JACKSON HOLLIDAY IN FREDERICK

With the Keys back in Birdland for the first time since 2019, it only took two weeks for Frederick to have its first Major League rehab assignment as current Baltimore Orioles second baseman Jackson Holliday took his rehab assignment to Frederick on April 18 and April 19.

After having right hamate surgery that forced him to miss most of Spring Training this past February and March, he began his 2026 season with the Orioles Triple-A affiliate Norfolk Tides and played 11 games before getting shut down for six more days beginning on April 12.

Then, it was announced by the Baltimore Orioles on April 17 that Holliday would continue his Major League rehab assignment with the High-A Frederick Keys on April 18 and 19 during the team's first homestand of the season. In two games against the Hudson Valley Renegades (High-A, Yankees), Holliday finished 2-8 at the plate and recorded an RBI double on the 19th. Defensively, Holliday appeared at second base as well as the designated hitter during the final two games of the six-game set.

"It was good to see him out, there," Keys manager Collin Woody said following the Keys winning 4-1 over the Renegades on April 18. "He's a great guy to have around the clubhouse and it was great to have him out there."

Last year for the Orioles, Holliday played in 149 games as their starting second baseman and finished with a .242 average, 17 home runs, and 55 RBIs, in what was his first full season at the Major League level. Prior to that, the number 1 overall pick from the 2022 MLB Draft got the call to Camden Yards in 2024 and finished with 60 games played for the Orioles with five homers and 23 runs batted in to help Baltimore make their late postseason push.

Despite Frederick going just 1-1 during Holliday's time in the Key City, it served as another milestone moment for the franchise, who hosted a current Major League player for the first time in nearly seven years. Holliday joins the growing list of current and former Major Leaguers who had brief rehab stints with the Keys during their Major League careers.



A LOOK AROUND THE FARM SYSTEM

Birdland has seen plenty of young potential throughout the first month of the season as Single-A Delmarva, High-A Frederick, Double-A Chesapeake, and Triple-A Norfolk have all displayed plenty of talent in the beginning of the 2026 campaign.

For the Keys, they entered the season with eight top 30 prospects on their roster including the top-ranked Orioles prospect: outfielder Nate George. He is joined by fellow top-five prospects infielder and outfielder Ike Irish and shortstop Wehiwa Aloy.

Left-handed pitcher Boston Bateman leads the charge as the ninth-ranked Orioles prospect and Frederick's highest-ranked pitching prospect. Starting pitchers in southpaw Joseph Dzierwa and right-hander JT Quinn both came into this season as top-20 prospects for the Orioles farm system and have combined for a 5-1 record through each of their first five starts in their professional careers.

Delmarva has been led by the sixth-ranked Orioles prospect and right-handed pitcher Esteban Mejia, who has topped out close to 100 miles per hour in terms of his pitching velocity. Their hitting has been led by infielder Cobb Hightower who has hit a .342 clip with no home runs and three RBIs during his first 10 games played. Outfielder Braylon Whitaker has recorded nine RBIs and stolen six bases, all while hitting at a .327 clip: the second-highest average on the current roster.

