SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

BREAKING OUT THE BROOMS FOR THE DOUBLEHEADER: The Shuckers completed their second doubleheader sweep over the Rocket City Trash Pandas on Thursday, winning 2-0 in game one and 9-1 in game two... The Shuckers outscored Rocket City 11-1 over the two games, including their fourth shutout win of the year in game one... Biloxi has now won six straight against the Trash Pandas, outscoring Rocket City 44-10 over that span, a +34 run differential... INF Zavier Warren has led the power surge against Rocket City with two home runs and nine RBI, with eight coming this week... On the mound, RHP Justin Jarvis extended his scoreless streak against Rocket City to 11 innings during game one of Thursday's doubleheader with five shutout innings.

THE BACK-END MONSTER: Entering today, the Shuckers bullpen has allowed three earned runs over their last five games, a 1.72 ERA... During Thursday's doubleheader, the bullpen held Rocket City scoreless over four innings with four strikeouts... This year, the bullpen's 3.05 ERA is the seventh-best between Major League Baseball and Minor League Baseball... The group has also struck out 159 batters in 115 innings, an average of 12.44 strikeouts per nine, the fifth-best mark in baseball.

KEEPING THE WINNING WAYS: With the doubleheader sweep on Thursday, the Shuckers cliched at least a split in their sixth straight series to start the year... The Shuckers have won two series and split three this year... The Shuckers last won a six-game set, 4-2, against Rocket City from April 18-23, 2023, becoming the second visiting team to take a series at Toyota Field since the start of the 2021 season.

WELCOME TO THE AWARDS SHOW: The Milwaukee Brewers announced on Wednesday that INF Tyler Black and RHP Justin Jarvis were named the Brewers Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for April... It marked the first time that the Shuckers swept the award since RHP Aaron Wilkerson and OF Troy Stokes Jr. took home the honors in July of 2017... Black ranked among the Southern League leaders for April in on-base percentage [2nd, .456], walks [T2nd, 17], stolen bases [3rd, 10], runs [T3rd, 15], OPS [4th, .938], slugging percentage [T6th, .482] and RBI [T9th, 13]... Jarvis ranked among Southern League leaders for the month in ERA [2nd, 1.57], WHIP [3rd, 1.00], opponent batting average [3rd, .205], wins [T3rd, 2], innings pitched [4th, 23.0] and strikeouts [8th, 29].

INCHING TOWARDS HISTORY: Shuckers manager Mike Guerrero enters today needing two more wins to reach 1,400 in his managerial career... Guerrero is in his 24th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 23rd with the Brewers organization... Over his seven-year managerial career in Biloxi, Guerrero has earned a two trips to the Southern League Championship Series, in 2018 and 2019... Guerrero also led the Shuckers to a franchise-best 82 wins during the 2019 season, a year after he led the Shuckers to a then-record 81 wins.

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TOBIAS MYERS (2-0, 4.50)</u>: RHP Tobias Myers makes his seventh start of the year and his second against Rocket City... In his last start, against Montgomery, Myers set a new season-high with 6.1 innings, becoming the first Shuckers starter to pitch into the seventh this year... Today marks Myers' 101st start in Minor League Baseball after being selected by the Orioles out of high school in the 2016 Draft.
