walk-off fashion, as well...On May 18, C Ronald Hernandez's game-ending RBI fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th helped the Cyclones complete their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021...Prior to May 18, Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021, vs. Wilmington...The 'Clones outscored the 'Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn's 6-game winning streak was snapped Tuesday at Jersey Shore...Additionally, the Cyclones' 37-16 record is the franchise's best record through 53 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn's 36-17 mark through 53 games in 2007 is tied 2nd-best.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn continued their dominance at Maimonides Park on Sunday with a 4-3 walk-off victory vs. Aberdeen...Sunday's triumph was the Cyclones' 13th-consecutive home win...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 22-5 (.815)...No one else in the league has more than 17 home victories (Greensboro and Greenville)...The 22 home wins are the most at the High-A level and tied with the Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas and Miami's Triple-A Jacksonville for the 2nd most in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Triple-A Toledo is 1st (23)...Brooklyn's .815 home winning percentage is the best in MiLB...Detroit's High-A West Michigan (.783) is 2nd.

REIMER SHINE: INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Entering play on Thursday, Reimer is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in runs scored (47) and tied for 6th in extra-base hits (27)...The former 4th-round pick also leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (47), slugging percentage (.572), OPS (.984), extra-base hits (27), hits (57), and doubles (16)...Reimer also ranks 2nd in batting average (.317), total bases (103), and RBI (36), 6th in on-base percentage (.412), tied for 8th in home runs (8) and games played (48)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn...D. Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week for May 3 vs. Wilmington snapped on Wednesday...During that time, Báez hit .3671.4751.544/1.019 with 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 23 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 17 walks to 11 strikeouts...On May 20, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.450) and RBI (26), is 2nd in batting average (.344), 3rd in OPS (.983), tied for 3rd in hits (31), tied for 4th in slugging percentage (.533), tied for 7th in total bases (48), and tied for 8th in runs scored (20) and walks (17).

vs. WILMINGTON: After sweeping their 2nd-straight home series, Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilmington enters the series after taking a 4-of-6 games in Wappingers Falls against Hudson Valley... The Blue Rocks are 12-13 at home this season...Brooklyn is 8-2 in 10 contests against Wilmington in 2025...The Blue Rocks boast 6 of the Nationals' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Travis Sykora (1), LHP Alex Clemmey (5), C Caleb Lomavita (8), LHP Jackson Kent (20), OF Elijah Green (23), and OF Brenner Cox (29)...Green is currently on the development list...In 118 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 65-53 (.551)...Brooklyn is 27-31 (.466) in 58 games at Daniel S. Frawley Stadium.

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting. 412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25...The 2024 first-round pick enters Thursday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (39), 4th in OPS (906), 5th in batting average (.301) and on-base percentage (.418), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (19), doubles (11), and hits (50), 6th in walks (32) and total bases (81), and 7th in slugging percentage (.488).

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Thursday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for the Minor League lead in triples (7)...He is also 3rd in batting average (.356) and stolen bases (39), and tied for 9th in hits (64)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (25), is 2nd in hits (38), tied for 2nd in triples (3), 3rd in batting average (.330), tied for 4th in runs scored (24), 6th in on-base percentage (.414), and 9th in total bases (52)...Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (25)...The 2023 4th-round pick had a 33-gene on-base streak since April 18 snapped on Sunday...During the on-base streak, Ewing hit 359/.450/.500/.950 with 27 runs scored, 5 doubles, 5 triples, a home run, 18 RBI, 21 walks, and 30 stolen bases.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City... Brooklyn enters play on Wednesday with 122 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (135)...The 122 steals are 8th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads MiLB (152)...The 122 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 53 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 43 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 79 steals through 53 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: C Chris Suero provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in Sunday's 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B Anderson De Los Santos enabled the winning run to cross...On Saturday, C Ronald Hernandez helped Brooklyn complete another come-from-behind win, clobbering a walk-off solo home run with 1 out in the 9th in a 5-4 Cyclones win...The walk-off homer was Brooklyn's 1st since 3B Jefrey De Los Santos hit a game-tying 2-run blast and LF Omar De Los Santos smashed the game-ending solo shot on July 28, 2024, vs. Rome...Hernandez also delivered a walk-off winner with a run-producing fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th on May 18 vs. Winston-Salem...2B Marco Vargas collected Brooklyn's 1st walk-off win of the year, slapping a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th on April 29 vs. Wilmington.