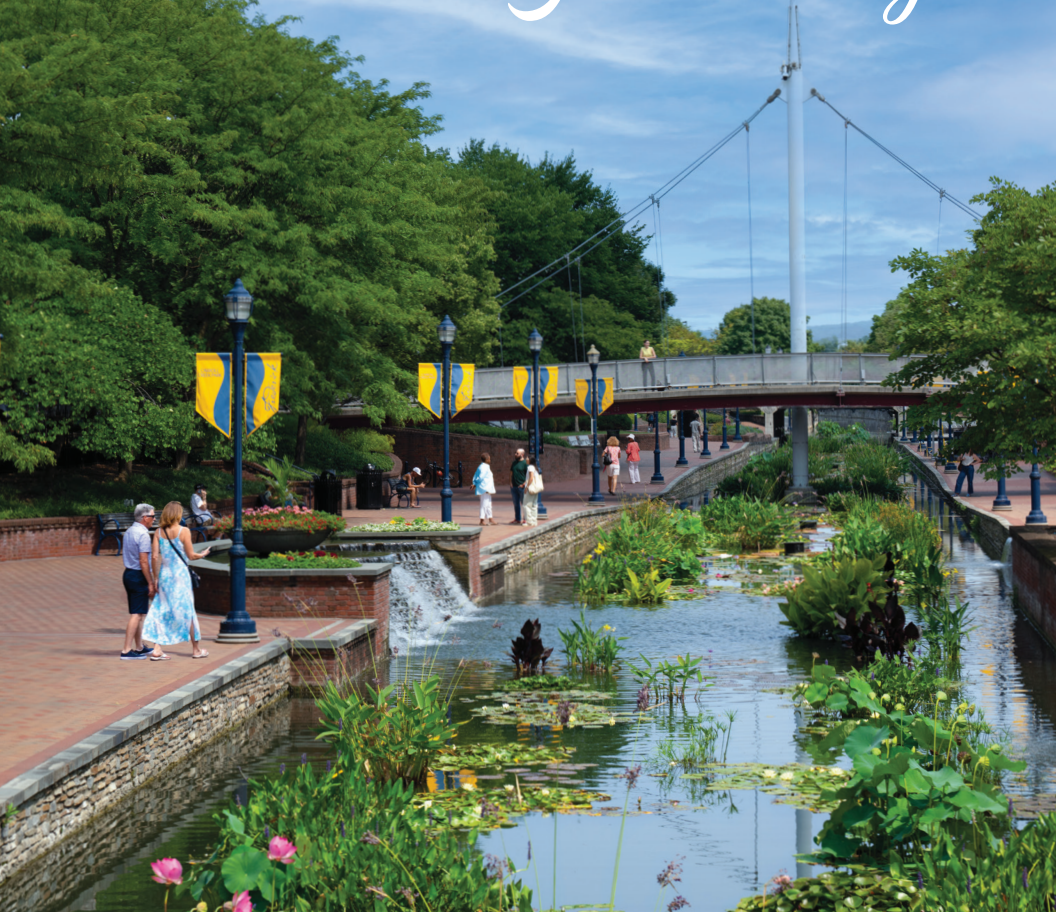


As for the Baysox, top-rated catcher Ethan Anderson has led Chesapeake to early offensive success this season with his average currently sitting at a .317 clip along with knocking in five RBIs. Infielder Anderson De Los Santos has hit a team-leading four home runs while driving in 12 runs on his own, tying Anderson for the highest batting average on the roster at .317.

Meanwhile, the Tides have been led on the mound most of this season by right-handed pitcher and third-ranked Orioles prospect Trey Gibson. His pitching has been stellar in Norfolk with a 2-2 record and 4.01 ERA. In his first 24.1 innings, Gibson has recorded 25 strikeouts while only allowing 12 walks. Outfielder Jud Fabian and catcher Creed Willems have led the way offensively with six and four homers apiece, helping Norfolk stay competitive in the International League in Triple-A.

KEYS HIGHLIGHT: JOSEPH DZIERWA

Since the Keys took the field as an Orioles affiliate for the first time in seven years on April 3, left-handed pitcher Joseph Dzierwa has led the pitching staff to new heights as he has posted a 3-1 record and a 2.67 ERA across his first 27 innings pitched of his professional career.

When the 12th-ranked Orioles prospect Dzierwa took the mound for the first time in a Keys uniform, he never felt too nervous or excited as his calm demeanor has been a strength of his following his second round draft selection during the 2025 MLB Draft.

"For me, it comes down to executing each pitch," said Dzierwa. "If you start doing that, the results will keep stacking one after another and I think it's more about the process."

On the opening game on April 3 against the Hub City Spartanburgers, Dzierwa recorded nine strikeouts and was an infield single shy of having a no-hitter through six innings of play at Fifth Third Park. Since that time, he has recorded 20 more strikeouts in his next four outings combined, helping the Keys go 4-1 in games that he's pitched in.

Dzierwa arrived at the Orioles organization after finishing his college career in 2025 with the Michigan State Spartans, nearly winning the Golden Spikes Award after recording a 2.36 ERA across 15 starts and 91.2 innings pitched. Additionally, his junior season had him record a career-high 104 strikeouts during the 15 starts, guiding the Spartans to more success in an ultra-competitive Big Ten Conference.

Moving forward, Dzierwa is excited about what fans can continue to expect out of him, especially as he continues to make his climb towards the Major Leagues throughout this year and the seasons ahead.

"Every pitch and every outing I want to compete at the highest level," said Dzierwa. "I love competing as it's something I've always done and to take every game pitch by pitch."

CHRISTIAN RODRIGUEZ BACK IN FULL SWING

So far in Single-A ball, former Keys right-handed pitcher Christian Rodriguez has shown what he is capable of as he is officially in his first full season of professional baseball following an injury that shut him down during the 2025 campaign.

After originally being assigned to the FCL Orioles, the six-foot-six right-hander Rodriguez has made four starts for the Single-A Shorebirds to begin the 2026 season. During this stint, he has thrown in 14 innings while posting a 3.21 ERA along with a 1-1 record in the Eastern Shore.

In his most recent start back on April 24, he finished with a season-high seven strikeouts across 3.2 innings in a win over the Wilson Warbirds at home. Besides that, he has posted at least three strikeouts in all four of his outings during the young season, guiding the Shorebirds to the heart of the Carolina League standings one month into the season.