MAGIC 8 BALL: Brooklyn erupted for a season-high 8 runs in the 3rd inning in Tuesday's 12-3 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 8 runs on 8 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate...The 8-run frame was Brooklyn's biggest offensive outburst this year...The previous high had been 6 runs on 3 occasions, most recently on May 14 vs. Winston-Salem in the bottom of the 4th...The 8-run inning was the 'Clones largest frame since scoring 9 runs in the bottom of the 2nd inning in an 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on July 27, 2023...Brooklyn scored 9 runs on 6 hits in that inning, sending 12 to the dish...It was the Cyclones' biggest offensive inning on the road since tallying 10 runs in the top of the 6th in a 20-6 rout on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green.

GOING STREAKING: The Cyclones had a season-high 7-game winning streak snapped on Wednesday...Brooklyn also won 6 in a row from May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...It is the 1st time the Cyclones have accrued multiple winning streaks of 6 more since the 2022 campaign... Brooklyn's last 7-game winning streak was from August 23-30, 2022, at Jersey Shore and vs. Wilmington...The Cyclones then won 6 consecutive contests from September 3-9 vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn's winning streak from May 13-18 was the first time the team had won 6-straight since that stretch in 2022...During that win streak, the Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown at Winston-Salem.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent....According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3). INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), OF A.J. Ewing (27), and RHP Will Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP Raimon Gómez (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

2025: Broke camp with Single-A St. Lucie...Suffered the loss as the Opening Day starter on 4/4 vs. JUP (3.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 2 K)...Earned his 1st win of the season on 4/18 vs. TAM (5.0 IP, H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...Struck out a season-high 7 in a no-decision on 4/22 vs. Daytona (4.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 7 K)...Earned the victory, tossing a career-high 5.1 innings on 5/3 @JUP (5.1 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...At the time of his promotion, Dohm was tied for 5th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (34) and tied for 7th in innings pitched (28.1)...Transferred to Brooklyn on 5/12...Took a no-decision in his Cyclones and High-A debut on 5/15 vWS (3.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 4 K)...Tossed 3.2 innings of shutout ball in a no-decision on 5/30 vABD (3.2 IP, 3 H, BB, 4 K).

PROSPECT RADAR: Dohm entered the 2025 season ranked as the New York Mets' No. 23 prospect per *Baseball America*...He is considered New York's No. 18 farmhand by MLB Pipeline and the organization's No. 20 prospect per SNY's **Joe DeMayo**.

STARKVILLE SUPERSTAR: The 22-year-old had a marvelous final collegiate campaign at Mississippi State in 2024...Dohm composed a perfect 4-0 record with a minuscule 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1 IP), 23 hits allowed, 4 walks, and 37 strikeouts in 8 appearances (6 starts) for the Bulldogs...Served as Mississippi State's Opening Day starter on 2/16/24 vs. Air Force...Struck out a season-high 10 on 3/8/24 vs. Evansville...Pitched a season-high 7.0 innings on 2/29/24 vs. Mount Saint Mary's...Had 8 or more strikeouts in 3 contests...Held opponents to a .217 batting average...Sidelined for most of March and April with an arm injury.

BALL HARD: Dohm started his collegiate career closer to home at Ball State University in Muncie, Ind...The university was located roughly 66 miles southeast of Zionsville (Ind.) High School...About a one-hour and 17-minute drive on I-69...Pitched one season with the Cardinals in 2022...Accrued a 4-3 record with a 5.71 ERA (26 ER in 41.0 IP), 2 saves, 32 hits allowed, 26 walks, and 56 strikeouts in 15 appearances (3 starts).

WHO TO ROOT FOR?: It isn't just New York sports fans who have to decide on which baseball team to root for...It can happen in Chicago, as well...Dohm grew up on both the north and south sides of Chicago before moving to Zionsville, Ind...As a result, Dohm grew rooting for both the Chicago Cubs and Chicago White Sox...However, Dohm became more of a Cubs fan while a student at Zionsville High School.