Rodriguez began his time in Maryland in the MLB Draft League and competed for the Frederick Keys during the first half of the 2024 campaign. While with Frederick, he finished with a 3-1 record and a 3.92 ERA, with his best outing featuring a 16-strikeout performance in a complete game on July 12, 2024 against the Mahoning Valley Scrappers. Rodriguez also became one of the leaders in strikeouts on the roster in 2024 as he finished with 45 strikeouts in 39 innings pitched.

From there, Rodriguez became the highest-drafted player from the first half roster, as he landed himself a 10th round pick by the Baltimore Orioles during the 2024 MLB Draft. He unfortunately was unable to make his professional debut until 2026 due to injury but has quickly transitioned into a go-to starter for the Shorebirds and for the Orioles farm system.



As he continues to make his climb towards the Major Leagues, there's certainly the chance that Rodriguez could have a full circle moment, if he in fact makes the return to Nymeo Field at Harry Grove Stadium, but this time as an Orioles affiliate.

KEYS HIGHLIGHT: IKE IRISH

The 2026 Frederick Keys roster is loaded with ranked prospects. Fourth-ranked Orioles prospect and infielder/outfielder Ike Irish has led the charge in the top of the Keys lineup, serving as their leadoff man during several six-game series in the first month of the season.

In the first 19 games of the season for Irish, he leads the team alongside first baseman Victor Figueroa in batting average with a .338 average with four home runs and 14 RBIs. Additionally, he has a hit in all but four games he played in this season. Irish has also recorded six multi-hit games as one of the main power threats in the top of the order for new Keys manager Collin Woody.

For Irish, he is one of several power bats in the top of the order alongside Orioles top-ranked prospect Nate George and fifth-ranked prospect Wehiwa Aloy, both of whom have batted alongside Irish since the start of the season on April 3.

As he has developed during his first full season of professional baseball, keeping his approach simple has been a huge part in gaining more confidence at the plate.

“For me it’s being stubborn and realizing what I do well,” said Irish in an interview with MASN back on April 24. “Anyone who knows me knows that my entire game revolves around me hitting the ball to the back side and hitting into left-center and left field. I just want to keep it simple in the box.”



Keeping it simple has worked out quite well for the 2025 Orioles first-round draft choice, as he has gone opposite field in nearly every one of his home runs throughout the course of the 2026 campaign.

Even though he is putting up high numbers to begin this season, he still feels there’s a lot left for him to accomplish and improve in during the heart of the season.

“I feel like I haven’t fully hit a stride yet,” said Irish. “The biggest thing for me is getting pitches I can handle and a lot of them have come in on the outer half. It should be a little bit better but I’m excited for it.”

AROUND THE SOUTH ATLANTIC LEAGUE

The Keys's first season in the South Atlantic League has them going against new league opponents as well as familiar foes from their days in the Carolina League.

So far in the first month of the 2026 season, Frederick has faced off against new league opponents the Hub City Spartanburgers (High-A, Rangers), Hudson Valley Renegades (High-A, Yankees), and the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A, Mets). Additionally, they have competed against two teams from their days in the Carolina League: the Winston-Salem Dash (High-A, White Sox) and Wilmington Blue Rocks (High-A, Nationals).



During the next two homestands, Frederick will welcome two new teams at Nymeo Field at Harry Grove Stadium, the Greenville Drive (High-A, Red Sox) and the Jersey Shore BlueClaws (High-A, Phillies). Despite

their long tenure in the South Atlantic League, 1994 and 2001 respectively, both teams will be facing the Keys for the first time ever in franchise history.

In the first month of play, Frederick has stayed in the middle of the pack in the South Atlantic North Division standings with their record currently sitting at 12-10 through their first 22 games of the 132-game campaign. Hudson Valley leads the charge with a 14-8 overall record after taking four out of six games from the Keys during the opening homestand at Nymeo Field from April 14-19.

As for the South Division, the Bowling Green Hot Rods (High-A, Rays) and Winston-Salem Dash are neck and neck for first place in the standings, with both teams having a 15-8 overall record after 23 games played. Not far behind them is Greenville who sits just two games back of first place after four weeks of play. Rounding out the standings are the Rome Emperors (High-A, Braves) who are currently fourth with a 12-11 record, Hub City who's at fifth at 9-13, and the Asheville Tourists (High-A, Astros), who are 5-18 through the first 23 games of the season.



Besides hosting the BlueClaws and Drive in the Key City, Frederick will take road trips to Hudson Valley and Jersey Shore during their second full month back in Birdland.

CARTAYA NAMED PITCHER OF THE WEEK

The South Atlantic League and Minor League Baseball announced back on April 27 that Frederick Keys right-handed pitcher Yeiber Cartaya was named the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for the week ending on Sunday, April 26.

Cartaya received the honor following two scoreless appearances during the week of April 21 at home in which he threw a combined 8.1 innings of no-run ball while allowing only two hits and recording 14 strikeouts. He also had his first save of the season back on April 21 against the Wilmington Blue Rocks (High-A, Nationals) after throwing four shutout innings with seven strikeouts to close out the series opener in Frederick.

With this honor, the six-foot-five right-hander becomes the first Keys player to receive a South Atlantic League weekly honor this season and is one of two Orioles players to receive Minor League honors. Right-handed pitcher Trace Bright of the Double-A Chesapeake Baysox was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after allowing one run across eight innings against the Akron RubberDucks (Double-A, Guardians).

Throughout this season, Cartaya has been a mainstay in the starting rotation for Collin Woody's group as he has thrown in four games through the first four weeks of the 2026 campaign while recording a 1.08 ERA across 16.2 innings and having 24 strikeouts. He came into the 2026 season after throwing in five games last year for the formerly High-A Orioles affiliate Aberdeen Ironbirds and totaling a 1-1 record while recording 21 strikeouts across 20 innings pitched.

In addition to his time in the High-A ranks a season ago, the Caracas, Venezuela native finished with a 3.56 ERA with Single-A Delmarva across 19 games and 11 starts, all while throwing in 78.1 innings and totaling 96 strikeouts. 2025 was the first full season in affiliated baseball for Cartaya after he spent his first two-and-a-half seasons in the Orioles Dominican Summer League and for the FCL Orioles in the Florida Complex League.

Cartaya will continue to be a crucial in the back part of the Keys's starting rotation as he joins alongside starting pitchers Joseph Dzierwa, JT Quinn, Boston Bateman, and Twine Palmer as the main starters throughout the first half of the Keys's first season back in Birdland.

FREDERICK KEYS FAN BEHAVIOR POLICY

The Frederick Keys are committed to creating a family-friendly and welcoming environment at the ballpark for all guests. As part of that commitment, we have adopted this written policy addressing fan behavior. The policy includes a Fan Code of Conduct, which is fan-facing and describes how fans are expected to behave.

All Frederick Keys staff, including game-day staff, must receive a copy of this policy before working any games. In addition, all staff must receive annual training on this policy, the substance of the Fan Code of Conduct, and how to respond to prohibited fan behavior. All training will be documented.

A copy of the Fan Code of Conduct can be found at any entrance gate to the ballpark, at any guest services booth, on www.FrederickKeys.com, and in the official game program.

Fans will be notified before and during the game through public service announcements ("PSAs") on the main video board that summarize the Fan Code of Conduct, the penalties for violation, and how to report prohibited behavior.

Reporting An Incident

Any game-day staff member who witnesses or receives a report of prohibited fan behavior by a fan must report the incident to a Club security supervisor. This can be done by contacting your immediate supervisor, notifying a nearby security staff member, or by contacting (301) 662-0013.

Use of derogatory language by a fan toward a player, umpire, Club staff, or their family members must be documented by the Club and reported to the Club's General Manager and to the Commissioner's Office via email to PDLsecurity@mlb.com. Clubs must seek to collect the name and identifying information of the fan and must include in their report a description of how the Club addressed the incident and any planned discipline.

Fan Code of Conduct

In order to provide a welcoming experience for all, the Frederick Keys have implemented a Fan Code of Conduct. Out of respect for fellow guests, players, coaches, and ballpark staff, all guests are prohibited from:

- Trespassing on the playing field at any time;
- Interfering with baseballs that are in play;
- Throwing or tossing objects;
- Using foul, obscene or derogatory language (see below) or gestures;
- Misusing or overconsuming alcohol, including, underage consumption;
- Behaving in a manner that is disruptive, unruly, or abusive;
- Accessing areas of the ballpark without a proper ticket, pass, or credential;
- Misusing tickets, passes, or credentials in any way; or
- Bringing prohibited items into the ballpark.

Derogatory language is defined as offensive language concerning a person's race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, age, sexual orientation, or national origin, and anyone using such language is subject to automatic ejection from the ballpark.

Violations of the Fan Code of Conduct will not be tolerated and may lead to ejection from the ballpark, a ban on attending future games, or other consequences. Guests who are found to have used derogatory language will be ejected from the ballpark.

Guests are encouraged to report violations of the Fan Code of Conduct to the nearest ballpark staff member. This can be done in person, at the nearest Guest Services location, directly with Ballpark Security or by calling (301) 662-0013.
